THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve trailed 6-0 in Bowie on Sunday but rallied for eight unanswered runs to avoid a four-game sweep with an 8-6 victory. **Chris Sharpe** drove in the first run in a three-run sixth against Mike Baumann and hit the go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the top of the ninth inning. **Bligh Madris** three-run homer in the eighth inning tied the game up at 6-6. **Jesus Liranzo** and **Austin Coley** each locked down two scoreless innings out of the bullpen while the offense charged back. The 6-0 deficit was Altoona's largest comeback win of 2019.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve open a four-game, three-day series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The current series will be the final meeting of the year between the two division rivals and will feature a double-header on Tuesday. Altoona have already clinched the season series against the SeaWolves, outscoring Erie 79-73 in the first 19 games. The Curve started 2-4 through the first two sets against Erie and rattled off wins in 10 of 13 head-to-heads, including six in a row with back-to-back series sweeps on June 3-5 and July 4-7. Today begins an eight-game, seven-day homestand against the SeaWolves and Richmond Flying Squirrels and leads into one of two remaining off days on July 29, ending a stretch of 19 games in 18 days.

THE CURVE: The Curve are 4-7 since the All-Star Break and have not won a series after going 23-9 with one series loss between June 3-July 7. Since the break, Altoona's .218 (79/363) team batting average is second-lowest in the league but the club has drawn the most walks (41) over that period. The pitching staff has carried a 4.59 ERA (46 ER/96 IP) since the break and has allowed five runs or more six times after leading the E.L. with a 2.84 ERA from June 3-July 7. The Curve have the best intra-division (39-27) among Western Division clubs and have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE SEAWOLVES: Erie has the best full-season record in the Western Division but trails Bowie by 1.5 games in the Second-Half standings. The SeaWolves have won 7 of 8 since July 14, which started by winning the final game of a four-game series against the Curve to split the first set out of the All-Star Break. Erie is the only other team along with Altoona to have a winning record against Western Division opponents (35-25). The SeaWolves' starting rotation is the best in the E.L. with a 3.23 ERA and stand second overall in pitching with a 3.31 ERA despite the 10th-ranked bullpen at a 3.43 ERA. Offensively, Erie leads the league in hitting at .249 and score the second-most runs per game (4.3) with the help of the fourth-most home runs (76) on the circuit.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander Brandon Waddell will make his seventh start of the season with the Curve after he started the season in the bullpen at Triple-A Indianapolis. Waddell struck out a season-high eight hitters and was charged with five runs over 5.1 innings against Trenton in his last start but he departed with a 4-3 lead until two inherited runners for Jesus Liranzo scored. Waddell has thrown six scoreless innings and struck out seven for wins in each of his two starts versus the SeaWolves in 2019. He was originally drafted by the Pirates in the fifth round of the 2015 draft out of the University of Virginia and pitched the clinching game for the Cavaliers in the 2015 College World Series...For more on Waddell, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Alex Faedo starts his 18th game and fourth against Altoona. In his latest start, the 23-year-old pitched five innings of a no-decision versus Akron on July 15 and struck out nine. He started against Altoona most recently on July 4 and held the Curve to three runs over six fames and is 1-1 with a 3.60 ERA (6 ER/15 IP) overall. Faedo was the 18th overall pick by Detroit in the 2017 draft out of the University of Florida, where he pitched the Gators into the 2017 College World Series Final by leading a shutout over TCU. The Gators won the National Championship that season over LSU and Faedo was awarded Most Outstanding Player for the 2017 College World Series. He is currently the Tigers' No. 9 overall prospect, according to MLB.com.

WILD, WILD WEST: The top four teams in the Western Division are all seperated by 1.5 games in the full-season standings as Erie leads Second-Half leader Bowie by a half game. Under the old playoff format, Erie and Bowie would be playoff bound if the season ended today but Bowie, Erie and Altoona are all fighting for the last remaining playoff spot in the West due to the split-season format. Harrisburg rode a 21-4 record in April to a 42-28 finish to punch their ticket to the postseason as First-Half Division Champions.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: The Eastern League has witnessed seven no-hitters in 2019, the most since a record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. The league-wide batting average stands at .238 with teams scoring 4.03 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95) while 1971 (.234/3.57) was the last season below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs per game. The Curve are above the league average by scoring 4.05 runs per game and rank fourth in hitting at .242. The lowest batting average in team history was .252 during the 2013 season. Strikeouts are also on the rise with E.L. pitchers averaging 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. Curve pitchers have struck out the fewest hitters (665) among full-season clubs in the Minors while Altoona hitters have struck out 136 times over their last 12 games (11.3 per game).

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva has been the top hitter in the Eastern League since early June and has been on base in 39 of his last 42 games. Over that period, Oliva has lifted his batting average from a season-low .193 in his first 39 games to .285, seventh-best in the E.L. and third in Pittsburgh's system, by hitting at a .368 (57/155) pace, the highest average in the league over that time, with 19 multi-hit games. Since June 14, he leads the E.L. with a .407 (48/118) batting average, .610 slugging percentage, .478 on-base percentage, 1.088 OPS, 48 hits and 19 steals over his last 32 games. He also has the best slashline (.406/.478/.604) in the E.L. since the second half started on June 19. Oliva is riding a career-high-tying nine game hitting streak, going 16-for-37 (.432) with six multi-hit games. He was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases, third-most in the system. third-most in the system.

BIG FLY BLIGH: Bligh Madris hit a three-run homer to tie Sunday's game in Bowie, 6-6, his seventh of the year. Even though all seven roundtrippers have been on the road, five of Madris' home runs have been either go-ahead or game-tying homers in Curve wins. He also owns three other game-winning hits, including a walk-off single on April 11, Altoona's home opener and the fifth walk-off hit of his pro career. Madris ranks fifth in the E.L. with 88 hits and 14 multi-hit games in his last 34 contests since June 12, batting .317 (39/123) with eight doubles, five home runs and 23 RBIs over that time. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

LOOKIN' SHARPE: Over his first month at Double-A, **Chris Sharpe** has been one of the most productive players in the Eastern League. His 21 RBIs and 22 runs scored since his Double-A debut on June 21 are each second-best in the E.L. over the last month while his six homers rank third. His go-ahead, two-run homer in the ninth inning in Bowie on Sunday was his third game-winning hit for Altoona to go with a walk-off single on June 28 and a go-ahead grand slam on June 30, each versus Binghamton. Sharpe was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star and batted .292 for A-Adv. Bradenton. Between both levels, he ranks among the best performers in the Pirates system with a .263 batting average (7th), 11 homers (T-7th), 51 RBIs (T-6th), 21 doubles (7th), 87 hits (5th) and 58 runs (3rd).

G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: Robbie Glendinning leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a .309 batting average (min. 300 plate appearances) while his career-high 11 homers (T-7th), 51 RBIs (T-4th), 23 doubles (3rd) and 92 hits (2nd) between two levels also rank among the organization's best. The Western Australia native was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton and led the FSL with .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games after he played his first nine games of the year with the Curve.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com has three Top 30 Pirates prospects in Altoona with Oliva (No. 9), Bolton (No. 23) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 30).
