THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve were beaten, 5-3, by Erie in the first game back from the Eastern League All-Star Break. The SeaWolves jumped ahead in the first with three unearned runs off starter **Sean Brady**. Daniel Pinero hit a two-run double to finish the first and hit a solo homer in the fourth. **Jared Oliva** tripled and scored on the play due to an error for the one score against Erie starter Logan Shore. Down 5-1 entering the ninth, Oliva doubled and scored on a two-run single by **Robbie Glendining** to tighten the score before the SeaWolves completed the win. The Curve Team had won six straight over Erie before the loss.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve play the second of a four-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is the final series in Erie for the Curve in 2019 before the 23-game season series concludes with four games at PNG Field from July 22-24, including a double-header on July 23.

THE CURVE: The Curve have won 7 of 9 and have the best full-season record (47-39) in the Western Division. Since June 1, the club is 24-11, the second-best record in the league behind Bowie (27-8) over that period, and have also won 9 of 10 series. Altoona has the best intra-division record (36-23) among Western Division clubs and have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE SEAWOLVES: The SeaWolves have won 14 of 19 to start the second half and take aim at breaking the longest playoff drought in the Western Division. Owner's of the largest run differential in the league (+48), the SeaWolves lead the league in hitting at .248 and rank fifth with 4.1 runs per game. From a pitching perspective, Erie's starting rotation paces the circuit with a collective 3.04 ERA while the bullpen is ranked 10th with a 3.61 ERA to give the entire staff a 3.26 ERA, second-best in the E.L.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-handed pitcher Brandon Waddell will make his fifth start of the season with the Curve after be made 21 relief outings with Triple-A Indianapolis to start the year. In his last start, he recorded season-highs in innings pitched (6.0) and strikeouts (7) during a win over Erie on July 5. A native of Houston, Waddell has spent the majority of his pro career with Double-A Altoona by pitching 256.2 innings of 429.2 career frames in a Curve uni-form. He was originally drafted by the Pirates in the fifth round of the 2015 draft out of the University of Virginia and pitched the clinching game for the Cavaliers in the 2015 College World Series...For more on Waddeli, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Tarik Skuball takes the mound for his second Double-A start after he took a no-decision due to one unearned run in five innings while striking out 11 Curve hitters on Sunday. Before his promotion, the 22-year-old went 4-5 with a 2.58 ERA in 15 starts for A-Adv. Lakeland and was a FSL All-Star. He missed most of 2016 and all of 2017 due to Tommy John surgery while attending Seattle University. Skuball was drafted by Detroit in the ninth round during the 2018 draft out of Seattle and is rated by MLB.com as the Tigers' No. 17 prospect.

RYAN'S REIGN: Indiana, Pa. native **Michael Ryan** is nearing the 200-win milestone as Curve manager. His 199 wins are third-most in club history behind Dale Sveum (2001-03) and Tim Leiper (2006-08), each at 213 wins. Ryan's .547 winning percentage is also the second-highest in franchise history behind Tony Beasley's .569 (2004-05). Over his seven-year managerial career, Ryan is a two-time league champion and is 479-434

TOUGH YEAR TO HIT: The league-wide average stands at .237 with teams scoring 3.98 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95) while 1971 (.234/3.57) was the last season offenses hit below .240 and scored fewer than 4.0 runs per game. The Curve are above the league average with 4.01 runs per game and rank third in hitting at .244. The lowest batting average in team history stands at .252 during the 2013 season.

BRAKE MEN: Since June 3, the Curve pitching staff own's a 2.82 ERA (90 ERA/287.0 IP), the best mark in the league. The staff has also pitched to a 3.05 ERA (141 ER/415.2 IP) over the last 48 games since May 16, second-best in the E.L. After a 6.82 ERA over 12 games from May 3-15, the club's ERA ballooned to a league-high 4.22 but has been trimmed down to 3.56 due to the prolonged run of success. OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva has been the best hitter in the E.L. since June 14. Over his last 21 games, he paces the league with a .416 (32/77) average, 1.104 OPS, .494 on-base percentage, .610 slugging percentage and 15 steals during 11 multi-hit games. He has reached base in 30 of his last 32 games since June 3 at a .360 (41/114), also the top average in the league over that period. He was hitting a season-low .193 before he started his uptick to .268. Oliva's 24 steals this year rank second in the E.L. and Pirates system. He was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases, third-most in the system.


G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: Robbie Glendinning has racked up 20 RBIs in 22 games since June 14, fourth-most in the E.L., while batting .313 (25/80) with nine extra-base hits since his promotion from A-Adv. Bradenton. A 2019 Florida State League All-Star, the Western Australia native tops the Pirates minor league system with a .328 average (min. 250 plate appearances), 86 hits and tied for first with 23 doubles. He also ranks among the top performers in the Pirates system with 11 homers (6th) and 50 RBIs (T-3rd), all career-highs between A-Adv. Bradenton and Double-A Altoona.

TOLMAN AT THE TOP: Since taking over the leadoff role on June 19, **Mitchell Tolman** has reached base in 16 of 17 games, including 13 in a row, while hitting at a .313 (20/64) pace with 17 runs scored, tied for the most in the league since the start of the second half. Tolman has hit leadoff in 25 games this season and owns a .292 (28/96) ledger from the top of the lineup. Since June 3, he has been on base in 28 of 31 and is batting .303 (36/119) with 21 runs, eight steals and seven extra-base hits.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris has reached base in 10 straight games and owns a .361 average (13/36) with four extra-base hits and four multi-hit games since June 29. He has reached base in 28 of his last 33 since June 2, batting .296 (34/115) with four homers, eight doubles, one triple, 13 walks and 20 RBIs during 11 multi-hit performances. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

LOOKIN' SHARPE: Chris Sharpe's 16 RBIs since his promotion to Double-A on June 21 are second-most in the E.L. He has collected 13 of those RBIs in the last nine games that included a walk-off single last Saturday, a go-ahead grand slam on Sunday, drove in three during a comeback win on Monday, sparked a four-run eighth on Wednesday with a solo homer, and a three-RBI night on July 4 that included a two-run homer. A 2019 Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton, Sharpe ranks fourth in the Pirates system with .270 overall batting average (min. 250 plate appearances), fourth with a .357 on-base percentage and third with 15 stolen bases.


