THE LAST TIME OUT: Hunter Owen capped off a three-hit night with a walk-off, two-run homer with the Curve down, 3-2, in the bottom of the ninth to lift the club to a 4-3 win. After two perfect innings of relief for New Hampshire's Vinny Nattoli, Logan Hill led off the home half of the ninth with a single, his third hit of the game, before the game-winning blast. Owen and Hill accounted for all six Curve hits. Sean Brady departed with a 2-0 lead with one out in the seventh before New Hampshire scored all three of their runs on a two-out, two-run single by Santiago Espinal followed by a throwing error on the play. Angel German struck out the side in the top of the ninth to pick up the win. Owen's walk-off homer is the first of the season for the Curve and the first with the club trailing at the time of the home run since Bryan Reynolds hit a three-run shot to give Altoona an 8-7 win on July 26, 2018 vs. Binghamton.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve complete their three-game series and homestand with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. Over a span of 13 days, the two clubs have played the entire six-game season series. The Fisher Cats swept the Curve in three games at Northeast Delta Dental Stadium on May 21-23 before splitting the last two games as New Hampshire has outscored the Curve, 22-11.

**NO PLACE LIKE HOME:** The Curve will finish a stretch of playing 16 of 23 on the road after they play three games in Erie after Sunday's contest in Altoona. The three-game series this weekend started a period 12 home games over 18 total from May 31-June 19. Altoona is also using the designated hitter in 23 straight games, spanning seven series, against American League affiliates until June 13. The team is also playing their fourth consecutive series against an Eastern Division club, which inloudes seven of their last 10 series until the end of the first half against the Eastern Division

**THE CURVE**: After winning three of four over first place Harrisburg, Altoona has lost eight of 10 and have been outscored 43-29. Each of the team's last three games have been decided by one run. The Curve have not been greater than five games below .500 since the end of the 2014 season when the club was 21 games under on the second-to-last day of the season. Altoona's offense ranks fifth in the Eastern League in hitting at .239, last with 31 homers, sixth with a .252 average with runners in scoring position and eighth with 3.9 runs per game. Altoona's pitching staff entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.53 ERA (47 ER/119.2 IP) over the last 13 games shaved it down to 4.05.

**THE FISHER CATS:** New Hampshire's club has hung around .500 most of the season before losing seven-of-nine after they swept the Curve in Manchester. In their current six-game road trip, they have been swept in three games by Harrisburg and split the first two games of the series in Altoona. Offensively, the club ranks fourth in hitting (.245), eighth in homers (34), 11th with runners in scoring position (.222) and are second in the league with 48 steals while plating 4.0 runs per game, fifth-most in the league. From a pitching perspective, New Hampshire ranks eighth with a 3.56 ERA. New Hampshire is the defending Eastern League champions, sweeping Trenton and Akron in three games each.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander **Domingo Robles** makes his first home start at PNG Field and his second Double-A start. During his debut, threw five innings in Trenton and allowed three runs, two earned, with six strikeouts on Tuesday. Robles ranked fifth in the Florida State League with a 2.64 ERA, third with a .203 batting average against, fourth with a 1.00 WHIP and tied for first with 10 starts after he served as the Opening Day starter for the Marauders. Robles, a 21-year-old native of the Dominican Republic, was signed by Pittsburgh as an international free agent on July 2, 2014... *For more on Robles, see page two.* 

FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE: Patrick Murphy, a 23-year-old righty, makes his 11th start for New Hampshire. Murphy won three straight starts, including six one-run innings against the Curve on May 23, before he allowed seven runs in 4.2 innings in his last start on Tuesday at Harrisburg. He currently ranks seventh in the Eastern League with 60 strikeouts, eighth with a .201 batting average against and 10th with a 1.05 WHIP and 56.1 innings pitched. Murphy made one start for the Fisher Cats in 2018 on May 27 versus Hartford while he went 10-5 with a 2.64 ERA with A-Adv. Dunedin. He was drafted by the Blue Jays in the third round in 2013 out Hamilton High School, where he was high school teammates with Dodgers outfielder Cody Bellinger, and is currently ranked as the No. 17 prospect in Toronto's minor league system, according to MLB.com.

**ROTATION STATION:** The Curve starting staff owned a 2.98 ERA (47 ER/142 IP) through play on May 2 but has swelled to a league-high 4.33 over their last 26 games due to a 5.93 ERA (81 ER/123.0 IP). Altoona's pitching staff had the highest ERA in the league in May at 5.00, (128 ER/230.1 IP) after pitching to a 3.13 ERA (72 ER/207 IP) in

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Curve defense shares the highest fielding percentage (.985) in Minor League Baseball with their Triple-A affiliate, the Indianapolis Indians. They have done so as Altoona pitchers put a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (354) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (150) in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

**BOUNTY HUNTER:** Third baseman **Hunter Owen** has homered in back-to-back games, including a walk-off, two run shot on Saturday night, to own the title of most homers (43) hit by a Pirates minor league since the start of the 2017 season. He ranks just ahead of 2019 organizational leaders Will Craig (15 in 2019) and Mason Martin (16 in 2019), who have each homerd 41 times over the same period. During his first season at Double-A, Owen leads the league with 37 RBIs and .587 slugging percentage while he ranks second with 12 home runs and 25 extra-base hits. His 33 runs scored are second-most on the circuit while his .307 batting average ranks seventh. Owen was a 25th-round pick by the Pirates out of Indiana State in 2016 and has hit safely in his last five games, batting .381 (8/21) with two homers and five RBIs. Defensively, Owen leads Eastern League third basemen with a .976 fielding percentage.

KING OF THE HILL: Logan Hill had his 16-game on-base streak from May 2-19 snapped with an 0-for-10 slide to start the last road trip. However, has reached safely in seven of his last eight, batting .345 (10/29) with four doubles and three walks. Hill has reached base in 27 of his last 32 games since April 24, batting .331 (39/118) with three homers, 10 doubles, one triple, 22 RBIs and boosted his average from .230 to .296, good for 10th in the E.L. Hill's .323 batting average and .404 on-base percentage in May ranked fifth and sixth among E.L. players. Overall, Hill leads the league in runs scored (33) and is third with 16 doubles. Hill was drafted by Pittsburgh out of Troy in 2015 during the 25th round.

**SUIT UP:** First baseman **Jerrick Suiter** has team's longest active on-base streak at nine games, hitting .333 (11/33) with two homers, six RBIs and three walks since May 22. A 26th round draftee by Pittsburgh out of TCU in 2014, Suiter had a solid May with a .295 batting average (28/95) with a team-high 19 RBIs, two homers, four doubles and hit safely in 22 of 27 games. Suiter led the 2017 Curve with a .285 batting average, .369 on-base percentage and .800 OPS over 100 games and was named the 2017 Altoona Curve Unsung Hero while helping the club capture the second league championship in franchise history.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Altoona catching tandem **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have teamed up for the Eastern League's third-best offensive catching unit, trailing only Erie (.321) and New Hampshire (.276). The two backstop have combined to hit .258 with a league-best 13 doubles and three triples in addition to four homers and 30 RBIs. Delay and Pabst are tied with New Hampshire catchers for the most extra-base hits with 20. Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech, has six RBIs in his last six games with four extra-base hits, batting .318 (7/22). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt, batted .339 (20/59) in May with four homers, six doubles and 16 RBIs in 16 games. Defensively, the two have limited the running game and allowed 29 stolen bases, third-fewest in the league.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system while MLB.com has Oliva ranked as the No. 11 overall prospect in the Pirates organization.
