In Case You Missed It: The Baysox went into the All-Star break on a high note & continued that tune in the first game since Sunday. **Michael Baumann** earned his first career Double-A win by allowing one hit over six scoreless innings with nine strikeouts. **Jay Flaa** and **Dillon Tate** combined to close out the 3-0 win in Akron. Offensively, **Cedric Mullins** knocked in the first run of the game off rehabbing Indian Danny Salazar, while **Carlos Perez** homered to lead off the fourth inning en route to a 3-hit, 2-RBI night.

Baysox Starter: **LHP Bruce Zimmermann** will make his 15th start of the season for the Baysox today. Zimmermann earned a win in his last start at home against Akron, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing just two runs and striking out six. Zimmermann's previous start was on June 23 in Harrisburg, when he allowed three earned runs in 4.0 innings and was dealt just his second loss of the season. Zimmermann enters this start with a 2.75 ERA, which ranks seventh in the Eastern League, and fourth among pitchers on active Eastern League rosters. The 24-year-old has had a number of standout performances this season, including a complete game four-hit shutout in Hartford on June 18 and an 11-strikeout game at home against Richmond on May 10. Today will mark the 26th Double-A start of Zimmermann's career, (20th with Bowie, 6 with Mississippi) and he is 7-6 with a tremendous 3.22 ERA at the level.

In the Other Corner: **LHP Adam Scott** makes his fifth start of the year for Akron today. Scott, a 23-year-old lefty, began the year in High-A Lynchburg and posted a 3.45 ERA in 12 starts before earning a promotion to Akron. Scott struggled in his first start with the RubberDucks, allowing six earned run in 5.2 innings in Reading on June 20. In his last start against Bowie, the Scott silenced the Baysox by allowing two hits over 5 2/3 scoreless innings.

Red Hot Baysox: Over the last few weeks, the Baysox have been the hottest team in the Eastern League. Since the beginning of June, Bowie has posted a remarkable 27-8 record, and has now won 10 consecutive series. The Baysox entered the All-Star break with a 1.5-game lead over Erie in the Western Division.

McKenna Named Player of the Week: **OF Ryan McKenna** was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for the period spanning July 1-July 7. During that stretch, McKenna was 9-26 (.346) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBIs, seven runs scored, three walks and two stolen bases. McKenna currently leads the Eastern League in runs scored, and became the fourth Baysox player to take home an Eastern League weekly award this season. **Zac Lowther** and **Alex Wells** have each won Pitcher of the Week awards while **Yusniel Diaz** earned a Player of the Week nod.

Orioles Minor League Players of the Month: **INF Mason McCoy** and **LHP Alex Wells** have been named the Orioles Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for June. During the month, McCoy was 35-112 (.313) with four RBIs, 19 runs, six doubles, one triple, 11 walks and three stolen bases. Wells made five starts in June and went 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA in 32.0 innings of work.

League Leaders: The Baysox went into the All-Star break with four players leading in Eastern League categories. On the mound, **Alex Wells** leads the league with a 1.92 ERA and **Zac Lowther** is tied for the league lead in wins with nine. **Mason McCoy** is the Eastern League leader in batting average at .319 and **Ryan McKenna** is pacing the league with 52 runs scored. Also, McCoy leads ALL of baseball (MLB and MiLB) in hits with 118--one ahead of Kansas City's Whit Merrifield.

A June to Remember: The Baysox 20-7 record in June was the best record of any month in franchise history. During the month, the Baysox led the Eastern League in batting average, runs, RBIs, hits, total bases, doubles, on-base percentage, OPS and struck out fewer times than any team in the league. On the mound, Bowie led the Eastern League in WHIP, batting average against, allowed the fewest hits and had the second best ERA in the league.

All-Star Game: The Baysox were well-represented at the 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game Wednesday night in Richmond--a game which saw the Western Division defeat the Eastern Division, 5-0. **Mason McCoy** and **Rylan Bannon** combined to go 2-for-4 with two doubles and a run scored from the plate, while LHPs **Zac Lowther** and **Alex Wells** tossed a collective 2 scoreless innings, allowing two walks and striking out two batters.

This Day in History: Down 5-1 heading into the ninth inning, the Baysox exploded for six runs in their final at-bats to win a 7-5 thriller and stun the host Reading Fightin' Phils on July 12, 2018..
