**THE LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve claimed their third straight win in a 5-1 decision over Binghamton on Saturday night. **Hunter Owen** clubbed his league-best 15th homer to tie the game, 1-1, in the fourth before **Bligh Madris** hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the sixth. **Pedro Vazquez** earned his sixth victory of the year with seven one-run innings and also singled during a two-run seventh inning. Binghamton had one runner get beyond first base in the form of a lead-off triple in the first by Andres Gimenez, who scored their lone run on a groundout.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve go for the sweep of a three-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. The Curve are going for their third sweep of the year while each of their previous two have also been road series. After the final contest in the Southern Tier for the season, the two clubs will wrap up the season series with four games at the end of the month on June 27-30 in Altoona. The Curve are 7-12 against Eastern Division opponents in 2019 after winning 4 of 5 against the other half of the league.

**THE CURVE:** The Curve are an Eastern League-best 11-3 in June. They have won four straight series after sweeping Erie on their last road trip, a 5-2 homestand against Akron and Portland and taking the first two games in Binghamton. Despite a .231 (101/438) team average this month, Altoona has hammered a league-best 12 homers in June after a league-low 30 home runs through the first two months of the season. Curve pitchers entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.09 ERA (80 ER/232.2 IP) over the last 27 games brought it down to 3.77. In June, Altoona pitchers have the fourth-lowest ERA (2.66) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. in May (5.00).

**THE RUMBLE PONIES:** Binghamton were eliminated from first half playoff contention with a loss last night with two games left in the half. The club has gone 3-11 over their last 14 games after leading the Eastern Division at 30-18 at the start of play on May 31. Binghamton will be off on Monday and will travel to New Hampshire for three games and back during the transition between halves. Binghamton has gone 19-8 against the Western Division while holding a 14-21 mark against the Eastern Division. The Rumble Ponies offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.246), runs per game (4.6) and are second in the league with runners in scoring position (.268). The club's pitching staff owns the highest ERA in the league in June (5.89) and ranks 11th overall with a 3.90 ERA.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Beau Sulser** will make his first Double-A start and 17th appearance of the season. Sulser worked a career-high five innings in his most recent outing on June 11 with one run allowed. In 16 outings from the bullpen, Sulser has worked multiple innings 14 times with scoreless relief 12 times. Sulser pitched three innings in relief on May 14 at Binghamton and hit a solo home run for the team's only run of the game. Today's starting assignment will be Sulser's first since August 28, 2017 with the short-season West Virginia Black Bears of the New York-Penn League and worked five innings against State College. A native of Escondido, Calif., Sulser started 21 games at Dartmouth College and was the Ivy League Pitcher of the Year as a senior in 2017 when he went 6-1 with a 1.40 ERA over seven starts. Sulser was drafted by the Pirates in the 10th round of the 2017 draft...*For more on Sulser, see page two.*

**FOR BINGHAMTON:** Left-hander David Peterson takes the mound for his 12th start. In his latest outing, he took a no-decision in his longest outing of the season by pitching 6.1 innings against Trenton and allowed four runs. The Denver native struck out seven Curve hitters over five one-run inning, allowing a solo homer to Beau Sulser in the second game of a double-header on May 14. He is in his first Double-A season and was a South Atlantic League All-Star with Single-A Columbia in 2018. Peterson was the 20th overall selection by the Mets in the 2017 draft out of the University of Oregon and is rated by MLB.com as the club's No. 5 prospect.

**BOUNTY HUNTER:** Third baseman **Hunter Owen** hammered his league-leading 15th homer on Saturday night while also ranking second in batting average (.300) and RBIs (43). He also paces the circuit in runs scored (44), slugging percentage (.583), OPS (.958), hits (67), extra-base hits (31) and hit-by-pitch (11). Owen's 46 homers since 2017 are the most by any Pirates minor league and is on pace to hit 32 home runs in 2019, which would break Adam Hyzdu's franchise record of 31 during the 2000 season. Pittsburgh's 25th round pick out of Indiana State in 2016 is also on pace rank in the top five in club history in RBIs (93), runs (95) and extra-base hits (67). Owen is also on pace to break Chris Duffy's record of 20 hit-by-pitch. *For more on single-season club records, see page 100 of the Curve Media Guide.* Owen has hit safely in 25 of his last 34 games since May 7 while batting .311 (37/119) with eight homers and 17 RBIs.

**OLIVA COMING ALIVE:** **Jared Oliva** is riding a season-best 12-game on-base streak in which he has also hit safely in 9 of 12 with a .239 (11/46) average and five walks since June 3. During his last 12 contests, Oliva has homered in back-to-back games on June 4-5 at Erie to double his total for the season, walked five times and has stolen three bases. The Pirates' seventh round choice in 2017 out of Arizona was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent run. A native of Southern California, Oliva was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

**BLIGH GUY:** **Bligh Madris** is heating up in June and has collected 12 hits over his last 13 games since June 2, batting .286 with two homers, four doubles, one triple, six walks and eight RBIs. Now with 14 doubles on the season, Madris has already set a new single-season career best in that category. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace over his next 28 from April 29-June 1 with three doubles and five RBIs. Madris is a Las Vegas native and was a DII stand-out at Colorado Mesa before he was drafted in the ninth round in 2017 by the Pirates.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have the most extra-base hits (24) and RBIs (39) than any other catching unit in the Eastern League. Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech, has 11 RBIs in his last 14 games with seven extra-base hits, including two homers, while batting .294 (15/51). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt, is hitting .282 (22/78) with five homers, six doubles, one triple and 20 RBIs over his last 21 games.

**ROBBIE'S RETURN:** **Robbie Glendinning**, a member of the Curve's Opening Day roster, was promoted from A-Adv. Bradenton on Thursday and has gone 2-for-7 with a homer on Friday and three walks. Glendinning hit .300 (6/20) over nine games before he was sent to Bradenton on April 18. The native of Australia tore up the Florida State League with league-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS and ranked fourth in the league with eight homers and 16 doubles at the time of his promotion. His .333 average between the two levels lead all hitters in the Pirates organization. Without Glendinning's production at the shortstop position, the Curve are batting .200 (42/210) at the position, which would rank 11th on the circuit.

**DOING THE SPLITS:** The Curve have three games remaining in the first half before the standings reset on June 19. Harrisburg became the first team to punch their ticket to the Eastern League Playoffs as First-Half Western Division Champions. The playoff berth for the Senators is their first since 2013, tied with Erie for the longest playoff drought in the Western Division. Altoona joined the Eastern League in 1999 and is experiencing a split season for the first time in franchise history, which was last played in the E.L. in 1982 at the end of a five-year run from 1978-82. The league also implemented a split-season format during the 1934-35, 1958 and 1975 seasons.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com ranks Oliva as the No. 9 overall prospect in the Pirates organization and RHP **Blake Cederlind** is rated No. 30.
