### TRIBE TIPS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Bats scored in six consecutive innings to bury the Indians last night by a 14-2 final score, Indy's biggest loss of the season; the Tribe had been defeated by 10 runs three times previously. Louisville clubbed 16 hits to tie the high surrendered by Indy's staff this season (also: 6/29 @ Columbus) and the 14 runs given up marked a new season high. Despite the loss, Indy still holds a 1.0-game lead in the IL Wild Card race with seven games to play. Kevin Kramer and Eric Wood both went 2-for-4, accounting for half of the Indians' eight hits on the evening. Wood tallied an RBI triple in the second inning, falling inches shy of a fourth straight game with a home run, but the RBI was his fifth in as many days. Brandon Waddell couldn't get through the third inning and dropped to 4-8 on the season. Domingo Tapia (W, 4-5) was credited with the win and Austin Brice (S, 1) tossed the final three innings for the Bats, who took three of four in the split series.

**POSTSEASON ALL-STARs:** Kevin Newman and Kevin Kramer were named as the shortstop and second baseman on the International League Postseason All-Star team today by the league office. Ballots were submitted by managers, coaching staffs, media members, general managers and broadcasters in the IL. Newman and Kramer's postseason All-Star honors are the first of their respective careers. Newman has two midseason All-Star bids (2016, FSL; 2018, IL) and Kramer has one midseason All-Star honor (2017, EL) to his credit. Newman is the second Indians shortstop to be named to the postseason squad, joining Brian Bixler who was on the 2007 team. Kramer is the first Indians second baseman to be named to the team.

**WELL THAT'S KIND OF NEAT:** Newman and Kramer are the first middle infield teammates to be named to the IL Postseason All-Star team since Columbus second baseman Brian Raabe and shortstop D'Angelo Jimenez in 1999.

**HOLY TOLEDO:** The Indians lead the season series over Toledo 13-8 with three games remaining. Indy has won the season series over the Mud Hens in eight of the last 10 seasons. The Tribe have won 15 games in a season against Toledo just once since 1988, doing so in 2013 when the Indians won 15 of 21 matchups against their IL West rivals. Indy has outscored Toledo 108-97 in the season series and has a 19-15 advantage in home runs.

**HOT BATS:** Four Indians are batting over .300 in the month of August, led by Ryan Lavarney who has a .354 average (23-for-65) in 20 games. He has one homer, nine doubles and 10 RBI in the month. Jose Osuna has the second-highest average this month (.333, 21-for-63) in 17 contests, including two dingers, three doubles and a team-high 18 RBI. Kevin Kramer is batting .329 (28-for-85) with two home runs, six doubles and five RBI this month, and Eric Wood has also had a productive final month, batting .317 (19-for-60) with four long balls, four doubles and 10 RBI in 18 games.

**AIR JORDAN:** Jordan Luplow has hit safely in 11 straight games for the Tribe dating back to June 29, batting .421 (16-for-38) with one homer, one double, seven RBI, seven runs scored and four walks. Since June 3 with Indy, he's hit .358 (44-for-123) with in 34 games to raise his average from .250 to .296. He has hit safely in 30 of those 34 games.

**RIGHT MAN, RIGHT TIME:** Jose Osuna is batting .417 (35-for-84) with six homers, nine doubles and 52 RBI with RISP this season. He went 1-for-2 in those situations Sunday, the knock being a first-inning, two-run blast off Lucas Sims. He has also walked 12 times and struck out just 10 times in those situations for the Tribe this year. The last Indians player to total 25-plus plate appearances with RISP and post an average at or above .400 was Gregory Polanco in 2014, when he hit .432 (32-for-74) with 43 RBI. Matt Hague nearly accomplished the feat that season, as well, batting .396 (38-for-96) with 53 RBI.

**CONGRATS TO THE CURVE:** Double-A Altoona clinched its fourth consecutive postseason berth and ninth overall with a 3-0 shutout over Richmond on Sunday. The defending Eastern League Champions have won seven of their last eight series and sit 17 games over .500 (.74-57). The Curve currently hold a 1.0-game lead over Double-A Akron in the EL Western Division. Oddly enough, Akron is the Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Indy is tied with Columbus, the Triple-A affiliate of Cleveland, for first place in the International League West Division.

**ANOTHER WEEKLY AWARD:** Jose Osuna was named IL Player of the Week yesterday by the league office, the first weekly award of his nine-year professional career and sixth by a Tribe player in 2018. Indy is tied with Columbus and Lehigh Valley for the most weekly honors this season. Osuna hit .478 (11-for-23) with three homers, a league-high nine RBI and four runs scored in six games vs. Columbus and Louisville. His .870 slugging percentage was the second-best mark in the league and his 1.370 OPS was third highest overall.

**LOOKING LIKE AN ACE:** Mitch Keller, 22, delivered another quality start Sunday en route to his third win at the Triple-A level. Over his last four starts, he's 3-0 with a 1.17 ERA (3 ER/23.0 IP) and 21 strikeouts against just six walks.

**WHEN THE GOIN' GETS TOUGH:** In the month of August, Indians relievers have inherited 29 runners and 14 have scored (48.3%). From April-July, 36 of 101 total inherited runners (35.6%) scored on Tribe relievers.

**ONE-RUN GAMES:** The Indians have lost six consecutive one-run games and are just 13-22 (.371) in one-run affairs this season, good for the lowest winning percentage in such contests among all International League teams. The Tribe are 57-41 (.582) in games decided by two or more runs.

**VALUABLE LAVARNWAY:** Ryan Lavarney is batting .361 (35-for-97) with four homers, 10 doubles, 14 RBI, 13 runs scored and a 1.014 OPS in 29 games dating back to July 21. His .361 average since that date ranks third in the IL while his 1.014 OPS is second.

**DIGGING FOR SECOND:** The Indians have racked up 295 doubles through 133 games this season (2.22 doubles per game). The Tribe are on pace for 311 doubles and have nine players with 19-plus doubles so far this year. Indy's highest doubles count as a team since 1996 is 299, done in both 1998 and 2000. The Indians have led the IL in doubles four times previously (2017, 2013, 1998 and 1963). The Tribe are on the verge of becoming the first IL team to total 300-plus doubles in a season since 2010, when Buffalo (330), Louisville (314) and Columbus (304) all broke the 300 doubles barrier.

**Tonight's Starter:** Right-hander J.T. Brubaker gets the nod for Indy in the series opener tonight against Toledo. The 6-foot-4 Springfield, Ohio native was selected by Pittsburgh in the sixth round (187th overall) of the 2015 MLB June Amateur Draft out of the University of Akron. He opened the 2018 season with Double-A Altoona, where he went 2-2 with a 1.80 ERA (7 ER/35.0 IP) and 35 strikeouts against just eight walks.

**Last Outing:** Brubaker allowed two runs on three hits with eight strikeouts over 5.0 innings last Thursday at The Vic against Columbus. He walked just one, his first free pass issued in nearly a month; his last walk was on July 25 vs. Rochester. The Indians knocked off the Clippers 8-6 to give Brubaker a career-high tying four-game winning streak dating back to July 19. His other four-game winning streak stretched from July 9-31, 2015 with Short-Season A West Virginia.

**Road Warrior:** Brubaker has made 13 combined starts on the road this year between Altoona and Indy, going 5-2 with a 2.03 ERA (16 ER/71.0 IP).

**Against the Mud Hens:** Brubaker will be making his fourth career start against Toledo and third against the Mud Hens at Victory Field tonight. He is 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA (6 ER/19.1 IP) and a 17:3 K-to-BB ratio in his previous outings combined. Indy has won each time Brubaker has taken the mound vs. Toledo, winning 5-2, 5-4 and 2-0.

**Miscellaneous:** Brubaker was named the New York-Penn League Pitcher of the Week on July 27, 2015, and was recently named as the IL Pitcher of the Week on Aug. 6 after delivering 15.0 innings across two road starts (7/30 @ COL, 8/4 @ TOL) for the Indians, allowing just one earned run. He attended the University of Akron, where he went 5-4 with a 3.63 ERA (36 ER/89.1 IP) in 15 games (15 starts) as a junior in 2015; led the Zips in strikeouts (72) and starts while finishing second in wins and innings pitched that year. He became the third Akron player to be drafted in the last four years in 2015. Brubaker led the Zips in strikeouts (39) as a freshman in 2013. He was a 2012 graduate of Tecumseh (New Carlisle, Ohio) High School, where he was a two-year letterwinner in baseball; also played basketball up through his sophomore year.
