THE LAST TIME OUT: Prior to an off day on Thursday, the Curve opened the second half with a 3-1 victory over Harrisburg and took 2 of 3 over the Senators. James Marvel matched a career high with nine strikeouts while pitching a Double-A best 7.2 innings of one-run ball. Robbie Glendinning singled home runs during the first and third frames while Hunter Owen doubled the first score of a two-run third inning. Mitchell Tolman (3-for-4) and Bligh Madris (2-for-4) also recorded multi-hit games while Matt Eckelman picked up his 10th save of the year and 21st at the Double-A level.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve start a six-game road trip with the first of three against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the only visit to Dunkin' Donuts Park for Altoona in 2019 while Hartford will make the trek to PNG Field for three games on August 19-21. The Curve are playing the sixth of 16 straight National League-style games through the end of June before using a designated hitter against American League-affiliated squads for all but four games in July.

**THE CURVE**: The Curve are an Eastern League-best 13-4 in June and have won five straight series after not stringing together consecutive series victories in April and May. After going 1-7 from May 21-28 during the club's longest road trip, Altoona has won five consecutive road games after sweeps in Erie and Binghamton with at least one home run hit in each contest. Another part of the recent turnaround has seen the ballclub go 4-1 in their last two series facing Eastern Division opponents after starting the season 3-11 against the other half of the league. The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE YARD GOATS: Hartford was in the mix on the final day of the first half but have lost 6 of 7 and are 6-10 in June. The Yard Goats were the best team in the E.L. during May, going 19-8 to position themselves for a first half postseason berth. Hartford's pitching staff leads the league at a 2.81 ERA and have issued the fewest walk on the circuit with the second-most strikeouts. Additionally, the Hartford bullpen ranks first in the league with a 2.38 ERA. From a hitting perspective, the 'Goats leave the yard at the second-highest league with 57 homers, trailing only Akron's 60, despite the second-lowest team batting average of .225. Yard Goats games have been low-scoring affairs, averaging 3.5 runs scored (second-lowest offensively) to 3.3 runs allowed (lowest defensively). Hartford is 9-21 against Western Division clubs and are coming off a three-game sweep to the hands of Bowie to start their homestand. homestand.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander **Domingo Robles** makes his fifth Double-A start after he needed 101 pitches to get through 4.2 frames of a no-decision last Friday in Binghamton. Robles was the Opening Day starter for A-Adv. Bradenton this season and owns the second-lowest ERA (2.60) and innings total (84.2) among Pirates minor league pitchers. Robles, a 21-year-old native of the Dominican Republic, was signed by Pittsburgh as an international free agent on July 2, 2014...**For more on Robles, see page two.** 

**FOR HARTFORD:** Left-hander Ty Culbreth, a 25-year-old from Bryan, Texas, gets the ball for his 14th start. In his latest outing, Culbreth allowed three unearned runs over five innings at Akron but suffered his fifth consecutive losing decision. Over his last five outings, Culbreth has a respectable 3.91 ERA (11 ER/25.1 IP) but has received just seven runs of offensive support in those starts. The former Texas Longhorn won three of his first four starts of the season with his last victory coming on April 23 at Portland. Culbreth was drafted by the Rockies in the eighth round of the 2016 draft and is in his first Double-A season

**BRAKE MEN:** Curve pitchers entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league. Over the last 30 games, the pitching staff has lowered it to 3.65 thanks to a 2.95 ERA (85 ER/259.2 IP), the second-lowest mark in the league over that period. In June, Altoona pitchers have the lowest ERA (2.42) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. during May (5.00). Additionally, the bullpen has not allowed a run over the last 18 innings worked by the unit, a stretch going back seven games to June 12.

MAKING THE PLAYS: The Curve defense has the highest fielding percentage (.985) in Minor League Baseball. The Altoona defenders have put away outs while their pitchers have put a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (471) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (190) in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

**OLIVA COMING ALIVE:** Jared Oliva had his season-long, 14-game on-base streak snapped with an 0-for-3 night on Wednesday. Oliva has hit safely in 11 of 15 with a .281 (16/57) average, four multi-hit games, four doubles, two homers, four steals, 11 runs and six walks since June 3. The Pirates' seventh round choice in 2017 out of Arizona was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent run. A native of Southern California, Oliva was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

**BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris** is heating up in June and has collected 16 hits over his last 16 games since June 2, batting .308 (16/52) with two homers, five doubles, one triple, nine walks and eight RBIs. Now with 14 doubles on the season, Madris has already set a new single-season career best in that category. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1. Madris is a Las Vegas native and was a DII standout at Colorado Mesa before he was drafted in 2017 during the ninth round by the Pirates.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have the most extra-base hits (25) and second-most RBIs (40) than any other catching unit in the Eastern League while batting a combined .247. Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech in 2016, has 12 RBIs in his last 16 games with eight extra-base hits, including two homers, while batting .281 (16/57). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt from 2014-17, is hitting .277 (23/83) with five homers, six doubles, one triple and 20 RBIs over his last 22 games.

ROBBIE'S RETURN: Robbie Glendinning, a member of the Curve's Opening Day roster, was promoted from A-Adv. Bradenton last Thursday and has gone 4-for-11 with a homer, four RBIs and six walks in four games. Glendinning hit .300 (6/20) over nine games at the start of the campaign before he was sent to Bradenton on April 18. The Aussie tore up the Florida State League with league-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS and ranked fourth in the league with eight homers and 16 doubles at the time of his promotion. His .337 average between the two levels leads all hitters in the Pirates organization. Without Glendinning's production at the shortstop position, Curve shortstops are batting a combined .205 (44/215).

**RYAN'S REIGN:** Indiana, Pa. native **Michael Ryan** is in elite company with Dale Sveum (2001-03) and Tim Leiper (2006-08) as the only managers to hold the post in Altoona for three seasons. During his time as the Altoona skipper, the Curve have gone 188-158 (.542) under Ryan's direction and won back-to-back Western Division titles (2017-18) for the first time in club history. Ryan's 188 managerial victories are third-most in club history while Sveum and Leiper share the franchise record with 213 wins as Curve manager.

**ROSTER SHAKEUP:** Without any roster movement from June 1-12, the Curve have shuffled several pieces around over the last week. Since June 13, **Logan Hill, Blake Weiman** and, most recently, **Hunter Owen** have all been promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis for the first time in their careers. At the time of his promotion on Friday, Owen led the Eastern League in home runs (15), hits (70), runs (45), total bases (134) and hit-by-pitch (12) while he ranked second in batting average (.298), extra-base hits (32) and slugging percentage (.570). *For more on roster transactions, see page 11.* 

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com ranks Oliva as the No. 9 overall prospect in the Pirates organization and RHP **Blake Cederlind** is rated No. 30.
