In Case You Missed It: The Baysox pitched their second shutout of the year in a 3-0 win over Richmond, sweeping a rain-shortened two game series. After a rain delay, **Richard Bleier** got the start and pitched one inning as part of his MLB rehab assignment. **Marcos Molina** then pitched the final 7.0 innings of the game, allowing just one hit. Offensively, Bowie was sparked by a **Ryan McKenna** two-run home run in the first innings and a sacrifice fly from **Preston Palmeiro** in the fourth. The game was called due to inclement weather after 7.5 innings.

Baysox Starter: RHP Hunter Harvey will make his seventh start of the year for the Baysox this season. Harvey is coming off his best start of the season, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings in Altoona. Harvey eclipsed the 200 inning mark for his career in that start. It was his first start of 6+ innings and no runs allowed since 2014. The start before that, Harvey struggled at home against Richmond, but had tossed 5.0 scoreless frames against Akron the week before.

In the Other Corner: LHP Tanner Tully makes his seventh start of the year for the RubberDucks today. In his last start, Tully allowed just one run in 6.0 innings in Erie. This will be Tully's third start of the year against the Baysox. In 11.0 innings against Bowie this year, Tully has allowed just one run in 11.0 innings. This will be Tully's third start of the year at home and first since April 20. The 24-year-old was a 26th round pick by the Indians in 2016 out of Ohio State University.

For the Er-Win: LHP Tyler Erwin has been a very dependable arm during high leverage innings out of the Baysox bullpen this year. Erwin leads the team in wins with two, and has the only three saves recorded by Bowie. In 14.0 innings, Erwin has a 1.80 ERA, and has not allowed a run in 12 of his 14 appearances. Erwin currently owns an 8.0 inning scoreless streak.

Bann-On a Run: INF Rylan Bannon has been the Baysox best hitter throughout the 2019 season. Bannon is tied for the team lead in home runs (4), and leads the club in RBI (16), batting average (.309) and runs scored (16). Bannon also has two four-hit games this season and has ten multi-hit games.

Welcome to Bowie: INF Mason McCoy made quite the impression after being called-up from High-A Frederick prior to the series in Altoona. In three starts against the Curve, all at shortstop and batting leadoff, McCoy went 7-14 (.500) with a home run and three RBI. In his home debut against Richmond, McCoy went 3-3 with a walk and three runs scored. In the second game of the Richmond series, McCoy hit his first AA triple and added a run scored and a walk.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, seven of the top 30 prospects in the organization will begin the season in Bowie. Outfielder **Yusniel Diaz** headlines the roster, coming into the year as Baltimore's number one prospect. Outleder **Ryan McKenna** (#7) and Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) also rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#18), **Zach Pop** (#20) and Infielder **RyIan Bannon** (#23) round out the top prospects that start the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: On May 13, 2008, Nolan Reimold hit a walk-off two run home run to lead the Baysox over Erie 5-3.
