Baysox vs. Trenton

In Case You Missed It: Three Baysox pitchers combined to toss a one-hit shutout in a 3-0 win over Trenton in the series opener. Zac Lowther pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, and was backed up by 3.0 frames from Hunter Harvey, who was pitching in relief for the first time in his career, and a 1.0 inning save from Tyler Erwin. Offensively, Rylan Bannon drove in the first run of the game with an RBI single in the fourth inning. The Baysox added a run in the seventh on a run scoring single from Jesmuel Valentin, and in the eighth Yusniel Diaz homered for the third straight game. The win ran the Baysox winning streak to a season-high six games.

Baysox Starter: LHP Alex Wells will be making his 10th start of the year for the Baysox today. Wells has been dominant for Bowie in 2019, entering tonight's game with a 1.61 ERA. In his last start in Portland, Wells allowed just one earned run on three hits in 6.0 innings of work. For the year, Wells has four scoreless starts in nine outings, and has allowed one earned run or less in seven of his nine starts. Wells has not allowed more than one run in a start since May 8. The 22-year-old left hander was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the period from May 27-June 2.

In the Other Corner: RHP Trevor Stephan will be making his 10th start of the year for the Thunder today. Stephan comes into this start with an inflated ERA of 5.40, but has allowed one earned run or less in five of his nine starts. Stephan is coming off a start in which he pitched 5.0 scoreless innings against Erie. This will be Stephan's 27th career AA start, and he comes in with a 4.78 ERA in 116.2 innings. Stephan was a third-round pick by the Yankees in 2017 out of the University of Arkansas

Pitching Dominance: The Baysox pitching staff had its most dominant stretch of the season during the last series against New Hampshire. From the fourth inning on Wednesday until the fifth inning on Thursday, **Bruce Zimmermann**, **Cristian Alvarado**, **Zach Muckenhirn** and **Marcos Molina** combined to retire 31 consecutive Fisher Cats hitters.

McCoy's Impact: INF Mason McCoy has had an undeniable impact on the Baysox since being called-up from High-A Frederick on May 6. Bowie began the year 7-23, but has posted an 21-14 record since McCoy joined the roster. In 34 games with the Baysox, McCoy is hitting .319 with a home run, ten RBI, 46 hits, 21 runs, five doubles, four triples and three stolen bases. McCoy also has 14 multi-hit games with the Baysox, and at least three hits in seven contests.

Rifaela Getting Hot: OF Ademar Rifaela has been on fire during the Baysox current homestand. In four games, Rifaela is 6-15 (.400) with five RBI, two triples and a run scored. Rifaela picked up his 500th career hit in the Baysox win over New Hampshire on Thursday night.

Three Times the Charm: OF Yusniel Diaz has hit home runs in three consecutive games for the Baysox. The stretch began on Wednesday night, when Diaz hit a two-run walkoff home run in the tenth inning. He followed that up with a three-run blast on Thursday and a solo shot on Friday night. This is the second time in Diaz's career that he has homered in three consecutive games. The last occurrence was on April 18, 19 and 20 of 2016 when he was a member of the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, 12 of the top 30 prospects in the organization are in Bowie. Outfielder **Yusniel Diaz** (#2), Outfielder **Austin Hays** (#5), Outielder **Ryan McKenna** (#7), Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) and Right-Handed Pitcher **Dean Kremer** (#9) rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#17), **Zach Pop** (#20), **Alex Wells** (#26), Catcher **Brett Cumberland** (#24), Infielder **Rylan Bannon** (#23) and Infielder **Mason McCoy** (#30) round out the top prospects that are speniding the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: On June 15, 2002, seven different Baysox had multi-hit games in a 9-5 win over Altoona. **Erik Bedard** picked up the win that day.
