THE LAST TIME OUT: Hunter Owen and Bligh Madris hit back-to-back homers during a five-run ninth inning on Monday as the Curve erased a five-run defect to beat Erie, 9-8. Owen clubbed his 13th of the season on a three-run blast to tie the game, 8-8, moments before the go-ahead blast by Madris, his second. Arden Pabst hit his first homer of the year in the seventh inning, which put Altoona within one run, 4-3, heading into the stretch before Erie opened up an 8-3 advantage with four in the home half of the seventh.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve plays the second of a three-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This week's meeting is the second of three series, totalling 10 games, in Erie while the two clubs have played six times at PNG Field in Altoona. The two clubs will play two four-game series on each side of the Eastern League All-Star Break to conclude the season series; in Altoona from July 4-7 before the break and July 11-14 in Erie when play resumes.

END OF THE ROAD: The current series in Erie completes a stretch of 16 out of 23 games played on the road for the Curve, dating back to May 13. Altoona's previous three-game series at home kicked off a period of 12 home games over 18 total from May 31-June 19.

THE CURVE: After winning three of four over first place Harrisburg on May 16-19, Altoona has lost nine of 12 and have been outscored 55-39. The lineup has sputtered to hit .193 (76/393) over the last 12 games while averaging 3.3 runs per game. Overall, the Curve offense ranks 11th with 34 homers, eighth with 4.0 runs per game, seventh in the Eastern League in hitting at .238 and are sixth by batting .252 when men are in scoring position. Altoona's pitching staff entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.72 ERA (57 ER/37.2 IP) over the last 15 games shaved it down to 4.09. The Curve have entered the ninth inning trailing in each of their last two wins last two wins.

THE SEAWOLVES: Erie has won five of their last eight after losing seven-of-nine. Erie went 15 games without scoring more than four runs before scoring eight runs in each of their last two. The SeaWolves rotation leads the Eastern League with a 3.18 ERA while the bullpen is 10th on the circuit with a 4.07 ERA. Erie's offense now leads the league in hitting at .248 after 15 hits last night, fourth at 4.3 runs per game, fifth with 40 homers in addition to .253 with runners in scoring position.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-handed pitcher **Pedro Vasquez** will make his 10th appearance with the Curve and ninth start after his first two career outings at Triple-A. He is coming off six scoreless, one-hit innings for Triple-A Indianapolis on May 30 in which he struck out seven. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by the Mariners as an international free agent in 2015 and was traded to the Pirates organization in September 2016...For more on Vasquez, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Logan Shore, a 24-year-old right-hander, makes his ninth start of the season and third against the Curve. Shore is 1-1 with a 6.30 ERA (7 ER/10 IP) over two starts against Altoona this season. In his latest start, Shore lasted 2.2 innings with five runs allowed. A former second-round pick out of the University of Florida, Shore joined the Tigers organization last September from Oakland as a player to be named later in the Mike Fiers trade. Shore is ranked by MLB.com as Detroit's No. 15 prospect.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Curve defense shares the highest fielding percentage (.984) in Minor League Baseball with their Triple-A affiliate, the Indianapolis Indians. They have done so as Altoona pitchers put a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (371) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (157) in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

BOUNTY HUNTER: Third baseman **Hunter Owen** has homered in three of his last fours games, including a walk-off, two run shot on Saturday night and a game-tying, three-run blast on Monday. Owen's 44 home runs since 2017 are the most by a Pirates minor leaguer over the last three seasons. During Owen's first season at Double-A, he leads the league with 40 RBIs, 13 homers, 36 runs and .601 slugging. His .309 batting average is the E.L.'s sixth-best while his 27 extra-base hits, 58 hits, eight hit by pitch and .975 OPS are all ranked second in the league. Owen was a 25th-round pick by the Pirates out of Indiana State in 2016 and has hit safely in his last seven games, batting .367 (11/30) with three homers and eight RBIs. Defensively, Owen also leads Eastern League third basemen with a .970 fielding percentage percentage.

KING OF THE HILL: Logan Hill had his 16-game on-base streak from May 2-19 snapped with an 0-for-10 slide to start the last road trip. However, has reached safely in eight of his last 10, batting .270 (10/37) with four doubles and four walks. Hill has reached base in 28 of his last 34 games since April 24, batting .310 (39/126) with three homers, 10 doubles, one triple, 23 RBIs and boosted his average from .230 to .283. Hill's .323 batting average and .404 on-base percentage in May ranked fifth and sixth among E.L. players. Overall, Hill is second in the league in runs scored (34), fourth with 16 doubles and tied for seventh with 53 hits. Hill was drafted by Pittsburgh out of Troy in 2015 in the 25th round.

SUIT UP: First baseman **Jerrick Suiter** has team's longest active on-base streak at 11 games, hitting .293 (12/41) with two homers, six RBIs and four walks since May 22. A 26th-round draftee by Pittsburgh out of TCU in 2014, Suiter had a solid May with a .295 batting average (28/95) with a team-high 19 RBIs, two homers, four doubles and hit safely in 22 of 27 games. Suiter led the 2017 Curve with a .285 batting average, .369 on-base percentage and .800 OPS over 100 games and was named the 2017 Altoona Curve Unsung Hero while helping the club capture the second league championship in fracthics history. second league championship in franchise history.

SUMMER CATCH: Altoona catching tandem **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have teamed up for the Eastern League's third-best offensive catching unit, trailing only Erie (.321) and New Hampshire (.276). The two backstops have combined to hit .258 and have collected the most extra-base hits by any team in the league at the position (21). Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech, has eight RBIs in his last eight games with five extra-base hits, including one homer, while batting .300 (9/30). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt, batted .339 (20/59) in May with four homers, six doubles and 16 RBIs in 16 games. Defensively, the two have limited the running game and allowed 31 stolen bases while Pabst's 14 runners caught stealing is the second-highest total in the league.

DRAFT DAY: The 2019 First-Year Player Draft continues today with round 3-10. On Monday night, the Pirates made four selections: RHP Quinn Priester (No. 18), Sammy Siani (No. 37), Matt Gorski (No. 57) and Jared Triolo (No. 72). The draft concludes with rounds 11-40 on Wednesday.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system while MLB.com has Oliva ranked as the No. 11 overall prospect in the Pirates organization.
