THE LAST TIME OUT: A late lead slipped away from the Curve for the second day in a row after a two-run double by Mandy Alvarez in the seventh put Trenton on top for good in a 4-3 game. After Thunder starter Nick Nelson whiffed nine over the first four innings, Jared Oliva's RBI single gave the Curve the lead in the fifth. Bligh Madris doubled twice and collected three hits, including a two-run, game-tying double in the fourth. In the bottom of the seventh, the Curve started the inning with back-to-back walks but the inning ended on a triple play. Catcher Kellin Deglan caught a bunt pop up hit by Chris Sharpe and threw to shortstop Kyle Holder to double off the runner off of second base and tag the runner coming from first. It was the first triple play turned against Altoona since Akron did so on April 12, 2016.

TODAY'S GAME: The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve play the second of a three-game series against the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. The two teams completed one of three scheduled games in Trenton from their May 28-30 series and will complete a suspended game and play four more at ARM & HAMMER Park on July 30-August 1.

THE CURVE: The Curve have won 9 of 13 and are 26-13 since June 1, the second-best record in the league behind Bowie (30-9) over that period. Altoona has also won 9 of 11 series in that time and have not lost a home series since May 31-June 2 to New Hampshire. Altoona played seven straight games against Erie around the Eastern League All-Star Break and swept three games at PNG Field before the two teams split a four-game series in Erie. The Curve have the best intra-division record (38-24) among Western Division clubs and have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE THUNDER: Trenton punched their ticket to the playoffs for the fourth straight season as First Half Eastern Divison Champions. They finished tied with Reading on June 18 and, due to zero head-to-head matchups against the R-Phils in the first half, were awarded the third tie-breaker with the better intra-divison record (20-11) during the half. The Thunder are on a seven-game road trip after the Eastern League All-Star Break and split a four-game series in Reading before taking the first game in Altoona on Monday. Before the break, the Thunder lost seven straight to begin July before winning the finale before three days off. Offensively, Trenton is seventh in the league in runs per game (4.1) and team batting average (.240) but are fourth with runners in scoring position (.256). Trenton pitchers also sit seventh with a 3.57 ERA with the fourth-best bullpen at 2.98 despite the second-worst rotation at 4.09.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-handed pitcher **Sean Brady** will make his 13th start for the Curve and 18th outing overall in 2019. He started the first game out of the All-Star Break for the Curve and pitched six innings, allowing four runs, one earned, in a losing decision. Since May 21, Brady has held a 2.78 ERA, which is the third-best in the E.L. over that period. Brady starts opposite Trenton for the third time in his career, holding an 0-1 record and 2.75 ERA (2 ER/7 IP). He spent the first six years of his professional career in the Indians organization and was released by Cleveland on May 1 and signed with the Pirates on May 6. He was originally drafted by the Indians in the fifth round of the 2013 draft out of high school... *For more on Brady, see page two.*

FOR TRENTON: Right-hander Albert Abreu makes his 17th outing and 16th start. The 23-year-old from the Dominican Republic pitched six scoreless, two-hit innings during a no-decision on the last day before the All-Star Break. In his first full-year in Double-A, Abreu reached Trenton for one start in 2018 (0 ER/5.0 IP) after he spent most of the year with A-Adv. Tampa with a 4-3 record and 4.16 ERA. Abreu was originally signed by the Astros as an international free agent on August 5, 2013 and was acquired by New York in a trade on November 17, 2016 that sent Brian McCann to Houston. Abreu is currently ranked by MLB.com as the Yankees' No. 3 overall prospect.

WILD, WILD WEST: The Curve have the best overall record in the Western Divison at 49-41, leading Harrisburg by a half game. Due to the new split-season playoff format, the Curve are 4.5 games behind Bowie for the last remaining spot in the Western Divison playoffs. Harrisburg won the first half with a 42-28 record, 5.5 games better than Altoona's 35-32 first half. The Senators played to a 21-4 record in April but have gone 29-39 since. Meanwhile, Bowie has taken advantage of new life after June 19 to lead the division and are 42-20 since May 6 after a 7-23 start.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: The league-wide batting average stands at .238 with teams scoring 3.98 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95) while 1971 (.234/3.57) was the last season below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs per game. The Curve are above the league average with 4.06 runs per game and rank fourth in hitting at .242. The lowest batting average in team history was .252 during the 2013 season. Strikeouts are also on the rise with pitchers averaging 8.8 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. Curve pitchers have struck out the fewest hitters (637) among full-season clubs in the Minors but Altoona hitters have struck out 80 times over the last six games.

BRAKE MEN: The Curve pitching staff has been dialed in over the last two months and owns the second-best ERA in the league since June 3 (36 games) at 2.98 (107 ER/323.0 IP) and rank third since May 16 (52 games) at 3.15 (158 ER/451.2 IP). After a 6.82 ERA over 12 games from May 3-15, the club's ERA ballooned to a league-high 4.22 but has been trimmed down to 3.60 due to the prolonged run of success.

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva has racked up eight RBIs over the last three games after a career-best five RBIs on Saturday, a two-run homer on Sunday and an RBI single on Monday. In 25 games since June 14, Oliva leads all E.L. hitters with a .413 (38/92) batting average, .620 slugging percentage, .495 on-base percentage, 1.115 OPS, 38 hits and 17 steals. He aslo has the best slashline (.413/.500/.613) in the E.L. since the second half started on June 19. Oliva was hitting a season-low .193 through his first 39 games but has been on base in 33 of his last 36 games since June 3 to boost his average to .275 thanks to a .364 (47/129) pace, also the best in the league over that period. His .275 average is ranked 11th in the league and third-best among Pirates minor leaguers (min. 300 plate appearances). He was a 2018 Mil.B.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases, third-most in the system.

TOLMAN AT THE TOP: Since taking over the leadoff role on June 19, **Mitchell Tolman** has reached base in 20 of 21 games, including a team-best 17 in a row, while hitting .299 (23/77). Since the start of the second half, Tolman leads the league with 20 runs scored, second with a .430 on-base percentage and third with 15 walks. Since June 3, he reached base in 32 of 35 and is batting .295 (39/132) with 24 runs, eight steals and nine extra-base hits.

BLIGH GUY: Bligh Madris recorded his team-best 25th multi-hit game on Monday, including a pair of doubles to become the first Curve hitter to reach 20 two-baggers, the eight-best total in the E.L. Madris has 12 multi-hit games in his last 28 contests since June 12, batting .327 (33/101) with eight doubles. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: Since his promotion from A-Adv. Bradenton, **Robbie Glendinning**'s 21 RBIs in 26 games are the second-best total in the Eastern League. The Western Australia native leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a .319 batting average (min. 300 plate appearances) while his career-high 11 homers (6th), 51 RBIs (T-3rd), 23 doubles (T-2nd) and 88 hits (2nd) between the two levels also rank among the organization's best. Glendinning was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star and led the FSL with .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games after he played his first nine games of the year with the Curve.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com has three Top 30 Pirates prospects in Altoona with Oliva (No. 9), Bolton (No. 23) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 30).
