In Case You Missed It: The Baysox went into the All-Star break on a high note, defeating the Harrisburg Senators 7-5 to complete a four-game sweep. Harrisburg scored the first run of the game in the top of the second inning, but Bowie answered right back with three runs in the bottom of that inning. **Preston Palmeiro** and **Mason McCoy** each had RBI walks, and **DJ Stewart** drove in a run with a fielder's choice. The Senators made it 3-2 with a run in the third, but the Baysox exploded for four runs in the fourth innings to break the game open. Stewart had a two-run single and **Yusniel Diaz** also brought in two runs with a hit in the inning. **Dean Kremer** won his fourth straight start for Bowie and **Dillon Tate** picked up his third save of the season.

Baysox Starter: RHP Mike Baumann will make his second start and fourth appearance in a Baysox uniform tonight. Baumann's first start came on July 3 in Hartford, where he pitched 6.0 innings and allowed just one run but took the loss. Prior to that, Baumann pitched twice out of the bullpen for Bowie and combined to throw 6.0 scoreless innings. Baumann began the season with Advanced-A Frederick and made 11 starts with the Keys before being promoted to Bowie on June 21. Baumann started the Carolina League All-Star Game and was leading the Carolina League in strikeouts at the time of his promotion.

In the Other Corner: RHP Danny Salazar will be making an MLB rehab start for the RubberDucks today. Salazar is rehabbing from right shoulder surgery that cost him all of the 2018 season and all of 2019 to date. Salazar has not pitched in a major league game since the 2017 American League Division Series against the Yankees. The 29-year-old has pitched five major league seasons and compiled a 38-33 record with a 3.82 ERA. Salazar was an American League All-Star in 2015 with the Indians. Salazar spent parts of 2012 and 2013 with Akron, and made a rehab start with the RubberDucks in 2017.

Red Hot Baysox: Over the last few weeks, the Baysox have been the hottest team in the Eastern League. Since the beginning of June, Bowie has posted a remarkable 26-8 record, and has now won ten consecutive series. The Baysox entered the All-Star break with a 1.5-game lead over Erie in the Western Division.

McKenna Named Player of the Week: OF Ryan McKenna was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for the period spanning July 1-July 7. During that stretch, McKenna was 9-26 (.346) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBIs, seven runs scored, three walks and two stolen bases. McKenna currently leads the Eastern League in runs scored, and became the fourth Baysox player to take home an Eastern League weekly award this season. **Zac Lowther** and **Alex Wells** have each won Pitcher of the Week awards while **Yusniel Diaz** earned a Player of the Week nod.

Orioles Minor League Players of the Month: INF Mason McCoy and LHP Alex Wells have been named the Orioles Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for June. During the month, McCoy was 35-112 (.313) with four RBIs, 19 runs, six doubles, one triple, 11 walks and three stolen bases. Wells made five starts in June and went 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA in 32.0 innings of work.

League Leaders: The Baysox went into the All-Star break with four players leading in Eastern League categories. On the mound, **Alex Wells** leads the league with a 1.92 ERA and **Zac Lowther** is tied for the league lead in wins with nine. **Mason McCoy** is the Eastern League leader in batting average at .319 and **Ryan McKenna** is pacing the league with 52 runs scored.

A June to Remember: The Baysox 20-7 record in June was the best record of any month in franchise history. During the month, the Baysox led the Eastern League in batting average, runs, RBIs, hits, total bases, doubles, on-base percentage, OPS and struck out fewer times than any team in the league. On the mound, Bowie led the Eastern League in WHIP, batting average against, allowed the fewest hits and had the second best ERA in the league.

All-Star Game: The Baysox were well-represented at the 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game Wednesday night in Richmond--a game which saw the Western Division defeat the Eastern Division, 5-0. **Mason McCoy** and **Rylan Bannon** combined to go 2-for-4 with two doubles and a run scored from the plate, while LHPs **Zac Lowther** and **Alex Wells** tossed a collective 2 scoreless innings, allowing two walks and striking out two batters.

This Day in History: On July 11, 2013, **Aaron Baker** hit two home runs and had six RBIs as the Baysox beat the Richmond Flying Squirrels 10-1.
