In Case You Missed It: The Baysox won their fourth consecutive game last night, securing a 3-2 victory over the Akron RubberDucks in the second game of a four-game set. After allowing a run in the top of the third, Bowie struck back, scoring once in the fourth, fifth, and sixth. **Jesmeul Valentin** kicked things off for the Baysox, lacing an RBI double to left. The next inning, **Ryan McKenna** knocked a 2-out RBI triple before **Rylan Bannon** capped off the night offensively with a convincing line drive home run in the sixth. After six strong innings from **Bruce Zimmermann**, **Zach Muckenhin** and **Cristian Alvarado** came in to shut the door, combining for three shutout innings in relief. For Alvarado, it was his first AA save.

Baysox Starter: **RHP Marcos Molina** gets the ball for the Baysox today, making his 14th start of the year. Last time out, Molina took the loss against Hartford, allowing three earned runs over six innings. However, three of Molina's last four starts have been quality starts (at least 6 IP and no more than 3 ER), highlighted by his June 13 performance versus New Hampshire in which he scattered three earned runs over seven innings and punched out five. Tonight, Molina makes his second start of the season against the RubberDucks. On May 30, Molina went pitched 5.1 innings against Akron at Prince George's Stadium, allowing three earned runs on five hits in a losing effort.

In the Other Corner: **RHP Eli Morgan** will be making his 10th start of the season for the RubberDucks today. Morgan owns a flawless 5-0 record through nine previous starts for the RubberDucks with an impressive 2.31 ERA. He has yet to allow more than two earned runs in a single start this season. In his last outing, Morgan was credited with a no decision against Harrisburg, despite allowing only two earned runs over six innings. Tonight will be Morgan's first start against the Baysox. The 23-year-old right hander was the Indians' 8th round selection of the 2017 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga.

Tied for First: The Baysox have gotten out to a fast start in the second half of the Eastern League campaign, winning eight of their first ten games. With their 3-2 win last night, Bowie currently sits in a tie with Erie atop the EL Western Division. Overall, Bowie has won nine of their last eleven, and 16 of their last 19 games.

Valentin Keeps it Going: With his RBI double last night, **INF Jesmeul Valentin** extended his hitting streak to 12 games, the longest of any Baysox player this season. Over that span, the Baysox infielder has batted .465 (20 for 43) with four extra-base hits and 10 RBIs.

Instant Relief: After another shutdown performance, the bullpen has now gone five consecutive games and 17.1 IP without allowing an earned run. **RHP Hunter Harvey** has been a force since transitioning to the bullpen, recording three consecutive scoreless appearances and allowing just one hit in his last nine innings in relief. **RHP Dillon Tate** has also been outstanding out of the pen of late, registering three consecutive scoreless appearances of his own and earning the win on June 26 versus Hartford. **RHP Cristian Alvarado**, who notched his first AA save last night, also extended his scoreless innings streak to 11.2. Over that time, he has allowed just three hits, walked none, and struck out 11.

Bannon's Boomstick Returns: Rylan Bannon's solo home run last night was his fifth of the season and his first since May 2 against Erie. In addition to his five homers, Bannon has doubled 17 times and drawn 33 walks on the campaign, both tops on the club.

All-Stars: **INF Mason McCoy**, **INF Rylan Bannon**, **LHP Zac Lowther** and **LHP Alex Wells** were all named Eastern League All-Stars on Monday. McCoy is currently the Eastern League leader in hitting with a .330 batting average, while Bannon has drive in 28 runs. Lowther and Wells each rank in the top five in the Eastern League in ERA and have each taken home an Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honor.

McCoy's Impact: **INF Mason McCoy** joined the Baysox on May 6 before a series in Altoona, and the team has taken off since his addition. At the time McCoy was added to the roster, Bowie was 7-23. Since then, the club is 31-17, and has four winning streaks of at least four games. In 47 games, McCoy is batting .330 with one home run, 13 RBI, 33 runs, nine doubles, four triples, 19 walks and four stolen bases. His .330 batting average leads the Eastern League by 20 points. McCoy has reached base in 40 of the 47 games he has played with Bowie, and has 20 multi-hit games, compared to only eleven contests in which he has not recorded a hit.

This Day in Baysox History: On June 29, 2017, the Baysox defeated the Altoona Curve by a score of 9-3 at Prince George's Stadium. While Austin Hays homered twice and drove in four, Austin Wynns and Chris O'Brien each added home runs of their own to power the offense. A rehabbing Zach Britton earned the win after tossing one scoreless
