In Case You Missed It: The Baysox mustered only three hits, but they scored the only run of the game on a Carlos Perez double in the 7th inning to earn a 1-0 win in the series opener against Altoona. Dean Kremer won his fifth start in his last 6 by shutting out the Curve over seven strong innings, scattering six hits and striking out eight. Jay Flaa struck out three batters in the final two innings to earn his first Bowie save of the season.

**Baysox Starter: Baysox Starter: LHP Zac Lowther** is on the mound for the Baysox today, making his 18th start of the season. In his last outing, Lowther threw 6 2/3 no-hit innings before allowing one hit and one run. The lefty struck out eight RubberDucks at Canal Park in what was his 5th start against Akron. Lowther has only faced Altoona once this season: a loss on May 7 (6 IP, 7 H, 3 R (2 ER), BB, 4 K). The lefty is the Eastern League leader in wins, having earned his 10th victory in his home state of Ohio.

**In the Other Corner: LHP Domingo Robles** makes his 10th start of the season at the Double-A level after going 5-5 with a 2.61 ERA in 10 starts with Class-A Advanced Bradenton to begin 2019. Robles has allowed three or more runs in four of his past six starts—including four earned runs in six innings at Erie on July 14. The lefty is 0-1 with a 7.36 ERA away from People's Natural Gas Field has yet to win a start in the month of July (0-1, 6.08 ERA in three starts).

**Baumann Makes History: RHP Mike Baumann** pitched just the third nine-inning no-hitter in Baysox history in the win over Harrisburg Tuesday night. Baumann was absolutely dominant, walking just two batters in the game and facing one over the minimum while striking out ten. Baumann has now made five appearances and three starts as a member of the Baysox and is 2-1 with one save and a 0.33 ERA in 27.0 innings. He is currently working on an 18.1 inning scoreless streak.

**Red Hot Baysox:** Over the last month and a half, the Baysox have been the hottest team in the Eastern League. Since the beginning of June, Bowie has posted a remarkable 32-10 record, and has now won 12 consectuive series. The Baysox set a franchise record by going 20-7 in June, and have begun July 12-3. Bowie currently holds a 1.5game lead over Erie for first place in the Western Division.

**McKenna Swiping Bags: OF Ryan McKenna** stole six bases in the three-game series against Harrisburg. McKenna stole two bases on Monday, followed that up with a career-high three swiped bags on Tuesday and stole another base on Wednesday. McKenna now has a team-leading 17 stolen bases on the year and is eighth in the Eastern League in that category.

The Alex Wells Experience: LHP Alex Wells has had an incredible first Double-A season thus far. Wells is currently leading the Eastern League with a 1.95 ERA, and has the best winning percentage (.890) in the league with an 8-1 record. Wells also ranks second in the Eastern League with a WHIP of 1.00 and fourth with a batting average against of . 216. Wells has already been an Eastern League All-Star, won an Eastern League Pitcher of the Week Award and been named the Orioles' Minor League Pitcher of the Month for June.

**Lowther Takes League Lead: LHP Zac Lowther** became the first pitcher in the Eastern League to win 10 games when he defeated Akron on Sunday. Lothwer had a no-hitter through 6 2/3 innings in that start, the longest no-hit bid for any Baysox pitcher this season. Along with leading the league in wins, Lowther also ranks at the top of the Eastern League in batting average against (.191), and is in the top ten in strikeouts (6th), innings (10th), WHIP (8th) and winning percentage (T-3rd).

**Alvarado on a Roll: RHP Cristian Alvarado** has become a dominant force out of the Baysox bullpen. Over his last nine outings, Alvarado has allowed just one run in 20.1 innings. He has yielded just nine hits and struck out 19 batters in that span. Alvarado has converted all three of his save opportunities this season, has a WHIP of 0.99 and is holding opponents to a .206 batting average. The 24-year-old is in his first season as a reliever after starting for the first seven years of his professional career.
