THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve dropped their fourth straight in a 3-1 series-opening loss to Richmond. Logan Hill hit a bloop double to score the first run of the game in the home half of the first but the Flying Squirrels put up three unanswered with single runs in the third, fourth and seventh. Richomd starter Brandon Lawson navigated six one-run innings despite seven hits allowed. Tyler Cyr and Melvin Adon threw three hitless innings combined for Richmond. Hill, **Jared Oliva** and **Bralin Jackson** all doubled for the Curve and **Jason Delay** went 2-for-4.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve play the second of a four-game series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels, Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants. The series is the second-to-last series between the two ballclubs which concludes with four games on August 8-11 after the Curve returns from a seven-game road trip to Trenton and Reading. Altoona has won all four series between the clubs by outscoring the Squirrels 67-52. These are the last three games of an 18-day stretch after the All-Star Break with 19 games for the Curve before the first of two remaining off days. Additionally, it is the only series for the Curve in the month of July without the designated hitter.

THE CURVE: The Curve are 5-10 since the All-Star Break and have not won a series after going 23-9 with one series loss between June 3-July 7. Since the break, Altoona has struck out the most (148) and drawn the most walks (52) while ranking 10th in the league with a .230 (112/488) average over that period. The pitching staff has carried a 4.33 ERA (63 ER/131 IP) since the break and has allowed five runs or more eight times after leading the E.L. with a 2.84 ERA from June 3-July 7. The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: Richmond's .360 winning percentage is the lowest at Double-A and second-lowest among all full-season teams in the Minors, bettering only West Michigan's (Class A Tigers) .340 (34-66). The Flying Squirrels won 4 of 7 from July 14-20 but have lost four straight, including a three-game sweep to Bowie in their most recent series in which they were held to one run. The Squirrels' offense scores the fewest runs per game (3.26), has the lowest team batting average (.218) and hit the fewest homers (61). Richmond pitchers have held a 3.87 ERA, second-highest in the E.L.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-handed pitcher **Sean Brady** will make his 15th start for the Curve and 20th outing overall in 2019. He last started on July 21 at Bowie and allowed six runs in five innings to break a streak of seven straight quality starts. It is Brady's first start versus Richmond in 2019 after he appeared in three games for Akron against the Flying Squirrels in 2018. He spent the first six years of his professional career in the Indians organization and was released by Cleveland on May 1 and signed with the Pirates on May 6. He was originally drafted by the Indians in the fifth round of the 2013 draft out of high school...*For more on Brady, see page two.*

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Caleb Baragar starts his 14th game at Double-A and makes his 21st appearance over three levels in the Giants system. He last pitched on July 20 against Erie and took a no-decision after he allowed five runs in six innings. Baragar faced the Curve in Richmond on June 25 and walked a career-high six hitters and allowed four runs in 4.1 innings. The native of Jenison, Mich. started the Eastern League All-Star Game for the Western Division at The Diamond. Baragar opened the season with A-Adv. San Jose, pitching to a 2.70 ERA through five April starts before a spot-start at Triple-A Sacramento sent him to Double-A Richmond in May. San Francisco drafted Baragar in the ninth round of the 2016 draft out of Indiana.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: The Eastern League has witnessed seven no-hitters in 2019, the most since a record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. The league-wide batting average stands at .239 with teams scoring 4.01 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95) while 1971 (.234/3.57) was the last season below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs per game. The league batting average has finished below .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). Pitchers are also recording 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. The E.L.'s average nine-inning game time of 2:37:46 is the fastest in baseball.

GLOVE TRAIN: The Curve defense owns the highest fielding percentage (.984) and committed the fewest errors (59) while turning the third-most double plays (97) at the Double-A level. However, the club has committed eight errors over their last eight games. The team has put away outs despite a high rate of ball put into play as Curve pitchers strike out the fewest hitters (705) and walk the 10th-least (286) among full-season clubs in the Minors. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: **Jared Oliva** has hit safely in 12 of 13 while batting .357 (20/56) since July 13. The top hitter in the Eastern League since early June, Oliva has been on base in 42 of his last 47 games with a .426 on-base percentage and hitting .351 (61/174), both the highest rates in the league since June 3, to go with 15 doubles, 36 runs, 20 steals and 61 hits. His batting average has risen from a season-low .193 to .280, ninth-best in the E.L. and third in Pittsburgh's system, over that time. In the Second-Half, Oliva leads the E.L. with a .375 batting average, .444 on-base percentage, .558 slugging percentage, 1.002 OPS and 45 hits. He also ranks second on the circuit and first in the Pirates system with 28 steals for the year.

BIG FLY BLIGH: Bligh Madris hit a three-run homer to tie Sunday's game in Bowie, 6-6, his seventh of the season. Even though all seven roundtrippers have been on the road, five of Madris' home runs have been either go-ahead or game-tying homers in Curve wins. He also owns three other game-winning hits, including a walk-off single on April 11, Altoona's home opener and the fifth walk-off hit of his pro career. Madris ranks sixth in the E.L. and fourth in the Pirates system with 91 hits and has 14 multi-hit games in his last 39 contests since June 12, batting .307 (42/137) with eight doubles, five home runs and 25 RBIs, third-most in the E.L. over that time. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

LOOKIN' SHARPE: Over his first month at Double-A, **Chris Sharpe** has been one of the most productive players in the Eastern League. Since his Double-A debut on June 21, his 24 runs and 22 RBIs are second-most and while six homers by the outfielder rank fourth. His go-ahead, two-run homer in the ninth inning on Sunday was his third game-winning hit for Altoona to go with a walk-off single on June 28 and a go-ahead grand slam on June 30, each versus Binghamton. Sharpe was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star and batted .292 for A-Adv. Bradenton. Between both levels, he ranks among the best performers in the Pirates system with a .261 batting average (7th), 11 homers (T-7th), 52 RBIs (6th), 23 doubles (T-5th), 91 hits (T-4th) and 60 runs (3rd).

G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: **Robbie Glendinning** leads Pirates minor leaguers with a .304 batting average (min. 300 plate appearances) while his career-high 11 homers (T-7th), 51 RBIs (7th), 23 doubles (T-5th) and 95 hits (2nd) between two levels also rank among the organization's best. Glendinning hit .333 (23/69) with 18 RBIs over his first 16 games back with the Curve from June 14-July 4, but hit .148 (8/54) from July 5-23 (1), including an 0-for-21 slide over six games, with just three RBIs. The Western Australia native was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton and led the FSL with .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games after he played his first nine games of the year with the Curve.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. MLB.com has three Top 30 Pirates prospects in Altoona with Oliva (No. 9), Bolton (No. 23) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 30).

In 17 Double-A starts this season between Akron and Altoona, Brady is 3-8 with a 4.74 ERA (53 ER/100.2 IP)...Ranked sixth in the E.L. with 100.2 innings pitched and second with 13 double-play ground balls...Also 10th in the E.L. with 35 walks and sixth with 12 homers allowed...Fourth career start versus Richmond, going 0-1 with a 9.19 ERA (16 ER/15.2 IP)

2019 NOTES

Started the season in the Indians organization with Double-A Akron...Made season debut against the Curve on 4/6 at Canal Park in Akron and tossed seven strong innings but was on the short end of a 2-0 Altoona victory...Promoted to Triple-A Columbus on 4/11 and made two starts with the Clippers, going 1-0 with a 5.23 ERA before returning to Akron's roster on 4/18...Allowed a career-high nine runs on 4/23 vs. BNG with nine scores on nine hits over three innings for second loss of the year...Pitched four innings and allowed five runs on seven hits on 4/28 @ BOW...Released by Cleveland on 5/1...Signed as a minor league free agent by Pittsburgh on 5/6 and assigned to Double-A Altoona...Made Pirates organization debut on 5/8 vs. BOW and allowed four runs over five innings, departing with the Curve trailing 4-2 before 12-2 loss...Earned first win in the Pirates organization on 5/15 @ BNG...Allowed five runs in the first and one in the second as the Curve trailed 6-2 but settled in to retired 12 of his last 15 hitters to complete six innings and Altoona took it's first lead in the top of the seventh...Compiled first quality start with Altoona on 5/21 @ NHM and allowed one earned run over 6.1 innings but was charged with two more when a pair of inherited runners scored against Vicente Campos during a 5-0 loss...Allowed a lead-off, solo homer to Jeremy Rivera on the first pitch of the game on 5/26 @ POR and sat down the next 17 hitters on his way to seven two-run innings and second winning decision...Departed a 2-0 game with one out in the seventh on 6/1 vs. NHM with two runners on before both were charged to his line when they scored on a single by Santiago Espinal...Faced former organization for the first time on 6/7 vs. AKR and was tagged for five runs over six innings, including two homers by Wilson Garcia over the first three innings...Faced the minimum over his first five innings on 6/12 vs. POR with two double plays and a pick off to work around one single and two walks, but allowed single runs in the sixth and seventh before the Sea Dogs opened up their lead against the bullpen...Snapped a three-game losing streak with third win on 6/23 @ HFD...Retired final 13 hitters on 36 of his 90 total pitches on and completed seven, one-run innings with the only Yard Goats score coming on a solo homer in the second by Bret Boswell...Allowed one run in the first and faced the minimum through the fourth before second run scored on 6/29 vs. BNG (2)...Started on 7/4 vs. ERI and allowed two runs in the first on a two-run homer by Jose Azocar in the first inning before settling in for seven innings of no-decision with six strikeouts, including the 500th of his professional career...Started first game after the All-Star Break on 7/11 @ ERI and turned in his seventh straight quality start but shouldered a losing decision after three unearned runs in the first...Tossed quality starts in 10 of last 11 outings, including seven in a row, with a 2.80 ERA (22 ER/70.2 IP), second-lowest in E.L. from 5/21-7/16...Snapped quality start streak with six runs allowed in five innings on 7/21 @ BOW and departed down 6-0 but the Curve rallied for an 8-6 win

BRADY CAREER NOTES

Sean Michael Brady...Attended Ida S. Baker High School in Cape Coral, Fla...Drafted by the Cleveland Indians in the fifth round (141st overall) in the 2013 draft...Committed to play collegiately at the University of Florida before signing pro contract...Spent part of first seven seasons with the Indians organization, reaching Triple-A in 2018 and 2019...2014 New York-Penn League All-Star with short-season Mahoning Valley and finished seventh in the league with a 2.79 ERA...Pitched four-most innings in Midwest League during 2015 with Single-A Lake County...Won a career-best 12 games in 2016 with A-Adv. Lynchurg, which was tied for the most victories on the circuit... Limited to 10 outings in 2017 due to left shoulder strain and did not debut until July 16 with AZL Indians and built his way back to A-Adv. Ryan returns for his third season in Altoona after guiding the Curve to back-to-back Western Division championships. In his first season, the Curve captured the 2017 Eastern League title. He also managed the Western Division All-Stars in the 2018 Eastern League All-Star Classic. Ryan started his coaching career as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He is in his seventh season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016 and won the Florida State League championship. Ryan played 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors, after he was a fifth-round draft choice by the Minnesota Twins in 1996.

Hanrahan joins the Curve in 2019 for his third season as a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh minor league system. He started his coaching career with the Bristol Pirates in 2017 and most recently oversaw pitchers for the West Virginia Power last year. Hanrahan was a two-time National League All-Star with the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2011 and 2012 while he served as the team's closer. He was the first Bucs closer to notch 40 saves in a single season and recorded 82 saves, fifth all-time, during four seasons in Pittsburgh. A second-round pick by the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2000, he played 14 totals seasons and seven years as a right-handed reliever in the majors.

Nunnally comes to the Curve for his first year in the Pirates organization and 12th season as a coach in professional baseball. During the 2010-11 seasons, he was the hitting coach for the Cleveland Indians under manager Manny Acta. Nunnally spent the last two seasons as the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for the Los Angeles Angels. He has served as a hitting coach in the Indians, Toronto Blue Jays and Boston Red Sox developmental systems with Eastern League stops in New Hampshire (2012, 14) and Portland (2016). As a player, Nunnally was drafted by Cleveland in the third round in 1992 and played 15 seasons. He also played six major league seasons.

Paniagua joins the Curve for his third season as a coach in the Pirates organization. He started his coaching career in 2017 with the Bristol Pirates and was the hitting coach for the Dominican Summer League affiliate last year. He played for 13 years as an international signee out of the Dominican Republic. Paniagua spent parts of six seasons as a member of the Boston Red Sox and New York Mets minor league systems that included Eastern League experience with Portland (2007) and Binghamton (2008-09). He also spent six seasons (2011-16) with the independent York Revolution and is the longest-tenured position player in franchise history.

In his eighth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Aherns returns to Altoona for a third season in 2019. In 2018, Ahrens was the trainer for the Western Division for the Eastern League All-Star Classic. He spent two years in Bradenton from 2015-16, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. Aherns received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger returns to the Curve for his third season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. In 2018, Ahrens was the trainer for the Western Division for the Eastern League All-Star Classic. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
