In Case You Missed It: The Baysox earned their biggest shutout victory of the season, a 13-0 decision over the Harrisburg Senators in the series opener on Thursday night. Bowie put the game away in the first inning, scoring five times thanks to home runs from **Yusniel Diaz**, **Rylan Bannon** and **Jesmeul Valentin**. Bowie added two more runs in the second on an error, and three more in the third on a two-run double from **Ryan McKenna** and a sacrifice fly from Diaz. **Bruce Zimmermann** started for Bowie and threw 7.0 scoreless innings, lowering his ERA for the season to 2.52. The Baysox added three more runs in the eighth for good measure. McKenna, Diaz and Bannon each had RBIs in the inning to help put the finishing touches on the 13-0 win.

Baysox Starter: LHP Zac Lowther will become the first Baysox pitcher to start 16 games this year when he takes the mound this evening. Lowther, an Eastern League All-Star, enters this outing with a 2.46 ERA, good for fourth in the Eastern League and second among active pitchers. Lowther struggled in his last start at home against Akron, taking the loss and allowing five runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings. Prior to that, Lowther had won four consecutive starts. Today will be Lowther's third start of the year against the Senators, after pitching against them on April 7 and April 14. In those two outings, Lowther was 1-0 and allowed just two earned runs in 9.0 innings.

In the Other Corner: RHP Steven Fuentes will make his eighth start and 12th appearance of the season for the Senators today. The 22-year-old has been outstanding this season, posting a 1.80 ERA in 45.0 innings while striking out 43 batters. Fuentes' last outing came on June 30 against Erie when he tossed 6.0 innings allowing two runs on five hits. Fuentes had a dominant outing in his prior start, throwing 7.0 scoreless innings against Akron and striking out seven. Fuentes began this season in Advanced-A Potomac and posted a 0.53 ERA in eight relief appearances before being promoted to Harrisburg on May 8. Fuentes was originally signed by the Nationals as an international free agent in 2013 out of Panama.

Red Hot Baysox: Over the last few weeks, the Baysox have been the hottest team in the Eastern League. Since the beginning of June, Bowie has posted a remarkable 23-8 record, and has now won nine consecutive series.

A June to Remember: The Baysox 20-7 record in June was the best record of any month in franchise history. During the month, the Baysox led the Eastern League in batting average, runs, RBIs, hits, total bases, doubles, on-base percentage, OPS and struck out fewer times than any team in the league. On the mound, Bowie led the Eastern League in WHIP, batting average against, allowed the fewest hits and had the second best ERA in the league.

Mac Attack: OF Ryan McKenna has found his power stroke over that last seven games. Over that stretch, McKenna is 11-28 (.393) with four home runs, 13 RBIs, seven runs scored and has four multi-hit games. Tuesday night, McKenna became just the third Baysox player with a multi-home run game this season. McKenna currently leads the Eastern League in runs scored (51), leads the Baysox in RBI (40) and is tied for the team lead in home runs (9).

Finding the Power: Over the last four games, the Baysox have outperformed their opponent 13-0. Bowie blasted nine home runs over the first two games of the series in Hartford, and followed that with three first inning home runs last night. The Baysox have also hit back-to-back home runs four times in the last six days. During that stretch, **Ryan McKenna** has hit three home runs and **Yusniel Diaz** and **Jesmeul Valentin** have each homered twice to lead the way.

All-Stars: INF Mason McCoy, INF Rylan Bannon, LHP Zac Lowther and LHP Alex Wells were all named Eastern League All-Stars on Monday. McCoy is currently second in the Eastern League in hitting with a .323 batting average, while Bannon has driven in 31 runs. Lowther and Wells each rank in the top five in the Eastern League in ERA and have each taken home an Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honor.

Lefty Trio: LHPs Alex Wells, Zac Lowther and Bruce Zimmermann have been dominant forces in the Baysox starting rotation this season. Each of them has an ERA of 2.53 or better, and ranks in the top six in the Eastern League. Among pitchers that are still active on Eastern League rosters, Wells, Lowther and Zimmermann ranked first, second and third in the league in ERA. Wells and Lowther have each won an Eastern League Pitcher of the Week award while on June 18, Zimmermann tossed the first complete game shutout for a Baysox pitcher since 2015.

This Day in History: On July 5, 2008, **Steve Torrealba** hit a pinch-hit, go-ahead grand slam in the bottom of the eighth inning to lead the Baysox to a 6-4 win over Erie.
