In Case You Missed It: The Baysox extended their season-long win streak to seven games in a 9-4 win over Trenton on Saturday night. Bowie jumped out to a quick start, scoring three runs in the first inning, on RBI singles from **Yusniel Diaz**, **Ademar Rifaela** and **Jesmuel Valentin**. The Baysox got three more runs in the second inning on a two-run double from Diaz and an RBI triple from Rifaela. Trenton got three runs back in the fourth inning, but **Ryan McKenna** extended the lead back to six runs by hitting his fifth home run of the year, a three-run blast in the sixth. **Alex Wells** earned his fourth win of the year on the mound, and helped Bowie clinch its fourth consecutive series win.

Baysox Starter: RHP **Dean Kremer** makes his seventh start of the year and fifth with the Baysox today. Kremer is coming off one of the best starts of his career, tossing 7.0 scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in a win over New Hampshire. The 7.0 innings tied a career-high for the 23-year-old. Kremer has improved in each of his four starts with Bowie this season, allowing fewer runs and pitching more innings than his previous start each time he has taken the mound. Today will be Kremer's 14th career AA start. He comes in with a career AA record of 6-5 with a 3.00 ERA. He has struck out 85 batters in 75.0 career AA innings.

In the Other Corner: RHP **Adonis Rosa** is making his 10th appearance and fourth start of the year with Trenton today. The 24-year-old last pitched on June 11th against Binghamton and allowed two earned runs on five hits in 2.1 innings of work. Rosa has made three appearances in AAA this season, and posted a 5.11 ERA in 12.1 innings. The 24-year-old made two starts with Trenton last season and was 0-2 with a 4.63 ERA in 11.2 innings. Rosa was originally signed by the Yankees as an international free agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2013.

Pitching Dominance: The Baysox pitching staff had its most dominant stretch of the season during the last series against New Hampshire. From the fourth inning on Wednesday until the fifth inning on Thursday, **Bruce Zimmermann**, **Cristian Alvarado**, **Zach Muckenhirn** and **Marcos Molina** combined to retire 31 consecutive Fisher Cats hitters.

McCoy's Impact: INF **Mason McCoy** has had an undeniable impact on the Baysox since being called-up from High-A Frederick on May 6. Bowie began the year 7-23, but has posted an 22-14 record since McCoy joined the roster. In 35 games with the Baysox, McCoy is hitting .322 with a home run, ten RBI, 48 hits, 23 runs, six doubles, four triples and three stolen bases. McCoy also has 15 multi-hit games with the Baysox, and at least three hits in seven contests.

Rifaela Getting Hot: OF **Ademar Rifaela** has been on fire during the Baysox current homestand. In four games, Rifaela is 8-18 (.444) with seven RBI, three triples and a run scored. Rifaela picked up his 500th career hit in the Baysox win over New Hampshire on Thursday night.

Diaz on Fire: OF **Yusniel Diaz** has also had a massive homestand for the Baysox. In five games, the Orioles #2 prospect is 7-18 (.388) with three home runs, 10 RBI, seven runs scored and three walks. He also hit home runs in three consecutive games for the Baysox during the homestand. On Wednesday night, Diaz hit a two-run walkoff home run in the tenth inning. He followed that up with a three-run blast on Thursday and a solo shot on Friday night. It was the second time in Diaz's career that he homered in three consecutive games.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, 12 of the top 30 prospects in the organization are in Bowie. Outfielder **Yusniel Diaz** (#2), Outfielder **Austin Hays** (#5), Outfielder **Ryan McKenna** (#7), Left-Handed Pitcher **Zac Lowther** (#8) and Right-Handed Pitcher **Dean Kremer** (#9) rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers **Hunter Harvey** (#12), **Dillon Tate** (#17), **Zach Pop** (#20), **Alex Wells** (#26), Catcher **Brett Cumberland** (#24), Infielder **Rylan Bannon** (#23) and Infielder **Mason McCoy** (#30) round out the top prospects that are spending the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

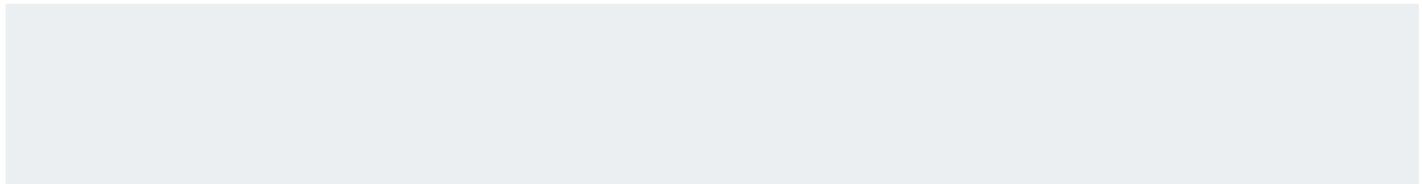
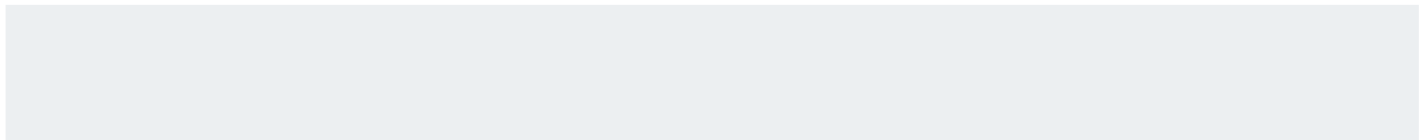
