THE LAST TIME OUT: Before being rained out on Sunday in Binghamton, the Curve claimed their third straight win in a 5-1 decision over Rumble Ponies on Saturday night. Hunter Owen clubbed his league-best 15th homer to tie the game, 1-1, in the fourth before Bligh Madris hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the sixth. Pedro Vasquez earned his sixth victory of the year with seven one-run innings and also singled during a two-run seventh inning. Binghamton had one runner get beyond first base in the form of a lead-off triple in the first by Andres Gimenez, who scored their lone run on a groundout.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve welcome the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, for a three-game series. It is the last stanza of the Route 22 Rivalry in Altoona before the two clubs convene in the Pennsylvania capital for two different series in August, inlcuding the season finale over Labor Day weekend on City Island. One of just two games in the Eastern League today, the Curve have two games left in the first half before the standings reset for Wednesday's series finale.

NO STRANGER TO THE RAIN: Sunday's postponement in Binghamton was the seventh postponed game of the season for the Curve. That number does not include a suspended game from May 30, that was to be played during a double-header due to a rainout the night before, that will be made up on July 30. Four of those games have been made up in double-headers. Altoona also has endured six rain delays to this stage of the season.

THE CURVE: The Curve are an Eastern League-best 11-3 in June. They have won four straight series after sweeping Erie and Binghamton on their last two road trips and a 5-2 homestand against Akron and Portland. Despite a .231 (101/438) team average this month, Altoona has hammered 12 homers in June after a league-low 30 home runs through the first two months of the season. Curve pitchers entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.13 ERA (81 ER/232.2 IP) over the last 27 games brought it down to 3.77. In June, Altoona pitchers have the third-lowest ERA (2.66) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. in May (5.00).

THE SENATORS: Harrisburg snapped a five-year playoff drought by winning the First Half Western Division title. With the Senators as the first team to reach the postseason, the Erie SeaWolves now own the longest dry spell in the Western Division. Meanwhile, Harrisburg went 21-4 in April, 13-16 in May and 7-7 so far in June. The Senators offense paced the league with 28 homers in April and hit .250 as a club but have hit a league-low 26 home run since May 1 while hitting at a .231 pace and 158 runs scored, each third lowest in the league over that time. From a pitching perspective, the Senators have been consistently one of the best units in the league, ranking second in team ERA (3.28).

FOR ALTOONA: Left-handed pitcher Sean Brady will make his eighth start for Altoona and 13th outing overall in 2019. Brady last pitched on June 12 and matched a season-best with seven innings of work but was dealt a losing decision after he allowed two runs in a 6-1 defeat to Portland. The Florida native has eaten up at least six innings in six of his seven starts with the Curve, including four quality starts. Today's start will be just his second career outing against Harrisburg after leading the E.L. in starts in 2018 with Akron. He spent the first six years of his professional career in the Cleveland Indians organization and was released by Cleveland on May 1 and signed with the Pirates on May 6. He was originally drafted by the Indians in the fifth round of the 2013 draft out of high school....For more on Brady, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Ben Braymer makes his 13th start of the campaign and first career start against the Curve. Braymer is coming off eight hitless innings on June 12 at Richmond in which he struck out seven hitters. However, that contest went into extra innings and the Senators were defeated, 1-0, on a walk-off single by Jalen Miller to score the placed runner at second base. In his first Double-A season, Braymer ranks ninth in the league with a 2.55 ERA, fifth with a 0.95 WHIP, sixth with a .190 batting average against and sixth with 74 innings pitched. He owns the lowest batting average against (.190) and WHIP (0.95) along with the second-lowest ERA (2.55) among pitchers in the Nationals minor league system. Braymer was drafted by Washington in the 18th round in 2018 out of Auburn and is ranked as the No. 20 prospect in the Nationals developmental system by *Baseball America*.

BOUNTY HUNTER: Third baseman **Hunter Owen** hammered his league-leading 15th homer on Saturday night while also ranking second in batting average (.300) and RBIs (43). He also paces the circuit in runs scored (44), slugging percentage (.583), OPS (.958), hits (67) and hit-by-pitch (11). Owen's 46 homers since 2017 are the most by any Pirates minor league while one pace for 32 in 2016, which would break Adam Hyzdu's franchise record of 31 during the 2000 season. Pittsburgh's 25th round pick out of Indiana State in 2016 is also on pace rank in the top five in club history in RBIs (93), runs (95) and extra-base hits (67). Owen is also on pace to break Chris Duffy's record of 20 hit-by-pitch. *For more on single-season club records, see page 100 of the Curve Media Guide*. Owen has hit safely in 25 of his last 34 games since May 7 while batting .311 (37/119) with eight homers and 17 RBIs.

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva is riding a season-best 12-game on-base streak in which he has also hit safely in 9 of 12 with a .239 (11/46) average and five walks since June 3. During his last 12 contests, Oliva has homered in back-to-back games on June 4-5 at Erie to double his total for the season, walked five times and has stolen three bases. The Pirates' seventh round choice in 2017 out of Arizona was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent run. A native of Southern California, Oliva was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris is heating up in June and has collected 12 hits over his last 13 games since June 2, batting .286 with two homers, four doubles, one triple, six walks and eight RBIs. Now with 14 doubles on the season, Madris has already set a new single-season career best in that category. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace over his next 28 from April 29-June 1 with three doubles and five RBIs. Madris is a Las Vegas native and was a DII standout at Colorado Mesa before he was drafted in the ninth round in 2017 by the Pirates.

SUMMER CATCH: Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have the most extra-base hits (24) and RBIs (39) than any other catching unit in the Eastern League. Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech, has 11 RBIs in his last 14 games with seven extra-base hits, including two homers, while batting .294 (15/51). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt, is hitting .282 (22/78) with five homers, six doubles, one triple and 20 RBIs over his last 21 games.

ROBBIE'S RETURN: Robbie Glendinning, a member of the Curve's Opening Day roster, was promoted from A-Adv. Bradenton on Thursday and has gone 2-for-7 with a homer on Friday and three walks. Glendinning hit .300 (6/20) over nine games before he was sent to Bradenton on April 18. The native of Australia tore up the Florida State League with league-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS and ranked fourth in the league with eight homers and 16 doubles at the time of his promotion. His .333 average between the two levels lead all hitters in the Pirates organization. Without Glendinning's production at the shortstop position, the Curve are batting .200 (42/210) at the position, which would rank 11th on the circuit.

DOING THE SPLITS: Altoona is experiencing a split season for the first time since joining the Eastern League in 1999. The last time the E.L. used the format was in 1982 at the end of a five-year run from 1978-82. The league also implemented a split-season format during the 1934-35, 1958 and 1975 seasons.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com ranks Oliva as the No. 9 overall prospect in the Pirates organization and RHP **Blake Cederlind** is rated No. 30.



In eight Double-A starts between Akron and Altoona, Brady is 2-6 with a 5.77 ERA (37 ER/57.2 IP)... Tossed quality starts in four of last five outings with a 3.31 ERA (12 ER/32.2 IP) and has thrown at least six innings in each of his last six starts...Making second career start against Harrisburg after June 22, 2018 for Akron at Canal Park (5.2 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 5 SO)

Sean Michael Brady...Attended Ida S. Baker High School in Cape Coral, Fla...Drafted by the Cleveland Indians in the fifth round (141st overall) in the 2013 draft...Committed to play collegiately at the University of Florida before signing pro contract...Spent part of first seven seasons with the Indians organization, reaching Triple-A in 2018 and 2019...2014 New York-Penn League All-Star with short-season Mahoning Valley and finished seventh in the league with a 2.79 ERA...Pitched four-most innings in Midwest League during 2015 with Single-A Lake County...Won a career-best 12 games in 2016 with A-Adv. Lynchurg, which was tied for the most victories on the circuit... Limited to 10 outings in 2017 due to left shoulder strain and did not debut until July 16 with AZL Indians and built his way back to A-Adv.
