ABOUT YESTERDAY: The Indianapolis Indians' Wednesday woes continued yesterday afternoon in Louisville with a 4-3 loss to the Bats. A fielding error by Tribe third baseman Wyatt Mathisen in the bottom of the seventh inning allowed the winning run to score for Louisville. Indy is just 1-5 in games played on Wednesdays this season. Pablo Reyes clubbed a one-out homer for Indy in the first inning to stake the Tribe a 1-0 advantage, but the Bats awoke against Nick Kingham in the second for three runs. Kevin Newman, Christopher Bostick and Eric Wood all doubled in the sixth against southpaw Justin Nicolino, helping the Tribe level the score at 3-3. Kingham tossed a quality start in the no-decision, while the scheduled starter -- Alex McRae -- took the loss out of the bullpen. Five of Indy's six hits went for extra bases.

WELCOME, J.T.: Starting pitcher J.T. Brubaker will be making his Triple-A debut for the Tribe tonight in the series finale at Louisville. Brubaker, 24, was a sixth-round selection by the Pirates in the 2015 MLB June Amateur Draft out of the University of Akron. In 73 career games (71 starts), the Ohio native owns a 21-23 record and 3.87 ERA (158 ER/367.2 IP) with 313 strikeouts against 111 walks. He was especially dominant for Double-A Altoona this year, going 2-2 with a 1.80 ERA (7 ER/35.0 IP) and team-high 35 strikeouts at the time of his promotion.

WHAT'S IN A NAME: Among the 2,600-plus former players and managers in the 117-year history of the Indianapolis Indians, there are just 19 former players or managers in the record books who have their first and middle names abbreviated with initials. J.T. Brubaker will become the 20th and the first "J.T." to play for the Tribe. STAY IN THE LUP: Jordan Luplow had an uncharacteristic April, batting just .180 by the month's end. Since May 1, the slugger has hit safely in all but one game, posting a .478 average (11-for-23) for the month. He has five extra-base hits already in May (two homers, two triples, one double) after totaling just one double and one triple over 18 games in April. He has been at his best this season with runners on base, posting a .356 clip (16-for-45) and 1.012 OPS.

CATCH US IF YOU CAN: Indy sits at or near the top of the league in several offensive categories. The Indians lead the IL in average (.268), doubles (77) and triples (13). They also rank second in slugging percentage (.408) and OPS (.733) and are third in fewest strikeouts (218).

WHOLE LOTTA NOTHIN': Tanner Anderson, who allowed five earned runs in his Triple-A debut, is riding a 16.0-inning scoreless streak dating back to April 8, the longest scoreless streak by a Tribe pitcher this season and the longest of his career. He tossed another two shutout innings in the seventh and eighth Tuesday night, scattering two hits with one strikeout en route to his team-high fourth hold.

JOHNNY ON THE SPOT: Another late-inning reliever, Johnny Hellweg, maintained his perfect 0.00 ERA on the season despite a little trouble Tuesday night. He allowed a one-out walk which was followed by a single to put runners at the corners. The veteran then fell behind Tyler Goeddel in the count, 3-1, before battling back and inducing a game-sealing 6-4-3 double play for the Tribe. He has recorded five saves in as many tries and has allowed just six hits and five walks with nine strikeouts in 12 innings pitched, good for a 0.92 WHIP and .154 (6-for-39) batting average against.

PABLO POWER: Tribe utilityman Pablo Reves went just 4-for-20 in his first seven games with the Tribe. Over his last eight games (seven starts), he's riding a seven-game hitting streak; he's batted .400 (10-for-25) with three doubles and one home run during that stretch. He launched his first career Triple-A homer in yesterday's defeat. The versatile Reyes has started at second, third, shortstop and center field for the Indians so far this season.

HE'LL HIT ANYWHERE: Christopher Bostick has started in 24 of Indy's 30 games so far this season, and his name typically appears in a different spot on the lineup card anytime he gets the nod from manager Brian Esposito. Bostick has already hit everywhere except cleanup this year for Indy. In 2017, Bostick batted everywhere in the lineup except fourth and fifth. Outfielder Danny Ortiz, now with Lehigh Valley, was the lone Tribe player in 2017 to bat at least once in every spot in the order.

Tonight's Starter: Right-hander J.T Brubaker will take the mound tonight in Louisville for his Triple-A debut. The 6-foot-4 Springfield, Ohio native was selected by Pittsburgh in the sixth round (187th overall) of the 2015 MLB June Amateur Draft out of the University of Akron. He opened the 2018 season with Double-A Altoona, where he went 2-2 with a 1.80 ERA (7 ER/35.0 IP) and 35 strikeouts against just eight walks.

Last Outing: Brubaker last pitched on May 5 vs. Erie with the Curve, surrendering two runs on six hits and three walks with one strikeout in four innings of work. He threw 50 of his 79 pitches for strikes but took the loss as Altoona was handed a 2-0 defeat in seven innings.

Against the Bats: Brubaker has never faced Louisville.

Miscellaneous: Brubaker was named the New York-Penn League Pitcher of the Week on July 27, 2015, the lone accolade of his professional career. He attended the University of Akron, where he went 5-4 with a 3.63 ERA (36 ER/89.1 IP) in 15 games (15 starts) as a junior in 2015; led the Zips in strikeouts (72) and starts while finishing second in wins and innings pitched that year. He became the third Akron player to be drafted in the last four years in 2015. Brubaker led the Zips in strikeouts (39) as a freshman in 2013. He was a 2012 graduate of Tecumseh (New Carlisle, Ohio) High School, where he was a two-year letterwinner in baseball; also played basketball up through his sophomore year.


