**THE LAST TIME OUT:** The Curve evened up their series with a 3-1 win over Harrisburg. All three Curve runs scored in the first three innings but without a hit with runners in scoring position. The club went 0-for-14 in the clutch and scored runs on a ground out, fielder's choice and a sacrifice fly. **Brandon Waddell** pitched four innings in his return to Double-A and surrendered just one run in the third while striking out five. **Jared Oliva** had a perfect, 3-for-3 night with a walk and one stolen base while **Alfredo Reyes** collected two hits and stole two bases from the leadoff spot.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve kick off the second half with **TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Attoona Curve Basebalt continues as the Curve Rick off the second half with the rubber match of their three-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Today is the final game in Altoona between the Route 22 Rivals before two clubs meet on City Island for three games in mid-August and finish the regular season over four games during Labor Day weekend. The Senators won the first won the first five games of the seasons series, inlcuding a three-game sweep at PNG Field April 15-17, but have won five of the last seven head-to-heads. A win today would extend Altoona's season-long streak of five straight series wins.

**THE CURVE:** The Curve toll into the second half an Eastern League-best 12-4 in June. The club has won four straight series after sweeping Erie and Binghamton on their last two road trips and a 5-2 homestand against Akron and Portland. Despite a .233 (118/506) team average this month, Altoona has hammered 12 homers in June after a league-low 30 home runs through the first two months of the season. Curve pitchers entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league, before a 3.02 ERA (84 ER/250.2 IP), third-lowest in the league over that period, over the last 29 games brought it down to 3.69. In June, Altoona pitchers have the third-lowest ERA (2.51) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. during May (5.00).

**THE SENATORS:** Harrisburg snapped a five-year playoff drought by winning the First Half Western Division title. With the Senators as the first team to reach the postseason, the Erie SeaWolves now own the longest dry spell in the Western Division by not reaching the postseason since 2013. The Senators had a red-hot 21-4 record in April before going 21-24 since. The Senators offense paced the league with 28 homers in April but have hit a league-low 26 home runs since May 1 while hitting at a .230 pace and 163 runs scored, each third lowest in the league over that time. From a pitching perspective, the Senators have been consistently one of the best units in the league, ranking second in team ERA (3.26).

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **James Marvel** makes the his team-high 14th start of the season. Marvel, the Curve's Opening Day starter, gets the second half opener after he earned his sixth victory of the season on in his last outing after seven, two-run innings against Portland. He is also making his third career start against Harrisburg, all in 2019, with three runs allowed over 10 innings combined and nine strikeouts. A native of the Bay Area, Marvel was drafted by the Pirates in the 36th round in 2015 after injury limited the righty to just 13 collegiate outings at Duke University. **For more on Marvel, see page two.** 

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Steven Fuentes makes his ninth Double-A appearance and fifth start while facing Altoona for the second time. The 22-year-old has tossed season-high six innings in each of the last two starts, allowing a combined two earned runs. Fuentes made one outing in relief against the Curve at PNG Field where he threw 1.2 hitless, scoreless frames. A native of Panama and an international free agent signing by the Nationals in July 2013, Fuentes started the year with A-Adv. Potomac and pitched eight games in relief before he was promoted to Double-A for the first time in his career.

**HOME COOKIN':** Altoona is 12-7 and have won 4 of their last 5 series at PNG Field since May 10. The team started 5-10 through their first 15 home games and have been over .500 for one day this season following a walk-off victory in the home opener on April 11 prior to losing the last five games of the first homestand of 2019.

**BOUNTY HUNTER: Hunter Owen** finished the first half as the Eastern League leader in home runs (15), hits (68), runs (44), hit-by-pitch (12) and total bases (131). He is also ranked second in batting average (.294), slugging percentage (.567), RBIs (43) and extra-base hits (31). Owen has recorded at least one hit in 26 of his last 36 games since May 7 to compile a .299 (38/127) average with eight homers and 17 RBIs. His .970 fielding percentage at third base is the highest in the league at the position but he played the outfield for the first time since July 27, 2017 on Tuesday.

**HOME RUN HISTORY:** The home run pace in 2019 for **Hunter Owen** is one of the highest in team history. Owen reached 15 homers in 64 games, just one game shy of **Jordan Luplow**'s 63-game pace in 2017. **Josh Bonifay** reached the 15-homer mark in 2005 in just 55 games but he did not debut until April 18 and homered for the 15th time on July 3. Under the Eastern League's current all-star format, Bonifay's 17 and Luplow's 16 at the break are the most in club history. Since the start of the 2017 season, Owen has hit more home runs (46) than any Pirates minor leaguer. He is currently on pace for 31 homers in 2019, which would tie **Adam Hyzdu**'s franchise record during the 2000 season. At this time during Hyzdu's record-setting season, he had 12 homers but reached 20 by July 3. **For more on single-season club records, see page 100 of the Curve Media Guide.** 

**OLIVA COMING ALIVE:** Jared Oliva picked up his first three-hit games at Double-A on Tuesday to extend his on-base streak to 14 games, the third-longest active streak in the league and two games shy of matching the longest by a Curve player this season. Oliva has hit safely in 11 of 14 with a .296 (16/54) average, four multi-hit games, four doubles, two homers, four steals, 11 runs and six walks since June 3. The Pirates' seventh round choice in 2017 out of Arizona was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent run. A native of Southern California, Oliva was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

**BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris** is heating up in June and has collected 14 hits over his last 15 games since June 2, batting .292 (14/48) with two homers, four doubles, one triple, nine walks and eight RBIs. Now with 14 doubles on the season, Madris has already set a new single-season career best in that category. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1. Madris is a Las Vegas native and was a DII standout at Colorado Mesa before he was drafted in 2017 during the ninth round by the Pirates.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have the most extra-base hits (25) and RBIs (40) than any other catching unit in the Eastern League while batting a combined .250. Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech in 2016, has 12 RBIs in his last 15 games with eight extra-base hits, including two homers, while batting .296 (16/54). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt from 2014-17, is hitting .277 (23/83) with five homers, six doubles, one triple and 20 RBIs over his last 22 games.

**ROBBIE'S RETURN: Robbie Glendinning**, a member of the Curve's Opening Day roster, was promoted from A-Adv. Bradenton on Thursday and has gone 2-for-9 with a homer on Friday and six walks in three games. Glendinning hit .300 (6/20) over nine games before he was sent to Bradenton on April 18. The native of Australia tore up the Florida State League with league-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS and ranked fourth in the league with eight homers and 16 doubles at the time of his promotion. His .330 average between the two levels leads all hitters in the Pirates organization. Without Glendinning's production at the shortstop position, Curve shortstops are batting .205 (44/215), which would rank 10th on the circuit.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com ranks Oliva as the No. 9 overall prospect in the Pirates organization and RHP **Blake Cederlind** is rated No. 30.

**WINNING WAYS:** The Curve have reached the postseason each of the last four seasons, the Eastern League's longest active streak. Trenton matched that mark on Tuesday with their first half division crown (2016-2019). Over the last four seasons, the Curve have tied a franchise record from 2003-06 for most consecutive playoff berths and have the best record (337-290) among Western Division teams since the start of the 2015 season.


