| 2019 SEASON | | In Case You Missed It: The Baysox four-game winning streak came to an end with a 3-0 loss Monday night at the hands of the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. Bowie was only able to manage one hit in the loss. | | | |

| Overall Record | 16-27 | Baysox Starter: RHP Dean Kremer will make his 2019 Baysox debut today. Kremer has made two starts in High-A Frederick after suffering an injury in spring training. In those two starts, Kremer did not allow a run in 9.2 innings. The 23-year-old right hander made eight starts with Bowie at the end of 2018 and went 4-2 with a 2.58 ERA in 45.1 innings. Kremer was acquired by the Orioles at last year's trade deadline in the deal that sent Manny Machado to the Dodgers. Between two levels in the Dodgers system and his eight starts in Bowie, Kremer struck out a minor league high 178 batters in 131.1 innings last season. Kremer was originally a 14th round pick by the Dodgers in the 2016 MLB Draft out of UNLV. He enters the 2019 season as the #9 prospect in the Baltimore organization, according to MLB.com and Baseball America. | | | |
| Home Record | 9-12 | In the Other Corner: LHP David Peterson makes his eighth start of the year for the Rumble Ponies today. The left-hander comes in with a 4.55 ERA on the season, but has been solid of late, only allowing one earned run in each of his last three outings. In his seven starts thus far in 2019, Peterson has allowed three earned runs or less six times. The one outlier was on April 29 when he allowed seven earned runs against Akron. The 23-year-old is in his first AA season after splitting 2018 between Low-A Columbia and High-A St. Lucie. Peterson was the Mets first round pick in the 2017 MLB Draft out of the University of Oregon. While at Oregon, Peterson struck out 20 batters in one game against Arizona State on April 28, 2017. | | | |
| Road Record | 7-15 | Lowther Wins Pitcher of the Week: LHP Zac Lowther was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday, for the period from May 13-19. Lowther pitched twice during the week, throwing 12.2 scoreless innings against Akron and Erie. The left-hander earned two wins, giving him a team-high four on the season, and is currently in the midst of a 15.2 scoreless inning streak. | | | |
| Versus Eastern Division | 0-1 | Strong Starting Pitching: Over the last seven games, the Baysox have gotten great work from the starting rotation. In 39.2 innings, the last six Bowie starters have combined for an ERA of 1.13. The stretch started with Zac Lowther tossing a career-high 7.2 scoreless innings in Akron. The next day, Alex Wells threw 7.0 scoreless frames of his own. In the first two games of the series against Erie, Bruce Zimmermann and Marcos Molina allowed just two earned runs in 6.0 innings. On Saturday, Hunter Harvey pitched 6.0 innings, allowing just one run. On Sunday, Lowther pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, extending his scoreless innings streak to 15.2. Last night, Wells pitched 2.0 scoreless frames before leaving with an injury. | | | |
| Versus Western Division | 16-26 | Bullpen Dominance: Along with great starting pitching, the Baysox bullpen was lights out in the series against Erie. In all, eight different Baysox relievers pitched in the series and did not allow a run. In total, the Baysox pitching staff allowed only six runs in 37 innings of play against the SeaWolves over the weekend. | | | |
| Current Streak | L1 | Getting Hot: Over the last thirteen games, the Baysox have been the hottest team in the Eastern League, with nine wins in that span. In this stretch, Bowie has won series against Altoona and Richmond, and most recently swept a four-game home series from Erie. | | | |
| Current Homestand | 4-1 | Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, eight of the top 30 prospects in the organization will begin the season in Bowie. Outfielder Yusniel Diaz headlines the roster, coming into the year as Baltimore's number one prospect. Outfielder Ryan McKenna (#7) and Left-Handed Pitcher Zac Lowther (#8) also rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers Hunter Harvey (#12), Dillon Tate (#18), Zach Pop (#20), Infielder Rylan Bannon (#23) and Infielder Mason McCoy (#30) round out the top prospects that start the 2019 campaign with the Baysox. | | | |
| Last Road Trip | 1-2 | The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton. | | | |

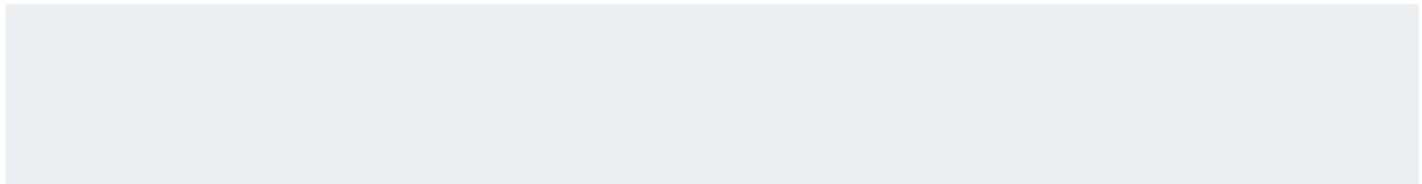
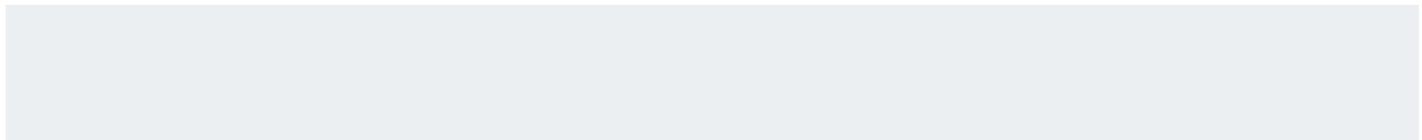
