THE LAST TIME OUT: Brandon Waddell led the Curve to a 4-1 victory by shutting out Erie over six innings for the third time this season. **Brett Pope** tripled in the first run of a three-run third that saw **Mitchell Tolman** and **Logan Hill** single in runs. Tolman knocked in another score in the fourth and finished 2-for-4. **Blake Cederlind** allowed one run in the seventh before **Joel Cesar** recorded the last six outs for his first Double-A save.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve play a double-header versus the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Altoona have outscored Erie, 83-74, and have already clinched the season series. The final contest of the season between the two clubs will take place in tomorrow's series finale. The Curve are in the midst of playing 19 games in 18 days out of the All-Star Break before one of their two remaining off days on Monday.

THE CURVE: The Curve are 5-7 since the All-Star Break and have not won a series after going 23-9 with one series loss between June 3-July 7. Since the break, Altoona has struck out the most (128) and drawn the most walks (44) while ranking eighth in the league with a .227 (90/396) average over that period. The pitching staff has carried a 4.29 ERA (50 ER/105 IP) since the break and has allowed five runs or more six times after leading the E.L. with a 2.84 ERA from June 3-July 7. The Curve have the best intra-division (40-27) record among Western Division clubs and have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE SEAWOLVES: The SeaWolves have won 7 of 9 since July 14, which started by winning the final game of a fourgame series against the Curve to split the first set out of the All-Star Break. Erie has the second-best intra-division record among Western Division clubs (35-26). The SeaWolves' starting rotation is the best in the E.L. with a 3.27 ERA and stand third overall in pitching with a 3.32 ERA despite the 10th-ranked bullpen at a 3.40 ERA. Offensively, Erie leads the league in hitting at .248 and score the second-most runs per game (4.3) with the help of the fourthmost home runs (76) on the circuit.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Cody Bolton makes his fifth Double-A start in game one and his first at PNG Field. The 21-year-old threw six one-hit innings for his longest outing at Double-A in his last start on July 18. Bolton was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton and led the FSL with a 1.61 ERA over his 12 starts at the time of his promotion on June 26. His 2.72 ERA between both levels ranks fourth among Pirates minor league pitchers with at least 50 innings pitched in 2019. Pittsburgh drafted Bolton out of Tracy (Calif.) High School in the sixth round of the 2017 draft and is ranked by Baseball America as the Pirates' No. 21 prospect while MLB.com ranks the righty at No. 23 in the system...For more on Bolton, see page two.

Right-hander **Nick Economos** will make his Double-A debut in game two. He has thrown three straight career-high, seven-inning starts for A-Adv. Bradenton, including seven one-run innings with seven strikeouts in his latest outing against Clearwater. His 2.17 ERA between Single-A Greensboro and A-Adv. Bradenton ranks second among Pirates minor leaguers that have thrown at least 50 innings in 2019. Economos was drafted by the Pirates in the 21st round during the 2015 draft. **For more on Economos, see page three.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Matt Manning gets the ball in the first game, his 18th start and fourth versus the Curve. Manning's last outing was on July 16 against Akron and he earned his seventh win after he allowed two runs over five innings. Manning did not start between July 2-16 due to the Eastern League All-Star Break and the All-Star Futures Game on July 7 in Cleveland. Manning has pitched in the Futures Game in 2018 and 2019. Also a 2019 Eastern League All-Star, Manning ranks second in the E.L. with 111 strikeouts, trailing teammate Alex Faedo (115). His 2.81 ERA (5th), 202 batting average against (2nd) and 1.08 WHIP (4th) also rank among the league's best. Against the Curve in 2019, Manning is 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA (7 ER/11.2 IP) at PNG Field but threw seven scoreless with 10 strikeouts in Erie on April 10. Manning was the ninth overall pick in the 2016 draft by the Tigers and is Detroit's No. 2 prospect and No. 31 in baseball, according to MLB.com.

Logan Shore, a 24-year-old from Minnesota, takes the mound for his 18th game and 14th start. His last two appearances have been in relief as he tossed 1.2 innings on July 20 in Richmond. His last start was against the Curve on July 11 at UPMC Park when he hurled six innings with one unearned run allowed for his third win of the year. Shore's start will be his fifth opposite Altoona in 2019 as he owns a 2-2 record and 3.68 (9 ER/22 IP). Shore was drafted by the Oakland A's with the 47th overall pick in 2016 and traded as a PTBNL to Detroit for Mike Fiers last fall.

WILD, WILD WEST: The top four teams in the Western Division are all seperated by 1.5 games in the full-season standings as Bowie leads the way in the overall and Second-Half standings. Under the old playoff format, Erie and Bowie would be playoff bound if the season ended today but Bowie, Erie and Altoona are all fighting for the last remaining playoff spot in the West due to the new split-season format. Harrisburg rode a 21-4 record in April to a 42-28 finish to punch their ticket to the postseason as First-Half Division Champions.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: The Eastern League has witnessed seven no-hitters in 2019, the most since a record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. The league-wide batting average stands at .238 with teams scoring 4.01 runs per game, The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95) while 1971 (.234/3.57) was the last season below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs per game. The Curve are above the league average by scoring 4.05 runs per game and rank fourth in hitting at .243. The lowest batting average in team history was .252 during the 2013 season. Strikeouts are also on the rise with E.L. pitchers averaging 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. Curve pitchers have struck out the fewest hitters (674) among full-season clubs in the Minors while Altoona hitters have struck out 145 times over their last 13 games (11.2 per game).

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva is riding a career-high 10-game hitting streak, going 17-for-41 (.415) with six multi-hit games since July 13. The top hitter in the Eastern League since early June, he has been on base in 40 of his last 43 games while hitting .365 (58/159), the highest average in the league over that time, with 19 multi-hit games as his average has risen from a season-low .193 to .284, eighth-best in the E.L. and third in Pittsburgh's system. Since June 14, he leads the E.L. with a .402 (49/122) batting average , 598 slugging percentage, .471 on-base percentage, 1.069 OPS, 49 hits and 19 steals over his last 33 games. He also has the best slashline (.400/.471/.590) in the E.L. since the second half started on June 19. He was a 2018 MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star after he hit .275 for A-Adv. Bradenton with 33 stolen bases, third-most in the system.

BIG FLY BLIGH: Bligh Madris hit a three-run homer to tie Sunday's game in Bowie, 6-6, his seventh of the year. Even though all seven roundtrippers have been on the road, five of Madris' home runs have been either go-ahead or game-tying homers in Curve wins. He also owns three other game-winning hits, including a walk-off single on April 11, Altoona's home opener and the fifth walk-off hit of his pro career. Madris ranks sixth in the E.L. with 89 hits and 14 multi-hit games in his last 35 contests since June 12, batting .317 (40/126) with eight doubles, five home runs and 23 RBIs over that time. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

LOOKIN' SHARPE: Over his first month at Double-A, **Chris Sharpe** has been one of the most productive players in the Eastern League. His 24 runs since his Double-A debut on June 21 are the most in the E.L. while his 21 RBIs are second-most and his six homers rank third. His go-ahead, two-run homer in the ninth inning in Bowie on Sunday was his third game-winning hit for Altoona to go with a walk-off single on June 28 and a go-ahead grand slam on June 30, each versus Binghamton. Sharpe was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star and batted .292 for A-Adv. Bradenton. Between both levels, he ranks among the best performers in the Pirates system with a .266 batting average (7th), 11 homers (T-7th), 51 RBIs (T-6th), 22 doubles (T-5th), 89 hits (T-4th) and 60 runs (3rd).

G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: Robbie Glendinning leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a .305 batting average (min, 300 plate appearances) while his career-high 11 homers (T-7th), 51 RBIs (T-6th), 23 doubles (T-3rd) and 92 hits (3rd) between two levels also rank among the organization's best. The Western Australia native was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton and led the FSL with .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games after he played his first nine games of the year with the Curve.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com has three Top 30 Pirates prospects in Altoona with Oliva (No. 9), Bolton (No. 23) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 30).
