In Case You Missed It: Down to their final out, the Baysox mounted a 9th-inning rally to take a late lead. Rylan Bannon's double was followed on the next pitch by a 2-run home run from Jesmuel Valentin to put the guests back on top. Akron tied the game with a run in the bottom of the ninth, but that allowed Preston Palmeiro to play hero, grounding a 10th-inning single to score Willy Yahn. Luis Gonzalez tossed a scoreless 10th to nail down a back-and-forth 6-5 win to secure at least a series split, and a 6th straight win for the club.

Baysox Starter: RHP Dean Kremer is on the mound for the Baysox today, making his 10th start of 2019 in a Bowie uniform. Kremer won his fourth consecutive start Sunday to help sweep the Harrisburg Senators at Prince George's Stadium. Over has last four outings, Kremer has allowed just five earned runs in 22.1 innings, good for a 2.01 ERA. Today will be the 19th double-A start of Kremer's career, and he is 10-6 with a 2.96 ERA in 103.1 innings at the level.

In the Other Corner: LHP Adam Scott makes his fifth start of the year for Akron today. Scott, a 23-year-old lefty, began the year in High-A Lynchburg and posted a 3.45 ERA in 12 starts before earning a promotion to Akron. Scott struggled in his first start with the RubberDucks, allowing six earned run in 5.2 innings in Reading on June 20. In his last start against Bowie, the Scott silenced the Baysox by allowing two hits over 5 2/3 scoreless innings.

Red Hot Baysox: Over the last few weeks, the Baysox have been the hottest team in the Eastern League. Since the beginning of June, Bowie has posted a remarkable 28-8 record, and has now won 10 consectuive series. The Baysox entered the All-Star break with a 1.5-game lead over Erie in the Western Division.

McKenna Named Player of the Week: OF Ryan McKenna was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for the period spanning July 1-July 7. During that stretch, McKenna was 9-26 (.346) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBIs, seven runs scored, three walks and two stolen bases. McKenna currently leads the Eastern League in runs scored, and became the fourth Baysox player to take home an Eastern League weekly award this season. Zac Lowther and Alex Wells have each won Pitcher of the Week awards while Yusniel Diaz earned a Player of the Week nod.

Orioles Minor League Players of the Month: INF Mason McCoy and LHP Alex Wells have been named the Orioles Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for June. During the month, McCoy was 35-112 (.313) with four RBIs, 19 runs, six doubles, one triple, 11 walks and three stolen bases. Wells made five starts in June and went 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA in 32.0 innings of work.

League Leaders: The Baysox went into the All-Star break with four players leading in Eastern League categories. On the mound, Alex Wells leads the league with a 1.92 ERA and Zac Lowther is tied for the league lead in wins with nine. **Mason McCoy** is the Eastern League leader in batting average at .315 and **Ryan McKenna** is pacing the league with 52 runs scored. Also, McCoy leads ALL of baseball (MLB and MiLB) in hits with 119--one ahead of Kansas City's Whit Merrifield.

A June to Remember: The Baysox 20-7 record in June was the best record of any month in franchise history. During the month, the Baysox led the Eastern League in batting average, runs, RBIs, hits, total bases, doubles, on-base percentage, OPS and struck out fewer times than any team in the league. On the mound, Bowie led the Eastern League in WHIP, batting average against, allowed the fewest hits and had the second best ERA in the league.

All-Star Game: The Baysox were well-represented at the 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game Wednesday night in Richmond--a game which saw the Western Division defeat the Eastern Division, 5-0. Mason McCoy and Rylan Bannon combined to go 2-for-4 with two doubles and a run scored from the plate, while LHPs Zac Lowther and Alex Wells tossed a collective 2 scoreless innings, allowing two walks and striking out two batters.

This Day in History: Caleb Joseph went 2-for-4 with a homer and 5 RBI, while Tyler Wilson and Zech Zinicola combined for a 1-hit shutout as the Baysox blanked Richmond, 13-0, on July 13, 2013.
