In Case You Missed It: The Baysox scored a season-high in runs and tied a season-high in hits in a 12-2 series-clinching win in Altoona. **Mason McCoy** had four hits and two RBI in the game, **Carlos Perez** drove in two runs, **Alexis Torres** drove in three runs and **Jesmeul Valentin** and **T.J. Nichting** each had multi-hit efforts. The ten run win was the largest of the season for Bowie, and the series win was the first of 2019. **Alex Wells** started on the mound and earned his second win of the season. **Brian Gonzalez** and **Cristian Alvarado** each pitched two scoreless innings out of the bullpen.

Baysox Starter: LHP Bruce Zimmermann makes the start today for the Baysox. This is his sixth start of the year. Zimmermann struggled in his last start in Erie, allowing five runs in 3.1 innings. Prior to that, Zimmermann had posted a 1.57 ERA over his first four starts. Zimmermann was acquired by the Orioles at the 2018 Trade Deadline in a deal with the Atlanta Braves that sent Kevin Gausman and Darren O'Day to Atlanta. Zimmermann made five starts with the Baysox, going 2-3 with a 5.06 ERA in 21.1 innings. Even with the high ERA, Zimmermann only allowed one run in three of the five starts.

In the Other Corner: RHP Alfred Gutierrez is making his sixth start of the year for Richmond. Gutierrez has had an up-and-down start to the season, allowing four runs in two of his starts, but two runs or less in his other three outings. The 23-year-old has struggled to give the Flying Squirrels much length this season, as he has not pitched more than 4.1 innings in a start. Gutierrez is in his first season in the Orioles' organization after spending the first seven years of his professional career in the Detroit system. Gutierrez made seven starts in AA-Erie last year, going 2-3 with a 6.09 ERA.

For the Er-Win: LHP Tyler Erwin has been a very dependable arm during high leverage innings out of the Baysox bullpen this year. Erwin leads the team in wins with two, and has the only three saves recorded by Bowie. In 13.2 innings, Erwin has a 1.84 ERA, and has not allowed a run in 11 of his 13 appearances.

Bann-On a Run: INF Rylan Bannon has been the Baysox best hitter throughout the 2019 season. Bannon is tied for the team lead in home runs (4), and leads the club in RBI (15), batting average (.319) and runs scored (16). Bannon also has the only two four-hit games for the team this season and has ten multi-hit games. Bannon is currently in the midst of a seven-game hitting streak.

Perez Getting Hot: C Carlos Perez had a big series in Altoona. Perez went 4-14 with two home runs and eight RBI in the series. The eight runs driven in were the most for any Baysox player in a single series this season. Perez also became the first Bowie player to drive in multiple runs in three consecutive games in 2019.

Welcome to Bowie: INF Mason McCoy made quite the impression after being called-up from High-A Frederick prior to the series in Altoona. In three starts, all at shortstop and batting leadoff, McCoy went 7-14 (.500) with a home run and three RBI.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, seven of the top 30 prospects in the organization will begin the season in Bowie. Outfielder **Yusniel Diaz** headlines the roster, coming into the year as Baltimore's number one prospect. Outfielder **Ryan McKenna** (#7) and Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) also rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#18), **Zach Pop** (#20) and Infielder **Rylan Bannon** (#23) round out the top prospects that start the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: On May 10, 2018, **Aderlin Rodriguez**, **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Austin Hays** combined for six hits, two home runs and six RBI in a 7-6 win over Hartford. **John Means** picked up the win on the mound.

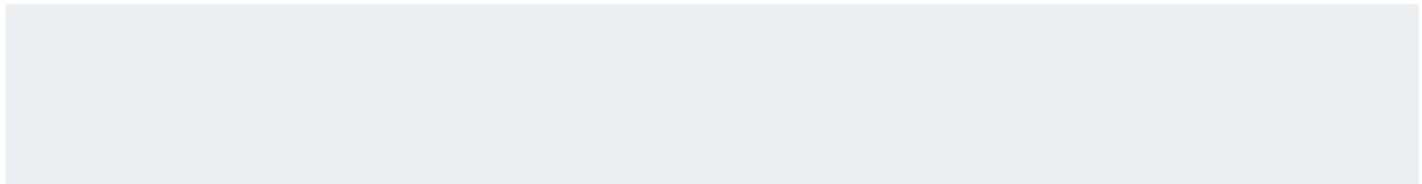
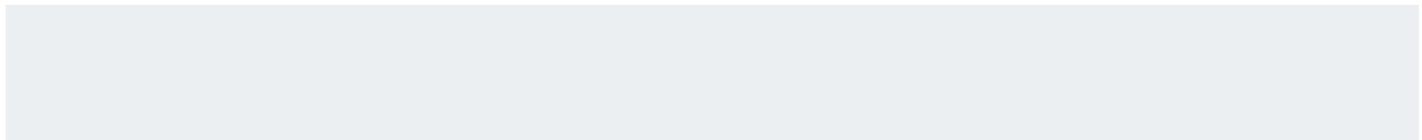
