In Case You Missed It: The Baysox dropped a tight contest against Binghamton by a score of 4-3 last night. Bowie scored the first run of the game in the bottom of the first inning on an RBI groundout from **Carlos Perez**. Binghamton got the next two runs in the game, taking a 2-1 lead into the bottom of the fourth inning. In that frame, **Ryan Ripken** launched a go-ahead two-run home run to give the Baysox the lead back. The Rumble Ponies responded with a run in the fifth and the winning run in the eighth to take the game.

Baysox Starter: RHP Cody Sedlock will make his seventh appearance and fourth start of the season for the Baysox today. Sedlock pitched well in his last start in Altoona, picking up his first Double-A win after allowing just one earned run in 5.0 innings. Sedlock had allowed six earned runs in 5.0 innings over his previous two outings. Today will be the second time that Sedlock has pitched against Binghamton. On July 28, Sedlock worked 3.0 scoreless and hitless innings in Binghamton, striking out four. Sedlock's first 13 appearances and 10 starts of 2019 came with Advanced-A Frederick where he was named a Carolina League All-Star. Overall in 2019, Sedlock is 5-2 with a 2.51 ERA in 82.1 innings between Frederick and Bowie. The 24-year-old is just 7.2 innings away from his career-high of 90.0, which he set in 2017. Sedlock is holding opponents to a .187 batting average against this season. The 24-year-old is in his fourth professional season after the Orioles made him the 27th overall pick in the 2016 MLB Draft out of the University of Illinois.

In the Other Corner: RHP Tommy Wilson will make his 13th start of the year for the Rumble Ponies today. Wilson took a tough-luck loss his last time out against New Hampshire, allowing just one earned run on two hits and striking out seven in 7.0 innings in a defeat. Wilson started against Bowie on July 27 and allowed just one run in 7.0 innings, striking out a season-high nine. Wilson made his first eight starts of the season with Advanced-A St. Lucie, where he pitched to a 2.01 ERA in 44.2 innings before being promoted to Binghamton on May 24. The 23-year-old is in just his second professional season after the Mets selected him in the 19th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Cal State Fullerton.

Down the Stretch They Go: With less than two weeks left in the regular season, Bowie and Erie are battling for the second-half West Division title. Erie has a 2.5-game lead over the Baysox entering play today. Bowie has 13 games remaining, while Erie still has 14 left after their contest last night was suspended in the eighth inning. After playing 18 games against each other in April and May, the Baysox and SeaWolves do not play each other again this season.

Baumann Named Pitcher of the Week (Again): RHP Mike Baumann has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of August 12-18 after throwing a nine-inning complete game shutout against Richmond last Wednesday night. It is the second time this season that Baumann has won the award, after he took it home for the period of July 15-21 after throwing a nine-inning no-hitter against Harrisburg. Baumann joins Erie's Casey Mize and Portland's Daniel McGrath as pitchers that have won the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week award twice in 2019. Baysox pitchers have now won the award four times this season and overall Bowie players have taken home six weekly individual awards.

Career Year for Perez: C Carlos Perez has set career-highs for home runs (13) and RBIs (53) during the 2019 season. Perez had never hit more than six home runs in any of his previous 11 professional seasons. Perez has homered three times in his last seven games and has driven in ten runs during that stretch.

RIPKEN: INF Ryan Ripken has quickly become a force in the middle of the Baysox order since joining the team on July 16. Ripken is hitting .311 in 22 games with Bowie, and has been on fire of late. Ripken has multiple hits in three of his last four games, and hit his first Double-A home run last night against Binghamton.

Zach Attack: Since rejoining the Baysox roster last week after an all-star season with Advanced-A Frederick, **OF Zach Jarrett** has four hits, four RBIs, two doubles and a run scored in three games with Bowie. Jarrett played 20 games with the Baysox in April and May and had just one multi-hit game. He has two such contests in his three games back with Bowie.

Feliz Getting Going: INF Anderson Feliz has hits in nine of his last ten games and is riding a team best six-game hit streak. During the last six games, Feliz is 9-24 (.375) with one RBI, four runs scored and three walks. For the season with Bowie, Feliz is hitting .314 in 24 games.

Jimenez Dominant in August: After a rocky July where he pitched to an 8.64 ERA in five appearances, RHP Francisco Jimenez has been outstanding for the Baysox in August. In five outings during the month, Jimenez has posted a 0.71 ERA in 12.2 innings. He has struck out 17 batters in those five outings, four of which have been at least 2.0 innings. Jimenez has a 0.95 WHIP and is holding opponents to a .191 batting average against this month.

This Day in History: On August 21, 2014, **Mike Yastrzemski** hit a home run and **Buck Britton** drove in two runs as the Baysox defeated Reading 6-2.
