**Today's Starter:** Right-hander Drew Hutchison will take the mound today in the series finale at Columbus. The 26-year-old was acquired by Pittsburgh from Toronto on Aug. 1, 2016 in exchange for left-hander Francisco Liriano, catcher Reese McGuire and outfielder Harold Ramirez. Last year, he went 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (18 ER in 36.0 IP) in seven games (six starts) for the Tribe.

**Last Outing:** Hutchison posted another quality start last Saturday against Norfolk, allowing one earned run on four hits over six innings. He has not allowed more than three earned runs in each of his last five starts.

**Major League Debut:** Hutchison made his major league debut on April 21, 2012 at Kansas City. He allowed five runs (five earned) on eight hits and three walks with four strikeouts over 5.1 innings pitched and recorded the win against the Royals.

**Against the Clippers:** Today's game marks Hutchison's sixth career start against Columbus, with four of them coming in 2016. Prior to being traded from Toronto to Pittsburgh, he made two starts against Columbus with Buffalo, going 2-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5 ER in 13.0 IP). Post-trade, he started twice against Columbus with Indy and went 0-1 with a 5.25 ERA (7 ER in 12.0 IP). Overall, he's 2-2 with a 5.10 ERA (17 ER in 30.0 IP) and has surrendered 20 hits (6 home runs) and 17 walks with 31 strikeouts in the process.

**Tomorrow's Starters:** Clay Holmes (1-1, 3.38) will start in the first game tomorrow night vs. Toledo. The Indians have not yet named a starter for the nightcap of the twin bill.
