TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve return home for three games against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. Over a span of 13 days, the two clubs will have played the entire six-game season series. The Fisher Cats swept the Curve in three games at Northeast Delta Dental Stadium on May 21-23, outscoring Altoona 14-3.

game and third game of the series will be rescheduled at a later date.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: The Curve will finish a stretch of playing 16 of 23 on the road on June 5. Beginning on Fri-day, the Curve will be sleeping in their own beds for 14 of the next 20 nights with 12-of-18 games at home. Altoona is also using the designated hitter in 23 straight games, spanning seven series, against American League affiliates until June 13. The team is also playing their fourth consecutive series against an Eastern Division club, which inlcu-des of seven of their last 10 series until the end of the first half against the Eastern Division.

THE CURVE: After winning three of four over first place Harrisburg, Altoona lost seven of eight games on their longest road trip of the season and were outscored 35-21. The Curve are four games below .500 for the first time since they entered a double-header on May 7, 2016 with an 11-16 record and swept the two games. The last time Altoona was greater than five games below .500 was at the close of the 2014 season when the club was 21 games under on the second-to-last day of the season. Altoona's offense ranks fifth in the Eastern League in hitting at .240, 11th with 29 homers, sixth with a .251 average with runners in scoring position and ninth with 3.9 runs per game. Altoona's pitching staff entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.45 ERA (39 ER/101.2 IP) over the last 11 games shaved it down to 4.06.

THE FISHER CATS: The defending Eastern League champions captured the 2018 title with a straight sweep through the postseason over Trenton and Akron. In 2019, New Hampshire's club has hung around .500 most of the season before losing six-of-seven after they swept the Curve in Manchester. They lost three out of four games at home against surging Hartford and were swept the barve in Hartisburg to begin their six-game road trip. Offen-sively, the club ranks tied for sixth in hitting (.243), seventh in homers (33), 10th with runners in scoring position (.224) and are second in the league with 45 steals while plating 4.0 runs per game, fifth-most in the league. From a pitching perspective, New Hampshire ranks seventh with a 3.56 ERA.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Austin Coley** takes the hill for his second start of the year after he allowed one run in his 2019 Curve debut on Monday in Portland. Coley was injured to start the year and pitched two games in relief for A-Adv. Bradenton on May 21 and 24. The 26-year-old was limited to 50.2 innings in 2018 with two stints on the injured list due to ailments in his throwing shoulder. In 34 games at Double-A, Coley is 8-4 with a 3.08 ERA. He was drafted by the Pirates during the eighth round of the 2014 draft out of Belmont University and is a native of Murfreesboro, Tenn...*For more on Coley, see page two.*

FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE: Yennsy Diaz, a 22-year-old right-hander, takes the hill for his ninth start and 10th overall appearance. Diaz compiled back-to-back seven scoreless, two-hit performances, including on May 21 against the Curve in Manchester, and pitched 19 straight scoreless innings over four starts from May 7-26. His scoreless streak ended with two outs in the fourth in his last outing against Hartford and would go on to allow five runs over six innings of work while being dealt the losing decision. Diaz is in his first Double-A season after he split 2018 between Single-A Lansing and A-Adv. Dunedin, going a combined 10-5 with a 3.05 ERA in 27 outings. Diaz was signed by Toronto as an international free agent in July 2014 and ranks as the organization's No. 23 prospect, according to MLB.com.

ROTATION STATION: After using eight total starters through the first 46 games of the season, three pitchers in the last four games made their first start of the season. The Curve starting staff owned a 2.98 ERA (47 ER/142 IP) through play on May 2 but has swelled to a league-high 4.37 over the last 24 games due to a 6.12 ERA (78 ER/114.2 IP). The entire pitching staff has the highest ERA in the league during the month of May at 5.00, (123 ER/221.1 IP) after pitching to a 3.13 ERA (72 ER/207 IP) in April.

BRAKE MEN: Altoona's bullpen has received a boost from some mid-season additions. **Beau Sulser**, brought up from Bradenton on April 6, pitched 16 consecutive scoreless innings before he allowed a run at Double-A. The right-hander has anchored the long-relief role with 11 scoreless appearances and 11 multi-inning outings. **Blake Weiman**, injured coming out of spring training, joined the Curve on April 22 and has allowed just four earned runs (a walk-off grand slam by Pat Mazeika on May 14) over 14.1 innings. For a pair of early May call-ups, **Blake Cederlind** has yet to allow a run over 12.1 innings while **Joel Cesar** has not let up a run over his last 8.2 innings since he surrendered a solo homer to his second Double-A batter.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Curve defense owns the highest fielding percentage (.986) in Minor League Baseball. They have done so as Altoona pitchers put a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (341) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (146) in Double-A. Pittsburgh's Triple-A affiliate in Indianapolis is tied for the second-best fielding percentage in the Minors at .984. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percent-age in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

BOUNTY HUNTER: Third baseman **Hunter Owen** is thriving during his first Double-A season by littering the Eastern League leaderboards in most major offensive categories. He is second in RBIs (33) and extra-base hits (23) while standing third in runs (30) and home runs (10). His 41 dingers since the beginning of the 2017 season are the tied with 2018 Altoona Curve MVP Will Craig for the most by any Pirates minor league player over the last three seasons. Over his last 32 games since April 23, Owen is batting .299 (35/117) with 12 multi-hit games, 17 extra-base hits, seven homers and 21 RBIs. Additionally, he has been hit by six pitches over his last 10 games and has been hit eight times this season, second-most in the E.L.

KING OF THE HILL: Logan Hill had his 16-game on-base streak from May 2-19 snapped with an 0-for-10 slide to start the road trip. However, has reached safely in five of the last six, batting .261 (6/23) with three doubles and two walks. Hill has reached base in 25 of his last 30 games since April 24, batting .313 (35/112) with a three homers, eight doubles, 21 RBIs and boosted his average from .230 to .283. Hill is ranked second in the E.L. with 31 runs scored while also standing fourth with 14 doubles, 10th with 28 RBIs and fifth with 49 hits.

SUIT UP: First baseman **Jerrick Suiter** had a team-high 10 hits on the road trip, batting .333 (10/30) with two homers and five RBIs while hitting safely in each of his last seven games. Throughout the month of May, the TCU product has racked up 18 RBIs and hit safely in 21 of 26 games while batting .297 (27/91) with six extra-base hits and 18 RBIs. Suiter led the 2017 Curve with a .285 batting average, .369 on-base percentage and .800 OPS over 100 games and was named the 2017 Altoona Curve Unsung Hero while helping the club capture the second league championship in franchise history.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system while MLB.com has Oliva ranked as the No. 11 overall prospect in the Pirates organization.
