THE LAST TIME OUT: Tuesday's series opener went back and forth all night but the Curve prevailed in a 5-4 victory. Portland scored twice in the first against Austin Coley with a lead-off triple by Jarren Duran that led to an RBI single by Jhon Nunez, who scored on a Brett Netzer single. Logan Hill smacked a two-run double in the home half of the first to tie the game. In the fourth, three hits for Portland led to one more run before Hunter Owen crushed his 14th homer of the season to even the score again, 3-3. Portland's Bobby Dalbec made it a 4-3 game with his 14th long ball during the seventh but the Curve punched back with two in the bottom of the inning on RBI singles from Brett Pope and Jared Oliva. Beau Sulser logged a career-high five innings in relief behind Coley's one inning. Joel Cesar picked up his first Double-A win and Matt Eckelman secured his seventh save of the year.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve play the second contest of a three-game set against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. Portland won 3 of 4 games at Hadlock Field over Memorial Day weekend on May 24-27. This is the lone visit to Altoona for the Sea Dogs this season. Altoona stands 4-11 against Eastern Division opponents in 2019 following Tuesday's win.

**THE CURVE:** The Curve have won four straight, seven of eight and are an Eastern League-best 8-2 in June. The club stands above .500 for the first time since May 21 and are one win shy of matching their longest winning streak of the season. Coming off back-to-back series wins for the first time this season (three-game sweep at Erie and 3 of 4 vs. Akron), Altoona looks to win three series in a row since rolling to five consecutive series wins last August 14-26 vs. New Hampshire, Portland, Binghamton, Harrisburg and Richmond. Despite a .221 (68/308) team average this month, Altoona has hammered nine homers in June after hitting a league-low 30 home runs through the first two months of the season. Curve pitchers entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.25 ERA (71 ER/196.2 IP) over the last 23 games brought it down to 3.87. In June, Altoona pitchers have the fourthlowest ERA (2.83) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. in May (5.00).

**THE SEA DOGS:** The Sea Dogs are on a three-city, nine-game road trip that will go from Altoona to Akron before making their final stop in Erie. Portland is 8-8 over their last 16 games after they entered play against the Curve on May 24 a season-low 13-31, 18 games below .500. On their most recent homestand, Portland went 2-4 and lost the rubber match in extra innings to both Richmond and Bowie. The Sea Dogs are batting the league average of .237 while ranking 10th in the league with 3.7 runs per game and .231 average with runners in scoring position. Portland's pitching staff owns the highest ERA on the Eastern League circuit at 4.08 aided by the most walks allowed in the league

FOR ALTOONA: Left-handed pitcher Sean Brady will make his seventh start for Altoona and 12th outing overall in 2019. Today's appearance will be his second of the season and fourth of his career against Portland. Brady has pitched three quality starts in his last four outings with a 3.50 ERA (10 ER/25.2 IP) over those appearances. In his last start, Brady faced his former club, Akron, for the first time in his career and was hit with three first-inning runs but settled in to pitch six frames with a total of five runs allowed. He spent the first six years of his professional career in the Cleveland Indians organization and was released by Cleveland on May 1 and signed with the Pirates on May 6. He was originally drafted by the Indians in the fifth round of the 2013 draft out of high school....For more on Brady, see page two. on Brady, see page two.

FOR PORTLAND: Tanner Houck, a 22-year-old right-hander from Collinsville, Ill., will make his 12th start of the season and second opposite Altoona. Houck has thrown three straight quality starts and has picked up two wins with a 2.37 ERA (5 ER/19 IP) with 25 strikeouts. In his last start, he tossed a season-high seven innings against Richmond on June 6 and struck out a career-best 11 but did not factor into the decision. Houck pitched six innings against the Curve on May 25 for his fourth win of the year. Houck was drafted by Boston out of the University of Missouri with the 24th overall pick in the 2017 draft and is currently ranked by MLB.com as the No. 5 prospect in the Red Sox Top 30

**HOME COOKIN':** Altoona is 10-5 and have won 3 of their last 4 series at PNG Field since May 10 when the club entered play with a 5-10 home record. The Curve's home record has been been over .500 for one day, which followed a walk-off victory in their home opener on April 11 before losing the last five games of the team's first homestand of 2019.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Curve defense shares the highest fielding percentage (.984) in Minor League Baseball with Triple-A lowa (Cubs) while the Pirates' Triple-A club, Indianapolis, ranks third with a .983 mark in the field. Altoona defenders have put away outs while their pitchers have put a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (410) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (170) in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

**BOUNTY HUNTER:** Third baseman **Hunter Owen** ran into his fourth homer in 11 games with his league-high 14th of the season on Tuesday. Owen's 45 homers since 2017 are the most by any Pirates minor leaguer. The Evansville, Ind. native is on a record-setting, 32 home run pace, which would break Adam Hyzdu's franchise record of 31. Pittsburgh's 25th round pick in 2016 is also on pace rank in the top three in club history in RBIs (96), runs (92) and extra-base hits (67). Owen leads the Eastern League in runs scored (40) and is third with a .299 average while he ranks second in the following categories: RBIs (42), extra-base hits (29), hits (63), slugging percentage (.578), OPS (.945) and hit by pitch (9). He has hit safely in 23 of his last 30 games since May 7 while batting .308 (33/107) with seven homers and 16 RBIs. *For more on single-season club records, see page 100 of the Curve Media Guide*.

**KING OF THE HILL: Logan Hill** has reached base in 34 of his last 41 games since April 24, batting .300 (45/150) with three homers, 12 doubles, two triples, 29 RBIs and boosted his average from .230 to .280. Overall, Hill is third in the league with 18 doubles and fourth in runs scored (35) and 36 RBIs while eighth with 59 total hits. Hill was drafted by Pittsburgh out of Troy in 2015 in the 25th round.

**OLIVA COMING ALIVE:** Jared Oliva is riding a season-best eight-game on-base streak in which he has also hit safely in 7 of 8 with a .300 (9/30) average. During his last eight contests, Oliva has homered in back-to-back games on June 4-5 at Erie to double his total for the season and has been hit by two pitches to raise his tally to seven on the year, fourth-most in the league. The Pirates' seventh round choice in 2017 out of Arizona was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent run. A native of Southern California, Oliva was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 with A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Altoona's catching tandem **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have the most extra-base hits by any team in the league at the position (23) while hitting a combined .258, third-best in the E.L. Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech, has 10 RBIs in his last 12 games with six extra-base hits, including two homers, while batting .326 (14/43). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt, is hitting .296 (21/71) with five homers, six doubles, one triple and 17 RBIs over his last 19 games. Defensively, the two have limited the running game and allowed 33 stolen bases, fourth-fewest in the league, while Pabst's 14 runners caught stealing is fifth-most in the league.

**DOING THE SPLITS:** The Curve have seven games remaining in the first half before the standings reset on June 19. A win tonight by Harrisburg or a loss by the Curve would eliminate Altoona from first half contention. Altoona joined the Eastern League in 1999 and is experiencing a split season for the first time in franchise history, which was last played in the E.L. in 1982 at the end of a five-year run from 1978-82. The league also implemented a split-season format during the 1934-35, 1958 and 1975 seasons.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com ranks Oliva as the No. 9 overall prospect in the Pirates organization and RHP **Blake Cederlind** is rated No. 30.
