In Case You Missed It: The Baysox offense was stuck in neutral again on Saturday night as number one pick in the 2018 draft Casey Mize and a duo of relievers held Bowie to a run on just three hits...For a second consecutive night, Erie homered three times in the contest to upend the Baysox 6-1...The Baysox are now just 2-7 against Erie and are 3-16 against right-handed pitchers on the season...Today they look to split the series in a 1:35 p.m. first pitch from UPMC Park...

Baysox Starter: RHP Marcos Molina makes his sixth start of the year for the Baysox today and third against Erie. Molina started on Opening Day at Harrisburg and took the loss, allowing four runs in five innings. He then got the ball in the home opener, also against Harrisburg, and allowed just one earned run in six innings of work. Last week, Molina pitched at home against Erie and allowed two runs in five innings. The 24-year-old spent the first six years of his career in the New York Mets organization, and was ranked in the Mets' top 15 prospects by MLB.com each of the last three years. Molina made 14 starts in AA Binghamton and two starts in AAA Las Vegas last year. Overall, he was 1-10 with a 6.94 ERA in 81.2 innings. Molina was released by the Mets in July of last season, and was later suspended for the rest of the season after testing positive for PEDs. The best season of his career was in 2014 when he went 7-3 with a 1.77 ERA in short-season Brooklyn. That year, Molina was named a NYPL All-Star and NYM Organizational All-Star.

In the Other Corner: RHP Matt Manning who like Molina is making his sixth start of the season and third against the Baysox. Has two no decisions against Bowie prior working 10.2 IP and allowing 3 ER. Was the 9th pick of the first round of the 2016 draft. A high school right-handed pitcher from Sacramento, CA is just 21 years old. Reached Double-A late last year making final two starts of season for Erie. Has held Eastern League hitters to .141 average against in six starts this season.

For the Er-Win: LHP Tyler Erwin has been a very dependable arm during high leverage innings out of the Baysox bullpen this year. Erwin leads the team in wins with two, and has the only three saves recorded by Bowie. In 13.2 innings, Erwin has a 1.98 ERA, and has not allowed a run in 10 of his 12 appearances.

Bann-On a Run: INF Rylan Bannon has been the Baysox best hitter throughout the 2019 season. Bannon leads the team in home runs (4), RBI (14), batting average (.308) and runs scored (13). Bannon also has the only two four-hit games for the team this season and has eight multi-hit games.

Scouting the SeaWolves: Erie comes into this four game series with an even record of 11-11 on the season. The SeaWolves took two of three games from Altoona in their last series. Offensively, **Jose Azocar** is leading the team with a .385 batting average. **Derek Hill** is the team leader with three home runs, and **Kody Eaves** leads the way with 14 RBI. Erie's starting rotation features three former first round picks, including **Casey Mize**, the #1 overall selection in the 2018 MLB Draft. Mize made his AA debut last week, and pitched a complete game no-hitter. **Matt Manning** (2-1, 2.83 ERA) and **Alex Faedo** (2-1, 3.10 ERA) also help lead the SeaWolves pitching staff.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, seven of the top 30 prospects in the organization will begin the season in Bowie. Outfielder **Yusniel Diaz** headlines the roster, coming into the year as Baltimore's number one prospect. Outfielder **Ryan McKenna** (#7) and Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) also rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#18), **Zach Pop** (#20) and Infielder **Rylan Bannon** (#23) round out the top prospects that start the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: On May 5, 2010 **Ryan Adams** registers a four-hit game and **Caleb Joseph** goes 3-for-5 with a three-run home run as the Baysox win going away in Harrisburg 7-1. **Steve Johnson** got the win for the Baysox.

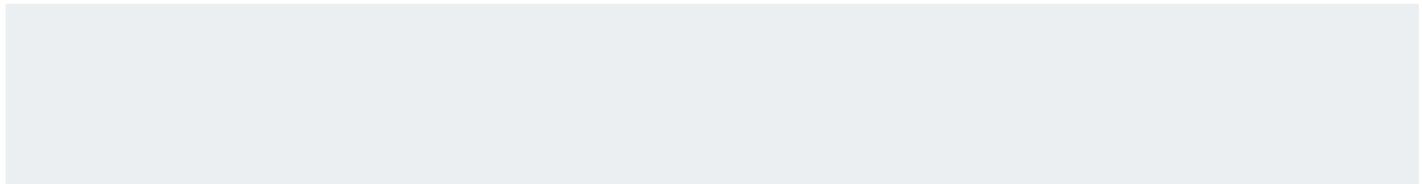
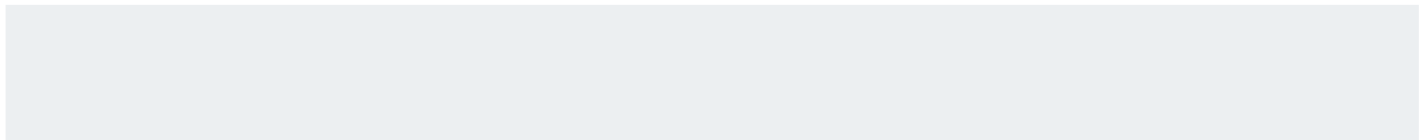
