In Case You Missed It: The Baysox mashed five home runs in a 6-2 win over Hartford on Tuesday night. The win clinched a ninth consecutive series victory for Bowie. **Jesmuel Valentin** got things going in the second inning, hitting a two-run home run. Two batters later, **Preston Palmeiro** hit his fourth long ball of the season. In the third innings **Ryan McKenna** and **Carlos Perez** each hit solo home runs, pushing the Baysox to a 5-0 advantage. The game remained 5-0 until the ninth inning, when McKenna hit his second home run of the game, and team-leading ninth of the season. On the mound, **Dean Kremer** tied a career-high with a 7.0 scoreless inning performance, and picked up his fourth win of the season.

Baysox Starter: RHP **Mike Baumann** will make the first Double-A start of his career today for the Baysox. This will be Baumann's third appearance with Bowie, with his first two coming out of the bullpen. Baumann pitched 2.0 scoreless innings in Harrisburg in his Baysox debut, and followed that up with a 4.0 scoreless innings performance against Akron last week, and earned his first career save. Baumann made 11 starts with Advanced-A Frederick to start the season, and started the Carolina League All-Star Game. At the time of his promotion to Bowie on June 21, Baumann was leading the Carolina League in strikeouts with 77 in just 54.0 innings of work. Baumann was the Orioles' third round pick in the 2017 MLB Draft out of the University of Jacksonville, and is currently ranked as the 24th best prospect in the Baltimore organization by MLB.com.

In the Other Corner: LHP **Jack Wynkoop** is making his 17th start of the season for the Yard Goats tonight. Wynkoop is the Eastern League leader in innings pitched at 101.0, and is one of five pitchers in the league that has started 16 games this season. Wynkoop was very solid in his last start against Richmond, firing 7.0 innings and allowing just three earned runs. In the start before that, Wynkoop pitched 8.0 innings against Altoona, but allowed 15 hits, the most any Eastern League pitcher has allowed in a game this season. Wynkoop has pitched at least 7.0 innings in each of his last six starts. This will be Wynkoop's third start of the year against the Baysox. In his prior two outings against Bowie, Wynkoop in 1-1 and has allowed just three earned runs in 15.0 innings.

Red Hot Baysox: Over the last few weeks, the Baysox have been the hottest team in the Eastern League. Bowie comes into tonight winners of seven of eight, 12 of 15, 17 of 22 and 24 of the last 28 games. After taking the first two games of this series in Hartford, the Baysox have now won nine consecutive series. The Baysox currently sit one game behind Erie for first place in the Western Division. With an overall record of 41-41, Bowie sits at .500 for the first time since opening day.

A June to Remember: The Baysox 20-7 record in June was the best record of any month in franchise history. During the month, the Baysox led the Eastern League in batting average, runs, RBIs, hits, total bases, doubles, on-base percentage, OPS and struck out fewer times than any team in the league. On the mound, Bowie led the Eastern League in WHIP, batting average against, allowed the fewest hits and had the second best ERA in the league.

Mac Attack: OF **Ryan McKenna** has found his power stroke over that last five games. Over that stretch, McKenna is 8-19 (.421) with four home runs, 10 RBIs, five runs scored and has three multi-hit games. Last night, McKenna became just the third Baysox player with a multi-home run game this season. McKenna currently ranks second in the Eastern League in runs scored (49) and leads the Baysox in home runs (9) and RBI (37).

Finding the Power: The Baysox have been leaving the yard with regularity during this series in Hartford. Bowie has mashed nine home runs over the first two games, both victories. **Ryan McKenna** has led the way with three long balls, while **Yusniel Diaz**, **Mason McCoy**, **Preston Palmeiro**, **T.J. Nichting**, **Carlos Perez** and **Jesmuel Valentin** have each gone deep once.

All-Stars: INF **Mason McCoy**, INF **Rylan Bannon**, LHP **Zac Lowther** and LHP **Alex Wells** were all named Eastern League All-Stars on Monday. McCoy is currently the Eastern League leader in hitting with a .326 batting average, while Bannon has drive in 28 runs. Lowther and Wells each rank in the top five in the Eastern League in ERA and have each taken home an Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honor.

This Day in Baysox History: On July 3, 2015, **Terry Doyle** pitched a complete game two-hit shutout in the Baysox 7-0 win over Akron. Doyle's nine-inning complete game shutout that day was the last for a Baysox pitcher before **Bruce Zimmermann** accomplished that feat on June 18 of this season in Hartford.

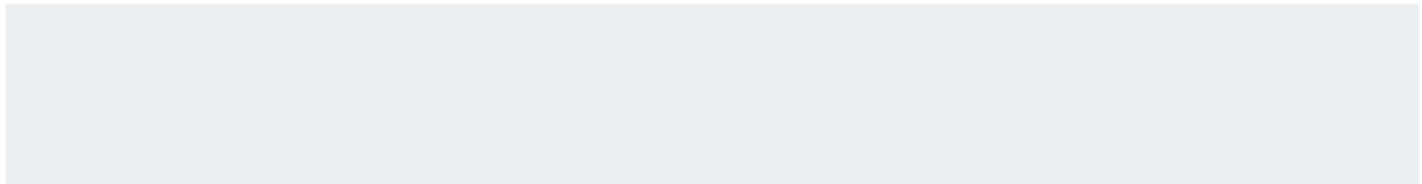
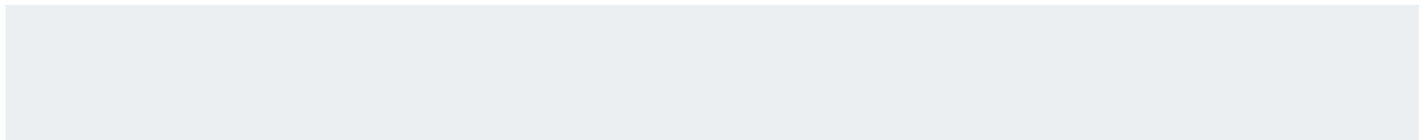
