TRIBE TIPS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Gwinnett Stripers evened the series at a game apiece after scoring two in the seventh and two more runs in the eighth to record a 4-3 comeback victory over Indy. Carlos Franco hit a two-run homer to make it a 3-2 ballgame, and after a Rio Ruiz game-tying double, Sean Kazmar Jr. drove home the winning run with a sacrifice fly to left field. The Indians wasted a solid effort from right-hander Alex McRae (6.1ip, 4h, 2r/er, 1bb, 5k) in the loss. Indy scored twice with two outs in the second to go up 2-0 thanks to an RBI double by Pablo Reyes and a run-scoring single by Christopher Bostick. Kevin Kramer then belted his third home run of the season in the fifth off Andres Santiago, a 365-foot dinger to right. Dovydas Neverauskas, who hadn't allowed a hit against 22 batters this season in Triple-A entering the game, surrendered three knocks against five batters and took the loss.

WE GOT ONE: Kevin Kramer's home run in the fifth last night was Indy's 10th of the season but just its first at Victory Field in 14 home games played. In order, the Indians were the seventh team to homer at their own ballpark this season. The list of teams and dates they first homered at The Vic prior to the Indians are below:

ONE OF THE BEST: Indy's offense ranks among the International League's best in terms of overall production. The Tribe rank first in average (.270), doubles (67) and triples (12), second in slugging percentage (.415), third in fewest strikeouts (185) and tied for third in hits (219).. The pitching staff has had a roller-coaster start to the season, but much like previous years, the team ERA at home (2.98) is significantly lower than the road ERA (5.90).

CINCO DE MAYO NOTES: Indy's overall record on May 5 since 1996 is 9-11. They were rained out on Cinco de Mayo at Columbus last year and didn't have a scheduled game on the date in 2016. The Indians have dropped three straight games on the date from 2013-15, that stretch coming on the heels of a three-game winning streak from 2009-12 (DNP in 2010). Indy has matched up with the Braves' Triple-A affiliate on May 5 just one time since '96, falling 3-2 at Richmond in 2008. The largest Victory Field crowd on Cinco de Mayo was in 2001, when 10,009 fans in attendance witnessed a 3-1 loss against Rochester.

STRETCH 'EM OUT: Alex McRae's 6.1-inning start last night was the longest by a Tribe pitcher this season and his third consecutive start of six or more innings pitched. The Indians have had just five quality starts in 25 games and only seven outings where the starting pitcher tossed six-plus innings.

TANNER AND JOHNNY: Tanner Anderson, who allowed five earned runs in his Triple-A debut, is riding a 14.0-inning scoreless streak dating back to April 8, the longest scoreless streak by a Tribe pitcher this season. He tossed another 1.2 shutout frames in last night's loss, fanning a pair of Stripers. Another late-inning reliever, Johnny Hellweg, still has a perfect 0.00 ERA on the season. He has recorded three saves in as many tries and has allowed just five hits and four walks with eight strikeouts in 10 innings pitched, good for a 0.90 WHIP and .152 (5-for-33) batting average against.

WHERE THERE'S FIRE, THERE'S SMOKER: Tribe southpaw Josh Smoker tossed a scoreless top of the ninth Thursday night and earned his first win in a Tribe uniform thanks to Erich Weiss' walk-off double. Smoker opened the season with Pittsburgh but was sent to Indy in mid-April. In seven appearances with the Indians, he's 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA (1 ER/6.2 IP) and eight strikeouts against just two walks.

IF YOU'RE NOT FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: Through Indy's first 11 games of the season, opponents owned a 19-2 run advantage in the first inning against the Tribe. In the last 14 games, the Indians have flipped the script in the opening frame, posting a +16 run differential (20-4). On the past six-game road trip, Indy hung a crooked number in the first inning five times, scoring two, three, four (2x) and five runs.

GOOD THINGS COME TO THOSE WHO WAIT: Erich Weiss recorded his first two RBI of the season with his ninth-inning double Thursday night. He was the last Opening Day position player to tally an RBI for Indy, but it was worth the wait for the 26-year-old. Weiss hit just .205 (8-for-39) with three extra-base hits in 14 April games this year, much like his 2017 April numbers (.154, 6-for-39, two XBH). He managed to finish the 2017 season with a .274 average and 43 RBI.

Tonight's Starter: Right-hander Tyler Eppler will take the mound in game three of the series against Gwinnett. The 6-foot-6, 220-pound Texas native was selected by Pittsburgh in the sixth round (191st overall) in the 2014 MLB June Amateur Draft out of Sam Houston State University, where he was a teammate with former Pirates minor league pitcher Cody Dickson in 2013. On the heels of a 2016 Eastern League mid-season All-Star selection with Double-A Altoona, Eppler posted an 8-9 record and 4.89 ERA (74 ER/136.1 IP) for the Tribe last year. His 23 home runs surrendered in 2017 matched a Victory Field Era record (1996-present) for home runs allowed in a single season by an individual pitcher.

Last Outing: Eppler lasted six innings for a second straight start on Monday at Toledo. He scattered seven hits and two walks with five punchouts, allowing four runs en route to his third win of the season.

Against the Stripers: Eppler made two appearances (one start) against Gwinnett last season, going 0-2 with a 12.91 ERA (11 ER/7.2 IP). Both of those outings came at Coolray Field. Four of the 15 hits Gwinnett totaled against the righty left the ballpark.

Miscellaneous: Eppler's wife's name is Marissa; he proposed to her the day he was drafted by the Pirates. He was a second-team All-Southland Conference selection in 2014 at Sam Houston State University. He graduated from Navasota (Texas) High School in 2011, where he played baseball, golf and basketball.
