THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve scored three in the eighth and held off Akron with the bases loaded in the ninth inning to take a 5-4 win on Monday. **Chris Sharpe** and **Robbie Glendinning** delivered doubles to tie the game and take the lead, respectively, during the three-run eighth. Sharpe drove in three total runs and was also involved in the two-run third that scored **Mitchell Tolman** after a game-tying triple. **Beau Sulser** faced the minimum over thre scoreless innings for his seventh win before **Matt Eckelman** wiggled out of a bases-loaded spot for his 14th save.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve play the second contest of a three-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. It is the second and final visit to Canal Park in 2019 after Altoona opened the season and completed club's first-ever four-game sweep in Akron. With six head-to-head games remaining between the two teams, the Curve can clinch the season series with their next win over the RubberDucks. Akron visits Altoona in the team's final home series of 2019 on August 26-29.

THE CURVE: The Curve are 20-9 since June 1, trailing only Bowie (21-7) for the best record in the Eastern League over the last month. During that hot stretch, the Curve have won 7 of 8 series and picked up 19 wins in June. Altoona has the best intra-division record (32-21) among Western Division clubs. The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE RUBBERDUCKS: Akron went 34-35 in the first half, third in the Western Division and have hovered near .500 most of the season. The 'Ducks were a season-low six games under .500 on May 10 and went a league-best 20-11 from May 11-June 13 to reach a season-best three games over .500 (34-31). However, Akron has lost 13 of 19. Akron went 3-4 over a seven-game road trip to Harrisburg and Bowie and return to the road after the current three-game set against the Curve. The 'Ducks lead the E.L. with 73 home runs and runs scored (350) while the pitching staff ranks fifth in the league with a 3.46 ERA.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander **Domingo Robles** makes his six Double-A start and 17th overall. He threw a quality start on Thursday against Binghamton for his second win for Altoona. He makes his second start agianst Akron after he threw a seven-inning, complete-game shutout during a double-header on June at PNG Field for his first Double-A win. Robles was the Opening Day starter for A-Adv. Bradenton this season and is ranked eighth in the Pirates minor league system with a 3.14 ERA between the two levels. Robles, a 21-year-old native of the Dominican Republic, was signed by Pittsburgh as an international free agent on July 2, 2014... *For more on Robles, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Jake Paulson gets the nod for the 14th time at Double-A and 16th outing of the season. He last worked 5.2 innings on June 27 at Bowie and allowed four runs in his return from a start for Triple-A Columbus. He has two total Triple-A outings this season and has allowed eight runs over 10.2 innings. Paulson last faced the Curve in his season debut in Akron on April 5 and allowed four runs in 4.1 innings of a no-decision. The 27-year-old was a 2018 Eastern League All-Star and went 8-5 with a 3.04 ERA in 20 games for Akron last season. He was originally a 27th round pick by the Reds in 2014 out of Oakland (Mich.) University and was released last year in spring training before signing with Cleveland as a free agent.

CHANGING THE NARRATIVE: Monday's win clinched a share of the season series against Akron. The Curve have won or split the series with Akron in each **Michael Ryan**'s three seasons as Curve manager with a 31-23 record. In 21 seasons, the Curve will finish with a .500 or better record against Akron for the seventh time and seek the fifth win in the season series and the first time in consecutive seasons. Currently 5-0 at Canal Park in 2019, Altoona's .411 winning percentage in 207 games at this facility is the lowest at any Western Division ballpark while Trenton (.391 in 87 games) has been the only place tougher historically to win for the Curve.

SPLIT WHILE YOU'RE AHEAD: In the overall season standings, the Curve are two games behind Harrisburg for the top record in the Western Division. Due to the split season, Harrisburg has already claimed the first playoff spot in the division and are currently chasing Erie and Bowie for a playoff berth. Altoona is experiencing a split season for the first time since joining the Eastern League in 1999.

TOUGH YEAR TO HIT: The league-wide average stands at .237 with teams are scoring 3.96 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95). The last time the E.L. saw offenses hit below .240 and score fewer than 4.0 runs per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The Curve are above the league average with 4.0 runs per game and rank second in hitting at .245. The lowest batting average in team history stands at .252 during the 2013 season.

BRAKE MEN: Curve pitchers entered play on May 16 with a 4.22 ERA, which ranked last in the league. The staff has lowered that mark to 3.62 over the last 42 games by holding 3.08 ERA (124 ER/362.2 IP), the third-best mark in the league over that period. In June, Altoona pitchers had the lowest ERA (2.78) in the league after carrying the highest in the E.L. during May (5.00). The bullpen owns a 2.24 ERA (20 ER/80.1 IP) over the last 26 games.

G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: Robbie Glendinning keeps hitting to lead the Pirates organization with a .339 average between Altoona and A-Adv. Bradenton while pacing the system with 81 total hits. He also ranks among the top performers in the Pirates system with 11 homers (6th), 21 doubles (T-2nd) and 44 RBIs (T-5th), all career-highs. A 2019 Florida State League All-Star, the Western Australian native is hitting .351 (20/57) with seven extra-base hits, 14 RBIs and seven walks in his last 16 games since he rejoined the Curve on June 13. Glendinning was on the Curve's Opening Day roster and hit .300 (6/20) over nine games before he was sent to down on April 18. He responded with a FSL-best a .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games with the Marauders.

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva has reached base in 24 of his last 26 games since June 3 while batting .312 (29/93) with eight multi-hit games, nine doubles, three homers, 12 RBIs, nine steals, 16 runs and 12 walks. He was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his recent upswing to .240. Over his last 16 games since June 14, he is hitting .357 (20/56) with eight doubles, one homer, eight steals and eight walks. Oliva's 17 steals are third-most in the E.L. and rank second in the Pirates system. He was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases.

TOLMAN AT THE TOP: Since taking over the leadoff role on June 19, **Mitchell Tolman** has hit .349 (15/43) and been on base in 11 of 12 games with 13 runs scored. Tolman has hit leadoff in 20 games this season and owns a .307 (23/75) ledger from the top of the lineup. Since June 3, he has reached base in 23 of 26 and is batting .316 (31/98) with 17 runs, seven steals and six extra-base hits.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris has batted .272 (25/92) and been on base in 22 of 27 games since June 2 with three homers, five doubles, one triple, 12 walks and 15 RBIs during eight multi-hit performances. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

LOOKIN' SHARPE: Chris Sharpe's last four hits have all been go-ahead or game-tying knocks while he has racked up eight RBIs over the last three games. On Saturday, Sharpe hit a walk-off single in extra innings against Binghamton before he hit a go-ahead grand slam on Sunday in Altoona. On Monday, Sharpe gave the Curve a 2-1 lead in the third on a single to center before a game-tying, two-run double during a three-run eighth. A 2019 Florida State League All-Star, Sharpe was promoted to Double-A on June 21 and ranks fifth in the Pirates system with .278 overall batting average, third with a .369 on-base percentage and third with 15 stolen bases.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com has three Top 30 Pirates prospects in Altoona with Oliva (No. 9), Bolton (No. 23) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 30).

HANG A STAR ON THAT ONE: The Curve are sending three players to the Eastern League All-Star Game with right-handed pitchers **Pedro Vasquez** and **Beau Sulser** joining catcher **Jason Delay**. Sulser was selected to join the Western Division roster after **James Marvel** was promoted to Triple-A on Monday. The 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game will be in Richmond on Wednesday, July 10.
