THE LAST TIME OUT: Pirates Top 30 prospect Cody Bolton took the mound for his Double-A debut against Richmond and faced the minimum with six strikeouts over his first four innings. However, the Flying Squirrels worked two walks sandwhiched between two singles to get on the board and chase the young righty with the bases loaded in the fifth. Johneshwy Fargas uncorked a three-run triple on the fourth pitch from Joel Cesar out of the Curve bullpen to push Richmond ahead, 4-2. The Flying Squirrels connected for two more runs in the sixth agianst Austin Coley. The Curve built an early 2-0 lead with a pair of RBI singles by Robbie Glendinning while Mitchell Tolman reached base four times with two hits and two walks to go with two steals.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve begin a five-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. PNG Field absorbed a rain out in Binghamton on Father's Day to be made up in a double-header on Saturday. The current series will complete the 10-game season series against Binghamton and is the only visit to Altoona for the Rumble Ponies. Binghamton took 2 of 3 in mid-May at NYSEG Stadium before the Curve returned to sweep the abbreviated, two-game set two weeks ago. The Curve are playing the 12th of 16 straight National League-style games through the end of June before using a designated hitter against American League-affiliated squads for all but four games in July.

**THE CURVE**: The Curve are 16-7 in June, trailing only Bowie (17-6) for the best record in the Eastern League this month, and have won 6 of their last 7 series. The club is poised to have one of the winningest months in team history, which has been done with 20 wins on three occassions: August 2018, August 2010 and June 2004. Altoona is second in the league in hitting (.251) this month and have gone deep 16 times after a league-low 30 home runs in April and May. Altoona has the best intra-division record (31-21) in their half of the league but are 8-14 against the Eastern Division. The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

**THE RUMBLE PONIES:** Binghamton, a league-worst 7-16 in June, is in the midst of playing or completing nine games in six days. They finished a suspended game against Erie on Monday before playing a double-header on Wednesday. The Rumble Ponies are coming off losses in 6 of 7 including a three-game sweep to Richmond and losing 3 of 4 to Erie on their latest homestand. Binghamton is the best road team in the league with a 26-12 mark away from NYSEG Stadium. The Rumble Ponies lead the Eastern League with 4.3 runs per game and rank second in total team batting average (.244) and runners in scoring position (.264) but have hit the fewest homers (40) on the circuit. The pitching staff ranks 11th with a 3.82 ERA.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander **Domingo Robles** makes his fifth Double-A start, second against Binghamton, and 16th overall. He is coming off a season-low four innings pitched and season-high five runs allowed in his last start at Hartford where he allowed three solo homers in the hitter-friendly confines of Dunkin' Donuts Park. Robles was the Opening Day starter for A-Adv. Bradenton this season and is ranked sixth in the Pirates minor league system with a 3.05 ERA and is second with 88.2 innings between the two levels. Robles, a 21-year-old native of the Dominican Republic, was signed by Pittsburgh as an international free agent on July 2, 2014...*For more on Robles, see page two.* 

**FOR BINGHAMTON:** Right-hander Andrew Church takes the hill for his third Double-A outing and fourth appearance overall in 2019. Church retired at age 23 last May but returned to baseball after a short step back as a car salesman, bartender and trainer. He was the Mets' second round pick in the 2013 draft out of his high school in Henderson, Nev. and rose through the system to reach Double-A Binghamton for one start in 2017. He topped out at Triple-A for two games last season before his semi-retirement.

**HOME COOKIN':** Altoona is 13-7 and have won 5 of their last 6 series at PNG Field since May 10. The team started 5-10 through their first 15 home games and currently have a winning record at home for the first time since winning their home opener on April 11.

**NO OFFENSE:** The Eastern League batting average stands at .237 while teams are scoring 3.96 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95). The last time the E.L. saw offenses hit below .240 and score fewer than 4.0 runs per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57).

**GLOVE TRAIN:** The Curve defense has the highest fielding percentage (.985) in Minor League Baseball and have turned the third-most double plays (72) among Double-A clubs. Altoona defenders have put away outs with pitchers putting a high rate of balls in play with the fewest strikeouts (521) in the Minors and the fifth-fewest walks (207) in Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

**BRAKE MEN:** Curve pitchers entered play May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league. Over the last 36 games, the pitching staff has lowered it to 3.66 thanks to a 3.07 ERA (106 ER/310.2 IP), the third-best mark in the league over that period. In June, Altoona pitchers have the second-lowest ERA (2.75) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. during May (5.00). Additionally, the bullpen owns a 2.31 ERA (16 ER/62.1 IP) over the last 20 games that included an eight-game stretch of 22 consecutive scoreless innings from June 12-June 21.

**OLIVA COMING ALIVE:** Jared Oliva has been on base in 19 of his last 20 games while batting .311 (23/74) with six multi-hit games, seven doubles, two homers, seven steals, 14 runs and 10 walks since June 3. The Pirates' seventh-round choice in 2017 out of Arizona was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent upswing to .234. In his last 10 games, he is hitting .378 (14/37) with six doubles, six steals and six walks. Oliva's 15 steals overall are third-most in the E.L. and ranks tied for second in the Pirates system. A native of Southern California, Oliva was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

**BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris** has enjoyed a fruitful June with 21 hits over his last 21 games since June 2, batting .296 (21/71) with three homers, five doubles, one triple, nine walks and 14 RBIs during seven multi-hit games. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

**G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: Robbie Glendinning** keeps hitting to lead the Pirates organization with a .338 average between Altoona and A-Adv. Bradenton while pacing the system with 74 total hits. A 2019 Florida State League All-Star, the Western Australian native is hitting .351 (13/37) with four extra-base hits, 10 RBIs and six walks in his first 10 games since he rejoined the Curve on June 13. Glendinning was on the Opening Day roster and hit .300 (6/20) over the first nine games of the campaign before he was sent to down on April 18. He responded with a FSL-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games with the Marauders. Without Glendinning's production at the shortstop position, Curve shortstops are batting a combined .205 (44/215).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com has three Top 30 Pirates prospects in Altoona with Oliva (No. 9), Bolton (No. 23) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 30).

HANG A STAR ON THAT ONE: The Eastern League announced the rosters for the 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game on Monday, which included three members of the Altoona Curve roster: right-handed pitchers James Marvel and Pedro Vasquez along with catcher Jason Delay. Delay is the first Curve catcher since Elias Diaz in 2014 to be selected to the E.L. All-Star Game and it is his first career nomination. Marvel, the Curve's Opening Day starter, also received the first all-star selection of his career. Vasquez was previously a 2017 Florida State League All-Star with A-Adv. Bradenton. The 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game will be in Richmond on Wednesday, July 10.
