In Case You Missed It: T.J. Nichting's two-run go-ahead inside the park home run in the eighth inning carried the Baysox to a 4-3 series-clinching win over Hartford last night. The Yard Goats scored three runs in the top of the first inning, but were held off the board the rest of the game by Alex Wells and Dillon Tate. Trailing 3-0 out of the gate, the Baysox slowly chipped away. In the bottom of the first, Bowie scored a run on a sacrifice fly from Jesmuel Valentin. The Baysox added another run in the sixth on an RBI single from Valentin. Then in the eight with two outs and a runner on, Nichting hit a ball off the wall in center field and made it all the way around the bases, scoring the go-ahead run.

**Baysox Starter: RHP Dean Kremer** will make his ninth start of the year for the Baysox today. Kremer is coming off an excellent outing in Harrisburg last Saturday, where he pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, striking out eight. Kremer has not allowed a run in two of his last three starts, including a 7.0 inning performance against New Hampshire on June 11. After leading all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts in 2018, Kremer has returned to that form over his last three starts, striking out 25 batters in his last 18.0 innings, including at least eight in each start.

In the Other Corner: RHP Jake Paulson is on the mound for the RubberDucks today, making his 13th appearance and 12th start of the season. Paulson's last start came with Triple-A Columbus on June 22, and he allowed four earned runs in 5.0 innings and took the loss. Paulson's last Eastern League start came against Portland on June 16, where he yielded four earned run in 3.0 innings and took the loss. Prior to that, Paulson had consecutive scoreless outings against Hartford (3.2 IP) and Reading (7 IP). This will Paukson's third start of the season against the Baysox. In his prior two, he has a 1-1 record and has allowed three earned runs in 11.0 innings, good for a 2.45 ERA. Paulson led the Eastern League in 2018 with an ERA of 3.04 in 115.1 innings.

**Red Hot Baysox:** Over the last few weeks, the Baysox have been the hottest team in the Eastern League. Bowie comes into tonight winners of seven of nine, and seven consecutive series. The Baysox have also won 14 of the last 17 games and 17 of the last 22 contests.

Carrying the Load: Last night's victory over Hartford was the second time in less than a week in which OF T.J. Nichting and INF Jesmuel Valentin accounted for all of the Baysox RBIs in a win. Last Friday, both Nichting and Valentin homered and drove in three runs in a 6-2 win in Harrisburg. Last night, Valentin drove in the first two runs of the game, while Nichting hit a two-run, go-ahead inside the park home run the eigth inning. Valentin currently owns a ten-game hit streak, the longest for any Baysox player this year. Nichting has homered in three of his last six games, after hitting only one home run in his first 56 games.

A Move Can Do You Well: RHP Hunter Harvey and RHP Dillon Tate have been dominant since moving into the Baysox bullpen. In 16.1 releif innings, Tate has posted a 1.65 ERA and has struck out 15 batters. Harvey has pitched 9.0 innings without allowing a run out of the bullpen, yielded just one hit and struck out 11 batters. Both Harvey and Tate have picked up their first career saves over the last week.

**Resting the Pen:** The Baysox received excellent length from their starters during the series win against Hartford. In each of the games, Bowie only had to use one relief pitcher. **Marcos Molina** and **Zac Lowther** eached pitched 6.0 innings in the first two games of the series, while Alex Wells made it through 7.0 frames in the series finale.

**All-Stars: INF Mason McCoy, INF Rylan Bannon, LHP Zac Lowther** and **LHP Alex Wells** were all named Eastern League All-Stars on Monday. McCoy is currently the Eastern League leader in hitting with a .332 batting average, while Bannon has drive in 27 runs. Lowther and Wells each rank in the top five in the Eastern League in ERA and have eached taken home an Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honor.

**McCoy's Impact: INF Mason McCoy** joined the Baysox on May 6 before a series in Altoona, and the team has taken off since his addition. At the time McCoy was added to the roster, Bowie was 7-23. Since then, the club is 29-17, and has three winning streaks of at least four games. In 45 games, McCoy is batting .332 with one home run, 13 RBI, 30 runs, nine doubles, four triples, 18 walks and four stolen bases. Hit .332 batting average leads the Eastern League by 30 points. McCoy has reached base in 37 of the 45 games he has played with Bowie, and has 19 multi-hit games, compared to only ten contests in which he has not recorded a hit.

**This Day in Baysox History:** Weather has not treated the Baysox well on June 27. Bowie was rained out three consecutive years on June 27, from 2006-2008. Luckily, tonight's forecast is 87 degrees and sunny for first pitch time in Bowie.
