THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve returned to action and were defeated in a thrilling, 7-6 game in Hartford. Yard Goats outfielder Vance Vizcaino delivered a clutch two-out, two-run double to right that gave Hartford the lead in the eighth against Altoona releiver Joel Cesar. The two clubs combined for five home runs over the first five innings, including a two-run blast by Bligh Madris, who drive in three runs total, during the thrid and Mitchell Tolman's solo shot in the fifth. Hartford's bullpen retired the final 14 Curve batters following go-ahead, RBI double by Robbie Glendinning in the fifth. Yeudy Garcia logged a season-high-tying three scoreless innings and fanned four, including all three outs in the sixth to escape a bases-loaded situation that preserved a one-run advantage at the time. The loss on Friday broke a five-game road winning streak for the Curve and was the first loss the club has suffered when leading after seven innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve plays the second of three against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the only visit to Dunkin' Donuts Park for Altoona in 2019 while Hartford will make the trek to PNG Field for three games on August 19-21. The Curve are playing the seventh of 16 straight National League-style games through the end of June before using a designated hitter against American League-affiliated squads for all but four games in July.

THE CURVE: The Curve are 13-5 in June, second-best in the league behind Bowie's 14-4 month, and have won five straight series after not stringing together consecutive series victories in April and May. Altoona has won 5 of 6 road games and have homered in each of their last six games away from PNG Field. The Curve hold a 7-13 record against the Eastern Division but have won 4 of 6 over their last three series against the other half of the league. The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE YARD GOATS: Hartford was the best team in the E.L. during May, going 19-8 and won 12 of 16 before dropping 6 of their last 8. Hartford's pitching staff leads the league at a 2.86 ERA and have issued the fewest walks on the circuit with the second-most strikeouts. Additionally, the Hartford bullpen ranks first in the league with a 2.40 ERA. From a hitting perspective, the 'Goats leave the yard at the second-highest clip in the league with 60 homers, trailing only Akron's 61, despite the second-lowest team batting average of .227. Yard Goats games have been low-scoring affairs, averaging 3.6 runs scored (second-lowest offensively) to 3.3 runs allowed (lowest defensively). Hartford is 10-21 against Western Division clubs and are coming off a three-game sweep to Bowie to start their homestand.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-handed pitcher Pedro Vasquez will make his 13th outing with Altoona and 15th overall between Double-A and Triple-A. The 23-year-old has recorded wins in each of his last four starts and has allowed one run in his last 25 innings along with 23 strikeouts. In his latest appearance in Binghamton last Saturday, he spun a season-high seven innings for his seventh victory overall. Vasquez has faced a Rockies affiliate one time in his career when he pitched for the DSL Mariners during his rookie debut season in 2015. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent in 2015 and was traded to the Pirates organization in September 2016 as a player-to-be-named later for RHP Arquimedes Caminero... FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Matt Dennis makes his Double-A debut after he was promoted from A-Adv. Lancaster on Thursday. The 24-year-old was 2-3 with a 5.60 ERA over 16 games, including sevens starts, with the Jet Hawks. In 2018, Dennis was 8-13 with a 5.59 ERA in 28 starting appearances with Lancaster. A native of Arlington Heights, Ill., Dennis was a 14th round pick by the Rockies in 2016 out of Bradley University.

BRAKE MEN: Curve pitchers entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league. Over the last 31 games, the pitching staff has lowered it to 3.71 thanks to a 3.09 ERA (92 ER/267.2 IP), the third-lowest mark in the league over that period. In June, Altoona pitchers have the second-lowest ERA (2.69) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. during May (5.00). Additionally, the bullpen has carried a 1.88 ERA (10 ER/28 IP) over the last 15 games that included an eight-game stretch of 22 consecutive scoreless innings from June 12-June 21.

GLOVE TRAIN: The Curve defense has the highest fielding percentage (.985) in Minor League Baseball and have turned the third-most double plays (69) among Double-A clubs. Altoona defenders have put away outs with pitchers putting a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (478) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (193) in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva has been on base in 15 of his last 16 games while batting .271 (16/59) with four multi-hit games, five doubles, two homers, five steals, 12 runs and seven walks since June 3. The Pirates' seventh-round choice in 2017 out of Arizona was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent upswing. A native of Southern California, Oliva was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris is heating up in June and has collected 18 hits over his last 17 games since June 2, batting .321 (18/56) with three homers, five doubles, one triple, nine walks and 11 RBIs during six multi-hit games. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1. Madris is a Las Vegas native and was a DII standout at Colorado Mesa before he was drafted by the Pirates in 2017 during the ninth round.

SUMMER CATCH: Altoona catchers **Jason Delay** and **Arden Pabst** have the most extra-base hits (25) and second-most RBIs (40) than any other catching unit in the Eastern League while batting a combined .247. Pabst, drafted out of Georgia Tech in 2016, has 12 RBIs in his last 16 games with eight extra-base hits, including two homers, while batting .281 (16/57). Delay, who played collegiately at Vanderbilt from 2014-17, is hitting .267 (23/86) with five homers, six doubles, one triple and 20 RBIs over his last 23 games since May 3.

ROBBIE'S RETURN: Robbie Glendinning, a member of the Curve's Opening Day roster, was promoted from A-Adv. Bradenton last Thursday and has gone 5-for-15 with a homer, one double, five RBIs and six walks in five games. Glendinning hit .300 (6/20) over nine games at the start of the campaign before he was sent to Bradenton on April 18. The Aussie tore up the Florida State League with league-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS and ranked fourth in the league with eight homers and 16 doubles at the time of his promotion. His .335 average between the two levels leads all hitters in the Pirates organization. Without Glendinning's production at the shortstop position, Curve shortstops are batting a combined .205 (44/215).

RYAN'S REIGN: Indiana, Pa. native **Michael Ryan** is in elite company with Dale Sveum (2001-03) and Tim Leiper (2006-08) as the only managers to hold the post in Altoona for three seasons. During his time as the Altoona skipper, the Curve have gone 188-159 (.542) under Ryan's direction and won back-to-back Western Division titles (2017-18) for the first time in club history. Ryan's 188 managerial victories are third-most in club history while Sveum and Leiper share the franchise record with 213 wins as Curve manager.

NO OFFENSE: The Eastern League batting average stands at .236 while teams are scoring 3.97 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95). The last time the E.L. saw offenses hit below .240 and score fewer than 4.0 runs per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features one of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com ranks Oliva as the No. 9 overall prospect in the Pirates organization and RHP **Blake Cederlind** is rated No. 30.
