In Case You Missed It: The Baysox dropped the second game of the series against Akron by a score of 9-8. After allowing a run in the first, the Baysox scored four in the first and one in the third to take the lead. The RubberDucks stormed back, taking a 9-5 lead, thanks to two three-run home runs from Ka'ai Tom. Bowie scored three in the ninth to cut it to a 9-8 game, but was unable to plate the tying run.

Baysox Starter: RHP Marcos Molina will make his tenth appearance and ninth start of the year for the Baysox today. In his last outing, Molina tied a season-high, tossing 7.0 innings and allowed just one earned run in Erie. Molina has given up two earned runs or less in each of his last three outings. The 24-year-old has been very consistent for Bowie this season, going 5.0 innings or more in all but one of his appearances. This will be Molina's first start of the season against Akron.

In the Other Corner: RHP Jake Paulson is on the mound for the RubberDucks today tenth start of the season and ninth with Akron. Paulson's last two starts have come against Richmond. In those two outings, he was allowed a combined six earned runs in 11.2 innings. For the season, including one start with AAA-Columbus, Paulson has allowed two earned runs in five of his starts and four earned runs in his other four. This is Paulson's second start of the season against the Baysox. On May 14 in Akron, Paulson pitched 6.0 innings against Bowie, allowing two runs on five hits. Paulson pitched 115.1 innings with the RubberDucks last season, and was the Eastern League leader in ERA, with a mark of 3.04.

Lowther Wins Pitcher of the Week: LHP Zac Lowther was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week last Monday, for the period from May 13-19. Lowther pitched twice during the week, throwing 12.2 scoreless innings against Akron and Erie. The left-hander earned two wins, giving him a team-high four on the season, and is currently in the midst of a 21.2 scoreless inning streak.

Strong Southpaws: LHP Zac Lowther and **LHP Alex Wells** have each been dominant over their last three starts for the Baysox. In that span, Lowther has not allowed a run in 18.2 innings and is 2-0. Wells has also not allowed a run in 16.0 innings over his last three starts. Both Wells and Lowther have ERA's under 2.00 for the season.

Scouting the RubberDucks: The Baysox have struggled so far this season against Akron, coming into this game with a record of 2-10. The RubberDucks took two of three in Akron the last time the two squads met.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, 12 of the top 30 prospects in the organization are in Bowie. Outfielder **Yusniel Diaz** headlines the roster, coming into the year as Baltimore's number one prospect. Outfielder **Austin Hays** (#5), Outfielder **Ryan McKenna** (#7), Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) and Right-Handed Pitcher **Dean Kremer** (#9) also rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#18), **Zach Pop** (#20), **Alex Wells** (#26), Catcher **Brett Cumberland** (#24), Infielder **Rylan Bannon** (#23) and Infielder **Mason McCoy** (#30) round out the top prospects that are spending the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: After putting together a four-game winning streak on games played on May 30 from 1994-1997, the Baysox are 10-10 in their last 20 games played on May 30.



