In Case You Missed It: Mike Baumann pitched a complete-game four-hit shutout as the Baysox defeated Richmond by a score of 4-0 last night. Baumann struck out seven and faced just two batters over the minimum in the victory. The Baysox got their first run of the night in the second inning when **Jesmuel Valentin** scored on an error. The lead was extended to 2-0 in the fourth when **Carlos Perez** drove in **Cedric Mullins** with an infield single. In the eighth, Perez hit a two-run home run, breaking a streak of 15 consecutive games without a long ball for Bowie.

Baysox Starter: RHP Tyler Herb will make the start for the Baysox today. It will be his seventh start of the year for Bowie and 23rd overall appearance for the 2019 season. Since returning to the Baysox on July 28 from Triple-A Norfolk, Herb has been nearly unhittable in his three starts. The 27-year-old is 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA in those outings, and has allowed just five hits in 19.0 innings, good for a .088 batting average against. This will be Herb's third start of the year against Richmond, including one that came last Friday where he earned the win. In those previous two starts against the Flying Squirrels, Herb has yielded just two earned runs in 11.0 innings. Herb was a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2017, making 10 starts with Richmond and pitching to a 2.76 ERA.

In the Other Corner: RHP Sean Hjelle will make the second Double-A start of his career today for the Flying Squirrels. Hjelle's debut with came last Saturday against the Baysox, where he retired 13 of the first 14 batters he faced before giving up a five-run fifth innings and taking the loss. The 22-year-old Hjelle has pitched at three different levels during the 2019 season. He began the year with Class-A Augusta where he posted a 2.66 ERA in nine starts. He then made 14 starts with Advanced-A San Jose where he recored a 2.78 ERA. In total, Hjelle has pitched 123.1 innings this season and has a very impressive 122/31 strikeout-to-walk ratio. Hjelle was the Giants second-round pick in the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of Kentucky. He stands 6-foot 11-inches, making him the tallest pitcher in Flying Squirrels history. If Hjelle reaches the major leagues, he will tie Jon Rauch as the tallest pitcher in MLB history.

Go The Distance: RHP Mike Baumann pitched his second nine-inning complete game of the season for the Baysox last night. He tossed a four-hit shutout against Richmond after pitching a nine-inning no-hitter against Harrisburg on July 16. Baumann is the first Baysox pitcher since **Terry Doyle** in 2015 to throw two nine-inning complete games in one season. Like Doyle, both of Baumann's complete games are shutouts. As a team, Bowie now has five complete games this season, more than any other club in the Eastern League.

Shutout Season: After last night's 4-0 win over Richmond, the Baysox now have 16 shutout victories this year, two more than any other team in the Eastern League. Bowie has also shutout Richmond six times in 17 games against them this season, and the Baysox pitching staff has not allowed a run in the last 18.0 innings of this series.

Career Year for Perez: C Carlos Perez is putting up the best power numbers of his 12-year professional career. So far this season in 78 games with the Baysox, Perez has 11 home runs and 46 RBI. Perez had never hit more than six home runs in a season prior to this year, and he sits just four RBI short of his career high of 50 which he reached in 2012.

Herb's Dominant Stretch: RHP Tyler Herb has been lights out for the Baysox in three starts since returning from Triple-A Norfolk. In those three outings, Herb is 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA in 19.0 innings. He has allowed just five hits in those 19.0 innings, good for a .088 batting average against.

Down the Stretch They Go: With less than three weeks left in the regular season, Bowie and Erie are in a tight race for the second-half West Division title. Erie currently has a 2.0-game lead and each team has 19 games remaining. After playing 18 games against each other in April and May, the Baysox and SeaWolves do not play each other again this season.

Baysox and Squirrels: Tonight's game between Bowie and Richmond in the final contest in a stretch where they play each other eight times in seven days. The Baysox won three of four in Richmond last weekend, and won two of three in this series in Bowie. The Baysox are 12-5 overall against Richmond during the 2019 season.

This Day in History: On August 15, 2015, **Aderlin Rodriguez** went 3-4 with five RBI as the Baysox beat Richmond 10-4. **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan McKenna** each had three hits in th win.
