THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve racked up another win, 6-2, over Binghamton to open the series on Friday. Altoona jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the fourth on an RBI single from Bligh Madris and ground out by Jason Delay. Binghamton got to Domingo Robles for single runs in the fourth and fifth and chased the lefty after 101 pitches through 4.2 innings. A second run-scoring grounder by Delay put the Curve ahead in the sixth and Robbie Glendinning unloaded a two-run homer in the seventh to widen the lead to three. In the eighth, Hunter Owen and Bralin Jackson smacked doubles to lead to the final run of the game. Owen went 3-for-3 with a walk to get on base four times.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve play game two of a three-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is final visit to NYSEG Stadium for the Curve in 2019 after losing 2 of 3 a month ago. The Rumble Ponies come to PNG Field for four games at the end of the month on June 27-30. Altoona stands 6-12 against Eastern Division opponents in 2019 but have won 3 out of their last 4. Today's contest will be the second of 16 straight games through the remainder of June without the designated hitter before all but four games in July (July 25-28 vs. Richmond) will feature an additional batter.

THE CURVE: The Curve are an Eastern League-best 10-3 in June. They seek a fourth straight series win after sweeping Erie on their last road trip prior to a 5-2 homestand against Akron and Portland. Despite a .232 (94/405) team average this month, Altoona has hammered 10 homers in June after a league-low 30 home runs through the first two months of the season. Curve pitchers entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.23 ERA (79 ER/223.2 IP) over the last 26 games brought it down to 3.81. In June, Altoona pitchers have the fourth-lowest ERA (2.79) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. in May (5.00).

THE RUMBLE PONIES: Binghamton was in first place in the Eastern Division at 30-18 entering play on the last day of May before going 3-10 over their last 13 games. With a league-best 23-12 record on the road, the Rumble Ponies are 10-16 at home, and are 1-3 on their current homestand. Binghamton will be off on Monday, leaving just one game in the first half after their series with the Curve, and will travel to New Hampshire for three games and back during the transition between halves. The Rumble Ponies offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.247), runs per game (4.6) and hitting with runners in scoring position (.268). The club's pitching staff owns the highest ERA in the league in June (5.97) and ranks 11th overall with a 3.88 ERA.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-handed pitcher Pedro Vasquez will make his 12th outing and second start against Binghamton. Since he returned from Triple-A, Vasquez has thrown back-to-back shutout outings of six innings each. He reached Triple-A for two games at the end of May and pitched in relief at Columbus (Indians) and allowed eight runs before he shut out Charlotte (White Sox) in six innings and struck out seven. The last time Vasquez saw the Rumble Ponies, he was tagged for six runs, five earned, over 5.1 innings in the first game of a double-header on May 14. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by the Mariners as an international free agent in 2015 and was traded to the Pirates organization in September 2016... FOR BINGHAMTON: Luc Rennie will make his second Double-A start and 13th of the season after going 4-2 with a 4.24 ERA with A-Adv. St. Lucie. Rennie combiled an impressive debut on June 9 in Hartford, pitching five hitless innings with nine strikeouts before the Yard Goats got to the Rumble Ponies bullpen for a 3-1 win. The 25-year-old right-hander was a 16th round pick by the Orioles in 2012 out of Torrey Pines High School in San Diego. He was released by Baltimore in June 2015 and has spent the last three seasons with the Evansville Otters of the independent Frontier League, going 12-10 with a 3.82 ERA in 41 games. Rennie was signed by the Mets on July 4, 2018 and finished last season with Single-A Columbia.

BOUNTY HUNTER: Third baseman **Hunter Owen** had a perfect Friday night at the dish, going 3-for-3 with a double and walk to boost his average to .300 and the top of the Eastern League leaderboard. Owen is also tied for the league lead in homers (14), ranks second in RBIs (42) with the most hits overall (66) and runs scored (42). He ranks second in the league in extra-base hits (30), slugging percentage (.573) and OPS (.946). He has hit safely in 24 of his last 33 games since May 7 while batting .310 (36/116) with seven homers and 16 RBIs. Owen's 45 homers since 2017 are the most by any Pirates minor league and is on pace to hit 31 home runs in 2019, which would match Adam Hyzdu's franchise record from the 2000 season. Pittsburgh's 25th round pick out of Indiana State in 2016 is also on pace rank in the top five in club history in RBIs (92), runs (92) and extra-base hits (66). Owen also has been hit by a league-high 11 pitches, which is on pace to surpass Chris Duffy's team record of 20 during the 2003 season. **For more on single-season club records, see page 100 of the Curve Media Guide.**

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva is riding a season-best, 11-game on-base streak in which he has also hit safely in 8 of 11 with a .244 (10/41) average and five walks since June 3. During his last 11 contests, Oliva has homered in back-to-back games on June 4-5 at Erie to double his total for the season and has been hit by two pitches to raise his tally to seven on the year, fourth-most in the league. The Pirates' seventh round choice in 2017 out of Arizona was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent run. A native of Southern California, Oliva was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 with A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris is heating up in June and has collected 11 hits over his last 12 games, batting .282 with a homer, four doubles, one triple, five walks and six RBIs. Now with 14 doubles on the season, Madris has already set a new single-season career best in that category. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace over his next 28 from April 29-June 1 with three doubles and five RBIs. Madris is a Las Vegas native and was a DII standout at Colorado Mesa before he was drafted in the ninth round in 2017 by the Pirates.

SUMMER CATCH: Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have the most extra-base hits (24) and RBIs (39) than any other catching unit in the Eastern League. Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech, has 11 RBIs in his last 13 games with seven extra-base hits, including two homers, while batting .319 (15/47). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt, is hitting .282 (22/78) with five homers, six doubles, one triple and 20 RBIs over his last 21 games.

ROBBIE'S RETURN: Robbie Glendinning, a member of the Curve's Opening Day roster, was promoted from A-Adv. Bradenton on Thursday and went 2-for-4 with a homer in his first game back on Friday. Glendinning hit .300 (6/20) over nine games before he was sent to Bradenton on April 18. The native of Australia tore up the Florida State League with league-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS and ranked fourth in the league with eight homers and 16 doubles at the time of his promotion. His .339 average between the two levels lead all hitters in the Pirates organization. Without Glendinning's production at the shortstop position, the Curve are batting .200 (42/210) at the position, which would rank 11th on the circuit.

DOING THE SPLITS: Harrisburg became the first team to punch their ticket to the Eastern League Playoffs as First-Half Western Division Champions. The playoff berth for the Senators is their first since 2013, tied with Erie for the longest playoff drought in the Western Division. The Curve have four games remaining in the first half before the standings reset on June 19. Altoona joined the Eastern League in 1999 and is experiencing a split season for the first time in franchise history, which was last played in the E.L. in 1982 at the end of a five-year run from 1978-82. The league also implemented a split-season format during the 1934-35, 1958 and 1975 seasons.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com ranks Oliva as the No. 9 overall prospect in the Pirates organization and RHP **Blake Cederlind** is rated No. 30.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Right-handed pitcher **Dario Agrazal** (2017-19 Curve) is scheduled to make his MLB debut for the Pittsburgh Pirates tonight in Miami, becoming the first member of the 2019 team and 11th former Curve to debut in the majors this season. The most former Curve players to appear in "The Show" for the first time in a single season is 14 in 2014 and 2018. *For more on 2019 MLB debuts by Curve alums, see page 11.*
