In Case You Missed It: The Baysox clinched a winning road trip by defeating the Harrisburg Senators, 6-2, for their fourth straight win (and 13 of last 16). Jesse Valentin, Preston Palmeiro & T.J. Nichting combined to go 7-for-11 from the plate with two home runs, four runs scored and all 6 RBI, Alex Wells allowed one run in 5 1/3 IP to earn his fifth win, while Cristian Alvarado tossed 2 2/3 perfect relief innings.

Baysox Starter: RHP Dean Kremer makes his eighth start of the year and sixth with the Baysox today. Kremer is looking to bounce back from a Sunday afternoon loss against Trenton The Thunder struck for four runs over his final two innings of work to come from behind and give Kremer his fourth loss of the season. Today will be Kremer's 15th career AA start and 1st this season against Harrisburg. He comes in with a career AA record of 6-6 with a 3.22 ERA. He has struck out 94 batters in 81.0 career AA innings.

In the Other Corner: RHP Jackson Tetrault makes his first career start against the Baysox in his ninth career start at the Double-A level. The 7th round pick by Washington in the 2017 draft, Tetrault started this year in Class-A Advanced Potomac, making four starts with a 1.23 ERA before earning a call-up on 4/29. Since then, the righty is 2-2 with a 4.50 ERA, coming off a no-decision 6/16 vs. Reading (5 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 7 K). Tetrault is looking for his first win at FNB Field, having recorded three no-decisions in as many home starts.

Pitching Dominance: The Baysox pitching staff had its most dominant stretch of the season during the last series against New Hampshire. From the fourth inning on Wednesday until the fifth inning on Thursday, Bruce Zimmermann, Cristian Alvarado, Zach Muckenhirn and Marcos Molina combined to retire 31 consecutive Fisher Cats hitters.

McCoy's Impact: INF Mason McCoy has had an undeniable impact on the Baysox since being called-up from High-Á Frederick on May 6. Bowie began the year 7-23, but has posted an 26-15 record since McCoy joined the roster. In 40 games with the Baysox, McCoy is hitting .320 with a home run, 11 RBI, 54 hits, 25 runs, seven doubles, four triples and three stolen bases. McCoy also has 17 multi-hit games with the Baysox, and at least three hits in eight contests.

Rifaela Getting Hot: OF Ademar Rifaela has been on fire since the last Baysox homestand. In seven games, Rifaela is 13-31 (.419) with nine RBI, three triples, a home run and 2 runs scored. Rifaela picked up his 500th career hit in the Baysox win over New Hampshire on Thursday night. This hot streak earned Rifaela a promotion to Triple-A Norfolk on June 20.

Diaz on Fire: OF Yusniel Diaz also had a massive homestand for the Baysox, leading to an Eastern League Player of the Week honor. In seven games, the Orioles #2 prospect is 10-27 (.370) with three home runs, 12 RBI, 8 runs scored and 3 walks. He also hit home runs in three consecutive games for the Baysox during the homestand. On Wednesday night, Diaz hit a two-run walkoff home run in the tenth inning. He followed that up with a threerun blast lastThursday and a solo shot the following Friday night. It was the second time in Diaz's career that he homered in three consecutive games.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, 12 of the top 30 prospects in the organization are in Bowie. Outfielder Yusniel Diaz (#2), Outfielder Austin Hays (#5), Outielder Ryan McKenna (#7), Left-Handed Pitcher Zac Lowther (#8) and Right-Handed Pitcher Dean Kremer (#9) rank in the Orioles' top ten. Pitchers Hunter Harvey (#12), Dillon Tate (#17), Zach Pop (#20), Alex Wells (#26), Catcher Brett Cumberland (#24), Infielder Rylan Bannon (#23) and Infielder Mason McCoy (#30) round out the top prospects that are spenidng the 2019 campaign with the Baysox.

The Buck Starts Here: 2019 marks Buck Britton's first season as manager of the Bowie Baysox. Britton replaces Gary Kendall, who was the head man in Bowie from 2011-2018. Britton picked up his first victory as a AA manager on April 7 against the Harrisburg Senators. Last season, Britton managed the Delmarva Shorebirds, leading the club to a 68-66 record. Prior to getting into coaching, Britton played nine seasons in Minor League Baseball, and spent parts of 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014 with the Baysox. Buck is the brother of former Baysox and Orioles' left-hander Zack Britton.

This Day in Baysox History: Jonathan Schoop homered and drove in three runs to lead the Baysox to a 6-0 shutout win over the Trenton Thunder at Prince George's Stadium on June 22, 2015.
