In Case You Missed It: The Baysox captured the opening game of the series against Reading with a 4-2 comeback win on Monday night. The Fightin Phils got out to an early 2-0 advantage in the fourth inning, before **Jesmuel Valentin** cut the deficit in half with an RBI single in the home half of the fourth. The game remained 2-1 Reading until the bottom of the eighth when Bowie put together a three-run rally. **Rylan Bannon** had a go-ahead two-run single and **Mason McCoy** added an RBI single of his own in the inning. The Baysox bullpen was outstanding on the night, as **Brian Gonzalez** and **Cristian Alvarado** combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings to seal the victory. With the win, Bowie remained tied atop the West Division with Erie, each with records of 28-10 in the second half.

Baysox Starter: LHP **Zac Lowther** will become the first Baysox pitcher with 20 starts this season when he takes the mound this evening. Lowther is coming off a solid start in Binghamton where he allowed just one run in 6.0 innings of work in a no-decision. Prior to that, Lowther had won three consecutive starts. Coming into this evening, Lowther is the Eastern League leader in wins (11) and batting average against (.190). He also ranks second in the league in ERA (2.57), fifth in strikeouts (100), sixth in innings pitched (105.0), tied for seventh in WHIP (1.12) and third in winning percentage (.690). Lowther was an Eastern League All-Star and has taken home an Eastern League Pitcher of the Week award this season. The 23-year-old has been a model of consistency, going at least 5.0 innings in 17 of his 19 starts and allowing three earned runs or less 16 times.

In the Other Corner: RHP **Jose Taveras** will make the start for Reading tonight. This will be Taveras' fifth start and seventh appearance of the season for the Fightin Phils. His last start was on July 24 against Binghamton, when he allowed two earned runs in 5.0 innings and earned the win. Taveras' prior six outings came with Triple-A Lehigh Valley, where he has pitched seven total times in 2019. The 25-year-old has struggled at the Triple-A level this season, posting an 8.15 ERA in 17.2 innings, but has a very solid 3.09 ERA in 23.1 innings with Reading. Taveras only made nine appearances in 2018 due to injury, with six of them coming with the Fightin Phils. Taveras also pitched twice with Reading in 2017, making today his 15th career appearance and 10th start in a Fightin Phils uniform.

Going for History (Again): After setting a franchise record by going 20-7 in June, the Baysox have begun the month of July 19-7. If Bowie can win the final two games of the series against Reading, it will re-set the franchise record for the best record in a month for the second consecutive month.

A Unique Win: The Baysox 4-2 win over Reading last night featured a few statistical oddities. Despite pounding out 12 hits in the game, Bowie did not have an extra-base hit on the night. Last night was also just the fifth time this season that the Baysox have won a game when trailing after seven innings.

Dominant Starting Pitching: Over the last 11 games, Baysox starters have combined to allow just 17 earned runs in 72.1 innings of work, good for a 2.12 ERA. Since July 3, only one time has a Baysox pitcher started a game and taken the loss.

Diaz on Fire : Since returning to the Baysox from the injured list on June 5, **OF Yusniel Diaz** has been one of the most productive hitters in the Eastern League. In 47 games, Diaz has nine home runs, 43 RBIs, 14 doubles and 32 runs scored. For the season, Diaz is now tied for eighth in the league with 50 RBIs, despite not playing between April 25 and June 5.

Perez's On-Base Streak: **C Carlos Perez** had a 27-game on-base streak come to an end on Saturday night. That streak was tied for the longest in the Eastern League this season. During the 27 games, Perez was 31-98 (.316) with eight home runs, 20 RBIs, 15 runs scored and a .384 on-base percentage. Perez has 10 home runs this season for the Baysox after not hitting more than six in any of the 11 previous seasons of his professional career.

Back-End Star: RHP **Cristian Alvarado** has been a dominant force in the back-end of the Baysox bullpen. Alvarado has allowed just three earned runs in 30.2 innings since June 4, good for a 0.88 ERA. Alvarado has three wins and three saves over that stretch.

Welcome to Double-A Cody: RHP **Cody Sedlock** has been nearly untouchable since being promoted from Advanced-A Frederick to Bowie on July 17. In 11.0 innings with the Baysox, Sedlock has yielded just one hit and no runs while striking out 15. Sedlock in holding opponents to an .031 batting average against and has not allowed a hit in his last 8.2 innings.

This Day in History: On July 30, 2017, the Baysox swept a doubleheader from Akron. **Austin Hays** had three hits, a home run and four RBIs on the day, while **Anthony Santander** went 4-6 with a home run and three RBIs across the two games.
