**THE LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve threw their first shutout in 34 games, dating back to April 28, with a 3-0 victory over Erie on Tuesday morning. Pedro Vasquez worked the first six innings, stranding a runner at third base in three different innings, to earn his fourth win before Beau Sulser maneuvered through the final three for his first Double-A save. Mitchell Tolman hit a two-out, RBI single in the second while Jared Oliva and Jason Delay each hit solo homers in the win.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve wrap up their three-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This week's meeting is the second of three series, totalling 10 games, in Erie while the two clubs have played six times at PNG Field in Altoona. The two clubs will play two four-game series on each side of the Eastern League All-Star Break to conclude the season series; in Altoona from July 4-7 before the break and July 11-14 in Erie when play resumes.

**TAKE ME HOME, COUNTRY ROADS:** Wednesday's game finishes a stretch of 16 out of 23 games played on the road for the Curve, dating back to May 13. Altoona's previous three-game series at home kicked off a period of 12 home games over 18 total from May 31-June 19.

**THE CURVE:** Altoona seeks their second series sweep of the season and first since a four-game series in Akron to start the campaign. The last time the Curve won three straight games was May 2-4 in Richmond. Winners of three of their last four, Altoona has lost nine of 13. The lineup has hit .191 (81/424) over the last 13 games while averaging 3.2 runs per game. Overall, the Curve offense ranks 11th with 36 homers, eighth with 3.9 runs per game, seventh in the Eastern League in hitting at .237 and are sixth by batting .252 when men are in scoring position. Altoona's pitching staff entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.50 ERA (57 ER/146.2 IP) over the last 17 games shaved it down to 4.01.

**THE SEAWOLVES:** Erie is 7-11 over their last 18 games. Erie went 15 games without scoring more than four runs before scoring eight runs in each of their last two prior to being shut out on Tuesday. The SeaWolves rotation leads the Eastern League with a 3.18 ERA while the bullpen is 10th on the circuit with a 4.05 ERA. Erie's offense now leads the league in hitting at .248 after 23 hits in the series, ranks fourth at 4.3 runs per game, fifth with 40 homers in addition to .248 with runners in scoring position.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Austin Coley** takes the hill for his third start of the year after he allowed one run over two innings in each of his first two appearances. Coley was injured to start the year and pitched two games in relief for A-Adv. Bradenton on May 21 and 24 before rejoining the Curve. The 26-year-old was limited to 50.2 innings in 2018 with two stints on the injured list due to ailments in his throwing shoulder. In 34 games at Double-A, Coley is 8-4 with a 3.08 ERA. He was drafted by the Pirates during the eighth round of the 2014 draft out of Belmont University and is a native of Murfreesboro, Tenn...*For more on Coley, see page two.*

**FOR ERIE:** Alex Faedo, a 23-year-old from Tampa, gets the starting nod for the series finale. The former Florida Gator is coming off 6.1 scoreless innings in which he struck out 12 and allowed just two hits on May 29. Over his last two outings, Faedo has allowed one run in 12.1 innings with 19 strikeouts. He has one previous appearance against Altoona, which was on May 1 and he allowed one run through six innings for his second of three total wins this year. Faedo was the 18th overall selection in the 2017 draft by the Tigers and is Detroit's No. 9 prospect, according to the MLB.com.

**MAKING THE PLAYS:** The Curve defense shares the highest fielding percentage (.984) in Minor League Baseball with their Triple-A affiliate, the Indianapolis Indians. They have done so as Altoona pitchers put a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (377) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (158) in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

**BOUNTY HUNTER:** Third baseman **Hunter Owen** has homered in three of his last five games, including a walk-off, two run shot on Saturday night and a game-tying, three-run blast on Monday. Owen's 44 home runs since 2017 are the most by a Pirates minor leaguer over the last three seasons. During Owen's first season at Double-A, he leads the league with 40 RBIs, 13 homers, 36 runs, 59 hits and .597 slugging. His .309 batting average is the E.L.'s sixth-best while his 27 extra-base hits, eight hit by pitch and .974 OPS are all ranked second in the league. Owen was a 25th-round pick by the Pirates out of Indiana State in 2016 and has hit safely in his last eight games, batting .364 (12/33) with three homers and eight RBIs. Defensively, Owen also leads Eastern League third basemen with a .970 fielding percentage.

**KING OF THE HILL:** **Logan Hill** had his 16-game on-base streak from May 2-19 snapped with an 0-for-10 slide to start the last road trip. However, has reached safely in nine of his last 11, batting .268 (11/41) with four doubles and four walks. Hill has reached base in 29 of his last 35 games since April 24, batting .308 (40/130) with three homers, 10 doubles, one triple, 23 RBIs and boosted his average from .230 to .283. Hill's .323 batting average and .404 on-base percentage in May ranked fifth and sixth among E.L. players. Overall, Hill is third in the league in runs scored (34), fourth with 16 doubles and tied for eighth with 54 hits. Hill was drafted by Pittsburgh out of Troy in 2015 in the 25th round.

**SUIT UP:** First baseman **Jerrick Suiter** has team's longest active on-base streak at 11 games, hitting .293 (12/41) with two homers, six RBIs and four walks since May 22. A 26th-round draftee by Pittsburgh out of TCU in 2014, Suiter had a solid May with a .295 batting average (28/95) with a team-high 19 RBIs, two homers, four doubles and hit safely in 22 of 27 games. Suiter led the 2017 Curve with a .285 batting average, .369 on-base percentage and .800 OPS over 100 games and was named the 2017 Altoona Curve Unsung Hero while helping the club capture the second league championship in franchise history.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Altoona catching tandem **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have teamed up for the Eastern League's third-best offensive catching unit, trailing only Erie (.314) and New Hampshire (.276). The two backstops have combined to hit .258 and have collected the most extra-base hits by any team in the league at the position (22). Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech, has eight RBIs in his last eight games with five extra-base hits, including one homer, while batting .300 (9/30). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt, is hitting .323 (21/65) with five homers, six doubles, one triple and 17 RBIs over his last 17 games. Defensively, the two have limited the running game and allowed 31 stolen bases while Pabst's 14 runners caught stealing is the second-highest total in the league.

**DRAFT DAY:** The 2019 First-Year Player Draft wraps up today with rounds 11-40. On Monday night, the Pirates made four selections through the first two rounds: RHP Quinn Priester (No. 18 - HS in ILL.), OF Sammy Siani (No. 37 - HS in Pa.), OF Matt Gorski (No. 57 - Indiana) and 3B Jared Triolo (No. 72 - Houston). On Day Two of the draft, Pittsburgh chose OF Matt Fraizer (Arizona), RHP J.C. Flowers (Florida State), RHP Grant Ford (Nevada), RHP Will Matthiesen (Stanford), OF Blake Sabol (USC), RHP Austin Roberts (Sacramento State), SS Ethan Paul (Vanderbilt) and RHP Cameron Junker (Notre Dame).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system while MLB.com has Oliva ranked as the No. 11 overall prospect in the Pirates organization.
