In Case You Missed It: The Baysox were swept in a three-game home series by the Akron RubberDucks after a 9-5 loss on Thursday. After falling behind 1-0 in the second inning, Bowie tied the game on an RBI single from **Jesmuel Valentin**. From that point on, Akron scored eight consecutive runs to take a 9-1 lead. The Baysox fought in the ninth, scoring four runs on an RBI double from **Preston Palmeiro** and a three-run home run from **Ryan McKenna**, but the comeback effort ultimately fell short. Bowie has now lost five consecutive games.

Baysox Starter: RHP Hunter Harvey is on the hill for the Baysox today, making his tenth start of the season. He is coming off an outing in Erie where he allowed four earned runs in 2.1 innings. In his previous start, Harvey struck out a season-high eight in a 6.0 inning effort where he allowed just one run. Harvey has allowed one run or less in three of his last six starts, including two scoreless outings in that span. The nine starts Harvey has already made this season are the most he has made in a season since 2014, when he started 14 times as a member of the Delmarva Shorebirds.

In the Other Corner: LHP Jack Wynkoop is on the mound for Hartford, making his 11th start of 2019. Wynkoop has struggled in his last two starts, both against New Hampshire. In those starts, he allowed a combined eight earned runs on 16 hits in 11.0 innings. Priot to that, Wynkoop had allowed two earned runs or less in six of his first nine starts of the season. Wynkoop currently ranks sixtrh in the Eastern League in innings pitched with 57.0. The 25-year-old is in his third consecutive season as a member of the Yard Goats, spending all of 2017 and 2018 in Hartford. Wynkoop was originally a sixth round pick by the Rockies in the 2015 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina.

Lowther Wins Pitcher of the Week: LHP Zac Lowther was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week last Monday, for the period from May 13-19. Lowther pitched twice during the week, throwing 12.2 scoreless innings against Akron and Erie. The left-hander earned two wins, giving him a team-high four on the season, and is currently in the midst of a 21.2 scoreless inning streak.

Strong Southpaws: LHP Zac Lowther and **LHP Alex Wells** have each been dominant over their last three starts for the Baysox. In that span, Lowther has not allowed a run in 18.2 innings and is 2-0. Wells has also not allowed a run in 16.0 innings over his last three starts. Both Wells and Lowther have ERA's under 2.00 for the season.

Scouting the Yard Goats: This will be the first of four series played in 2019 between Bowie and Hartford. The Yard Goats come into this series with a record of 30-22, good for fourth place in the very competitive Eastern Division. Despite being in fourth, Hartford is just two games out of first place and is tied for the second-most wins in the Eastern League. Offensively, Hartford is led by Vince Fernandez, who leads the Eastern League in home runs (13) and runs (32), and is tied for sixth in RBI (30). The Yard Goats also have two players in the top ten in the league in batting average, Colton Welker (.315) and Alan Trejo (.292). Welker currently leads the Eastern league in hits (57) and doubles (17). On the mound, Hartford has two starters in the top ten in ERA (Rico Garcia and Ashton Goudeau), two in the top ten in wins (Garcia and Brandon Gold) and the league's top closer in Ben Bowden (1.25 ERA, 16 SV).

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, 11 of the top 30 prospects in the organization are in Bowie. Outfielder **Austin Hays** (#5), Outleder **Ryan McKenna** (#7), Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) and Right-Handed Pitcher **Dean Kremer** (#9) rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#18), **Zach Pop** (#20), **Alex Wells** (#26), Catcher **Brett Cumberland** (#24), Infielder **Rylan Bannon** (#23) and Infielder **Mason McCoy** (#30) round out the top prospects that are spenidng the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: On May 31, 2015, the Baysox defeated Harrisburg 6-4 on a game-winning grand slam in the ninth innings from **Quincy Lattimore**.
