In Case You Missed It: The Baysox bats came alive in a 9-2 series-opening win against the Altoona Curve on Thursday. Cedric Mullins hit a leadoff home run in the bottom of the first inning, putting Bowie on top. Jesmuel Valentin added another run in the inning with an RBI single. In the second, T.J. Nichting and Anderson Feliz each drove in runs, making it 4-0. In the fourth, Feliz hit a two-run double and Carlos Perez added an RBI single, extending the advantage to 7-0. Ryan McKenna picked up an RBI in the eighth inning and Feliz hit another RBI double, capping a four-hit and four-RBI night. Zac Lowther gave the Baysox 6.0 strong innings on the mound, earning his league-leading 13th win.

Baysox Starter: LHP Alex Wells will make his 22nd start of the season for the Baysox today. Wells enters with the second-best ERA in the Eastern League at 2.40. In his last start in Altoona, Wells tossed 7.0 innings, allowing four runs (three earned) and striking out six in a no-decision. It was the eighth time this season that Wells has thrown at least 7.0 innings in a start. Wells made another start against the Curve on May 8 and earned the win, going 5.0 innings and yielding just two runs. Along with having the second-best ERA in the Eastern League, Wells also ranks in the top nine in innings pitched, batting average against, WHIP and winning percentage.

In the Other Corner: LHP Sean Brady will make his 20th start of the year for the Curve today. Brady allowed three runs in 6.0 innings in a no-decision against Bowie on Sunday. In four starts overall against the Baysox this year, Brady is 0-1 with an 8.10 ERA, allowing 18 earned runs on 28 hits in 20.0 innings of work. The 25-year-old spent the first five-plus seasons of his professional career in the Indians' organization before he was released on May 1 after a start in Bowie. Brady signed a minor league deal with the Pirates on May 6 and has been with Altoona since then.

Down the Stretch They Go: With less than two weeks left in the regular season, Bowie and Erie are battling for the second-half West Division title. Erie has a 1.0-game lead over the Baysox with 11 games remaining. After playing 18 games against each other in April and May, the Baysox and SeaWolves do not play each other again this season.

Lucky Number 13: With his win last night against Altoona, **LHP Zac Lowther** became just the sixth pitcher in Baysox franchise history to win 13 games in a single season. Lowther is the Eastern League leader in wins, and ranks in the top six in the league in ERA (T-4th), strikeouts (2nd), innings (3rd), batting average against (4th), WHIP (T-6th) and winning percentage (6th).

Four Hits, Four RBIs: Last night, **INF Anderson Feliz** became the first Baysox player this season with four hits and four RBIs in a game. In 27 games with the Baysox this season, Feliz is hitting .320 and has driven in 20 runs.

Career Year for Perez: C Carlos Perez has set career-highs for home runs (13) and RBIs (54) during the 2019 season. Perez had never hit more than six home runs in any of his previous 11 professional seasons. Perez has homered three times in his last eight games and has driven in 11 runs during that stretch.

On-Base Machine: OF Ryan McKenna has been on-base 13 times in his last five games. During that stretch, McKenna is 7-18 (.389) with four RBIs, five runs scored, two walks and three stolen bases. For the season, McKenna ranks in the top seven in the Eastern League in runs (T-2nd), triples (T-3rd), walks (6th), stolen bases (T-7th) and games played (T-1st).

No Trouble with the Curve: Over his last four games against Altoona, **OF Cedric Mullins** has hit three home runs, driven in five runs, scored six runs and stolen two bases. Mullins leadoff home run last night was the first for a Baysox player since **Austin Hays** in August 2018.

Zach Attack: Since rejoining the Baysox roster last week after an all-star season with Advanced-A Frederick, **OF Zach Jarrett** is 6-18 (.333) with five RBIs, one run scored and two doubles in four games played with Bowie. Jarrett played 20 games with Bowie in April and May and had just one multi-hit game, but has three such contests in four August games.

Jimenez Dominant in August: RHP Francisco Jimenez has been outstanding for the Baysox in August. In six outings, four of which have been at least 2.0 innings, he has posted a 0.66 ERA in 13.2 innings and struck out 18 batters.

Baumann Named Pitcher of the Week (Again): RHP Mike Baumann has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of August 12-18 after throwing a nine-inning complete game shutout against Richmond last Wednesday night. It is the second time this season that Baumann has won the award, after he took it home for the period of July 15-21 after throwing a nine-inning no-hitter against Harrisburg. Baumann joines Erie's Casey Mize and Portland's Daniel McGrath as pitchers that have won the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week award twice in 2019.

This Day in History: On August 23, 2017, Stevie Wilkerson hit a home run and drove in three in a 7-3 win over Reading.
