In Case You Missed It: The Baysox offensive exploded for 11 runs and 14 hits in a series-opening 11-4 win over the Binghamton Rumble Ponies on Monday. Bowie fell behind 2-0 early, but broke out for a seven-run third inning to take a lead it would never relinquish. In the frame, Carlos Perez drew a bases loaded walk to get the Baysox on the board.

Jesmuel Valentin and Zach Jarrett followed with consecutive RBI doubles, and Preston Palmeiro hit a two-run home run. Bowie added to the lead with three runs in the sixth thanks to two Binghamton errors. In the eighth, Perez blasted his 13th home run of the season. On the night, the 4-7 hitters in the Baysox lineup (Perez, Valentin, Jarrett, Palmeiro) combined to go 8-17 with two home runs, nine RBIs and six runs scored. Bowie got great work from the bullpen, as Francisco Jimenez, Jay Flaa and Brian Gonzalez combined to throw 4.0 scoreless innings of relief.

Baysox Starter: RHP Tyler Herb will make his eighth start of the season for the Baysox today, and fifth since returning from Triple-A. In his last start, Herb got the win against Richmond, striking out eight in 5.0 innings of work. Since returning to the Baysox on July 28, Herb is 3-0 in four starts with a 2.25 ERA in 24.0 innings of work. His first start back with Bowie was in Binghamton against the Rumble Ponies, where he earned a win, yielding just two runs on two hits in 6.0 innings of work. Herb made his first three starts of the season with the Baysox before being called-up to Triple-A Norfolk where he made his next 16 outings. Overall, this will be Herb's 24th appearance and 21st start of the 2019 season.

In the Other Corner: RHP Zach Lee will make his sixth start of the season for the Rumble Ponies today. Lee was added to the Binghamton roster yesterday after spending about two weeks on Triple-A Syracuse's injured list. His last outing came with Syracuse on August 3 where he gave up five runs on 11 hits in 3.0 innings. His prior five starts came with Binghamton, the last of which was against the Baysox on July 28. Bowie tagged Lee for five runs in 6.0 innings that day and he took the loss. In his other four starts with the Rumble Ponies, Lee had not allowed more than one earned run. The 27-year-old had made 20 appearances and 17 starts in Triple-A before those five starts with Binghamton. Lee is in his first season in the Mets' organization after signing as a minor league free agent in March. A first-round pick of the Dodgers in 2010, Lee is pitching with his fifth organization (LAD, SEA, SD, TB, NYM) in his nine-year professional career. He made four major league appearances with the Dodgers and Padres in 2015 and 2017. Lee has made 59 Double-A appearances in his career and sports a 25-15 record at the level. Lee was a teammate of Baysox manager **Buck Britton** in 2015 with the Triple-A Oklahoma City Dodgers.

Down the Stretch They Go: With less than two weeks left in the regular season, Bowie and Erie are battling for the second-half West Division title. Erie has a 2.0-game lead and each team has 14 games remaining. After playing 18 games against each other in April and May, the Baysox and SeaWolves do not play each other again this season.

Baumann Named Pitcher of the Week (Again): RHP Mike Baumann has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of August 12-18 after throwing a nine-inning complete game shutout against Richmond last Wednesday night. It is the second time this season that Baumann has won the award, after he took it home for the period of July 15-21 after throwing a nine-inning no-hitter against Harrisburg. Baumann joines Erie's Casey Mize and Portland's Daniel McGrath as pitchers that have won the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week award twice in 2019. Baysox pitchers have now won the award four times this season and overall Bowie players have taken home six weekly individual awards.

Career Year for Perez: After going 3-4 with a home run and three RBIs last night, C Carlos Perez has now set career-highs for home runs (13) and RBIs (52) during the 2019 season. Perez had never hit more than six home runs in any of his previous 11 professional seasons. Perez has homered three times in his last six games and has driven in nine runs during that stretch.

Zach Attack: Since rejoining the Baysox roster last week after an all-star season with Advanced-A Frederick, **OF Zach Jarrett** has four hits, four RBIs, two doubles and a run scored in three games with Bowie. Jarrett played 20 games with the Baysox in April and May and had just one multi-hit game. He has two such contests in his three games back with Bowie.

Feliz Getting Going: INF Anderson Feliz has hits in eight of his last nine games and is riding a team best five-game hit streak. During the last five games, Feliz is 8-19 (.421) with one RBI, four runs scored and three walks. For the season with Bowie, Feliz is hitting .314 in 24 games.

Jimenez Dominant in August: After a rocky July where he pitched to an 8.64 ERA in five appearances, RHP Francisco Jimenez has been outstanding for the Baysox in August. In five outings during the month, Jimenez has posted a 0.71 ERA in 12.2 innings. He has struck out 17 batters in those five outings, four of which have been at least 2.0 innings. Jimenez has a 0.95 WHIP and is holding opponents to a .191 batting average against this month.

This Day in History: On August 20, 2018, Corban Joseph and Yusniel Diaz drove in all six runs in a 6-2 Bowie win in Richmond.
