51S EARN SERIES SPLIT WITH EXTRA INNINGS VICTORY

■ The Las Vegas 51s prevailed in a seesaw battle against the El Paso Chihuahuas on Monday morning, coming out on top 9-6 in 11 innings. The Chihuahuas were introduced to the new minor league extra innings rule, with a runner starting on second base, as they played their first extra inning game of the season. It took four comebacks to get there however, as the Chihuahuas rallied from deficits of 1-0, 3-1, 4-3 and 5-4 to send the game into extras. Both Allen Craig and Brett Nicholas hit game-tying home runs, with Craig's coming in the sixth and Nicholas' in the seventh. Down to the last out in the bottom of the ninth, Franmil Reyes singled off the wall in left to drive in the game-tying run. After a scoreless 10th, the 51s broke it open with four in the 11th. El Paso tried to mount a comeback, but could only score one, dropping the 9-6 decision.

 Allen Craig smacked his first home run of the season with yesterday's two-run sixth inning shot. Craig, who was limited to only one home run each of the past two years, is now hitting .281, with one home run and five RBIs.

BRETT'S BOMB

■ Brett Nicholas became the second Chihuahua to hit a pinch hit home run, following Dusty Coleman's on 4/6 at Las Vegas. The Chihuahuas as a team are hitting .462 (6-for-13) in pinch hitting situations.

LONG HISTORY VS RENO

The Chihuahuas will face the Reno Aces for the first time since sweeping them in the first round of the playoffs in 2017. The Chihuahuas are 31-32 all time in regular season play vs Reno.

Today, LHP Tyler Webb was recalled by San Diego. As a corresponding move, LHP Kyle McGrath has been optioned to El Paso, keeping the active roster at 25.

The Chihuahuas hit two home runs yesterday, adding to their season total of 19, which is tops in the PCL.. Nick Schulz had his team high six-game hitting streak snapped with his 0-for-4...with his recall today and following his first appearance in San Diego, Tyler Webb will become the 33rd Chihuahua to appear in the major leagues.


