THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve were defeated, 4-1, by New Hampshire at PNG Field on Sunday to close the season series with the Fisher Cats in a 13-day period. Eastern League Player of the Week Forrest Wall hit a pair of doubles, including a lead-off two bagger that led to the game's first run in the opening frame. The Curve scored their lone run in the third after back-to-back singles by Brett Pope and Ryan Peurifoy were coupled with a fielding error by shortstop Kevin Smith allowed Pope to reach home. New Hampshire starter Patrick Murphy handcuffed the Altoona offense to just one hit beyond that inning and retired his last 11 to complete seven one-run innings. Domingo Robles made his first home start for the Curve and turned in a quality start despite the losing decision.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve heads to UPMC Park for a three-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This week's meeting is the second of three series, totalling 10 games, in Erie while the two clubs have played six times at PNG Field in Altoona. The two clubs will play two four-game series on each side of the Eastern League All-Star Break to conclude the season series; in Altoona from July 4-7 before the break and July 11-14 in Erie when play resumes.

END OF THE ROAD: The current series in Erie completes a stretch of 16 out of 23 games played on the road for the Curve, dating back to May 13. Altoona's previous three-game series at home kicked off a period of 12 home games over 18 total from May 31-June 19.

THE CURVE: After winning three of four over first place Harrisburg on May 16-19, Altoona has lost nine of 11 and have been outscored 47-30. The lineup has sputtered over to hit .186 (66/355) over the last 11 games while averaging 2.7 runs per game. Overall, the Curve offense ranks last with 31 homers, eighth with 3.9 runs per game, seventh in the Eastern League in hitting at .238 and are sixth by batting .253 when men are in scoring position. Altoona's pitching staff entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.50 ERA (50 ER/128.2 IP) over the last 14 games shaved it down to 4.03. Entering play on Monday five games under .500, the Curve have not been greater than five games below .500 since the club was 60-81 entering the final day of the 2014 season.

THE SEAWOLVES: Erie has won five of their last seven after losing seven-of-nine. Erie went 15 games without scoring more than four runs before the club put up eight in a wild, 11-inning 8-5 win over Akron in the second game of a double-header on Sunday to take 2-of-3 over the 'Ducks. Kody Eaves homered to tie the game, 2-2, in the seventh and walked it off with a three-run shot in the 11th. The SeaWolves rotation leads the Eastern League with a 3.19 ERA while the bullpen is 10th on the circuit with a 3.83 ERA. Erie's offense ranks third in hitting at .245, fourth at 4.3 runs per game, fifth with 39 homers in addition to .255 with runners in scoring position.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander James Marvel makes the his 11th start of the season and fifth career outing against the SeaWolves. Marvel's last outing was cut short after two scoreless innings when the game was suspended due to heavy rains on Thursday in Trenton. In four previous starts against the SeaWolves, he is 0-4 with a 6.29 ERA (17 ER/24.1 IP), which included his Double-A debut on August 10, 2018 in Altoona. Marvel was the Curve's Opening Day starter and started the year 3-1 with a 1.52 ERA over his first five starts before he went 0-3 with a 9.18 ERA (17 ER/16.2 IP) over his next three appearances. A native of the Bay Area, Marvel was drafted by the Pirates in the 36th round in 2015 after injury limited the righty to just 13 outings in college from 2013-14 at Duke University. *For more on Marvel see name two* on Marvel, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Anthony Castro, a 24-year-old right-hander, makes 11th appearance, sixth start of the year and first career outing against the Curve. Castro allowed six runs in one inning of relief during his latest outing on May 25. He was signed by the Tigers as an international free agent in 2011. He did not pitch his first full season until 2017 for West Michigan, going 10-6 with a 2.49 ERA. In 2018, he spent most of the season with A-Adv. Lakeland and went 9-4 with a 2.93 ERA and also made three outings in June with Erie before finishing the year with the Flying Tigers. Castro is ranked by MLB.com as Detroit's No. 21 prospect.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Curve defense shares the highest fielding percentage (.985) in Minor League Baseball with their Triple-A affiliate, the Indianapolis Indians. They have done so as Altoona pitchers put a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (360) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (155) in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

BOUNTY HUNTER: Third baseman **Hunter Owen** has homered in two of his last three games, including a walk-off, two run shot on Saturday night. No Pirates minor leaguer has hit more homers since the start of the 2017 season (43) than Owen, who ranks just ahead of the top two sluggers in the system in 2019, Mason Martin and Will Craig, who have each homered 41 times over the last three years. During Owen's first season at Double-A, he leads the league with 37 RBIs and ranks second with 12 home runs, 33 runs and .953 OPS while batting .306, seventh in the E.L. Owen was a 25th-round pick by the Pirates out of Indiana State in 2016 and has hit safely in his last six games, batting .360 (9/25) with two homers and five RBIs. Defensively, Owen also leads Eastern League third basemen with a .977 fielding percentage.

KING OF THE HILL: Logan Hill had his 16-game on-base streak from May 2-19 snapped with an 0-for-10 slide to start the last road trip. However, has reached safely in seven of his last nine, batting .303 (10/33) with four doubles and three walks. Hill has reached base in 27 of his last 33 games since April 24, batting .320 (39/122) with three homers, 10 doubles, one triple, 22 RBIs and boosted his average from .230 to .290. Hill's .323 batting average and .404 on-base percentage in May ranked fifth and sixth among E.L. players. Overall, Hill is second in the league in runs scored (33) and is fourth with 16 doubles. Hill was drafted by Pittsburgh out of Troy in 2015 in the 25th round.

SUIT UP: First baseman **Jerrick Suiter** has team's longest active on-base streak at 10 games, hitting .324 (12/37) with two homers, six RBIs and three walks since May 22. A 26th-round draftee by Pittsburgh out of TCU in 2014, Suiter had a solid May with a .295 batting average (28/95) with a team-high 19 RBIs, two homers, four doubles and hit safely in 22 of 27 games. Suiter led the 2017 Curve with a .285 batting average, .369 on-base percentage and .800 OPS over 100 games and was named the 2017 Altoona Curve Unsung Hero while helping the club capture the second league championship in franchise history.

SUMMER CATCH: Altoona catching tandem **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have teamed up for the Eastern League's fourth-best offensive catching unit, trailing only Erie (.323), New Hampshire (.276) and Portland (.257). The two backstops have combined to hit .254 and are tied with New Hampshire catchers with 20 extra-base hits, the hightest team total for catchers. Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech, has six RBIs in his last seven games with four extra-base hits, batting .280 (7/25). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt, batted .339 (20/59) in May with four homers, six doubles and 16 RBIs in 16 games. Defensively, the two have limited the running game and allowed 31 stolen bases while Pabst's 14 runners caught stealing is the second-highest total in the league.

DRAFT DAY: The 2019 First-Year Player Draft begins tonight with the first two rounds, starting at 6 p.m. on MLB Network and MLB.com. The first two rounds will occur today with rounds 3-10 on Tuesday followed by rounds 11-40 on Wednesday. The Pittsburgh Pirates will have the 18th, 37th, 57th and 72nd overall selections tonight.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system while MLB.com has Oliva ranked as the No. 11 overall prospect in the Pirates organization.
