THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve fell in 11 innings, 6-5, to Richmond for the club's sixth straight loss. It matches the longest losing streak of the season for the Curve and clinched just the sixth series win of the year for the Flying Squirrels. Altoona led, 3-2, after eight innings before Richmond rallied to take the lead in the ninth, 10th and 11th innings with the Curve matching the score twice. Matt Eckelman suffered his first blown save of the year and broke a strand of 26 consecutive saves converted with Altoona dating back to the 2018 season. The Curve were 41-0 when leading after eight innings. leading after eight innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve look to avoid a sweep to the Richmond Flying Squirrels, Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, in the finale of a four-game series and eight-game homestand. The Curve have been swept in two three-game series in 2019 while Richmond seeks their second series sweep (June 21-23 at Binghamton) and first four-game sweep. Altoona and Richmond will complete their 23-game season series when the Curve return home on August 5 for a four-game series. Today's game ends a stretch of 19 games in 18 days stretch after the All-Star Break before an off day on Monday. The Curve will play 35 games in the final 35 days of the regular season starting on Tuesday in Trenton.

THE CURVE: The Curve have lost six in a row, matching their longest losing streak of the season from April 12-18. The longest losing streak during Michael Ryan's three seasons as manager was in 2017 when the club lost seven straight from June 26-July 2. Altoona has been outscored 28-17 over their last six games while each contest has been decided by three runs or fewer. The team is 5-13 since the All-Star Break, the worst record in the league, and have not won a series after going 23-9 with one series loss between June 3-July 7 entering the break. The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06). Altoona reached the postseason in 2018 by chasing down Akron, who held a seven-game lead at the start of August.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: Richmond is one game from matching a season-high winning streak of four. The Flying Squirrels' .379 winning percentage is the lowest at Double-A. Richmond pitchers hold a 3.83 ERA, second-highest in the E.L. Richmond has been outscored by 121 runs in 2019, the highest run differential in the league with the next closest team standing at -20. The Squirrels' offense scores the fewest runs per game (3.3), has the lowest team batting average (.219) and hit the fewest homers (61).

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Cody Bolton makes his sixth Double-A start and second versus Richmond. The 21-year-old was limited to three innings and three runs allowed in his last appearance on Tuesday due to a long rain delay against Erie. He made his Double-A debut at The Diamond in Richmond on June 26 and faced the minimum through four before the Squirrels scored four in the fifth. Bolton was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton and led the FSL with a 1.61 ERA over his 12 starts at the time of his promotion on June 26. He leads the Pirates system with a 0.95 WHIP and ranks fifth with a 2.75 ERA between both levels. Pittsburgh drafted Bolton out of Tracy (Calif.) High School in the sixth round of the 2017 draft and is ranked by Baseball America as the Pirates' No. 21 prospect while MLB.com ranks the righty at No. 13 in the system... FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Logan Webb returns to the mound for his sixth Double-A start. The 22-year-old made five starts and held a 2.00 ERA through the month of April and was hit with an 80-game suspension for testing positive for a banned performance-enhancing substance. Over the last two weeks, Webb has made three rehab outings, one in the Arizona Rookie League and two for Class A Augusta, allowing a total of two runs over 15 innings. The Giants drafted Webb in the fourth round in 2014 out of Rocklin (Calif.) High School and is in his sixth pro season. He was a 2018 California League All-Star with A-Adv. San Jose in 2018, holding a 1.82 ERA before he made his Double-A debut for Richmond last August. Sunday is his first career start against Altoona.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: The Eastern League has witnessed seven no-hitters in 2019, the most since a record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. The league-wide batting average stands at .239 with teams scoring 3.99 runs per game. The last time the league average finished under .250 and 4.0 runs per game was in 1989 (.249/3.95) while 1971 (.234/3.57) was the last season below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs per game. The league batting average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). Pitchers are also recording 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. The E.L.'s average nine-inning game time of 2:37:37 is the fastest in baseball.

GLOVE TRAIN: The Curve defense is one of the best untils in the Minors but has committed 12 errors in their last nine games. The club's .983 fielding percentage, 63 errors and 99 double plays all rank third at Double-A. The Curve have set the franchise record for highest team fielding percentage in each of the last three seasons, which was .980 in 2016 and 2017 before the 2018 club held a .985 mark.

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva has hit safely in 13 of 15 while batting .338 (22/65) since July 13. The top hitter in the Eastern League since early June, Oliva has been on base in 43 of his last 49 games with a .420 on-base percentage and hitting .344 (63/183), both the highest rates in the league since June 3, to go with 15 doubles, 36 runs, 21 steals and 63 hits. His batting average has risen from a season-low .193 to .279, ninth-best in the E.L. and third in Pittsburgh's system. In the Second-Half, Oliva leads the E.L. with a .364 batting average, .434 on-base percentage, .969 OPS and 47 hits. He ranks second on the E.L. circuit and first in the Pirates system with 29 steals for the year.

BIG FLY BLIGH: Out of seven total home runs hit by **Bligh Madris**, five have been either go-ahead or game-tying homers in Curve wins. He also has connected on three other game-winning hits, including a walk-off single on April 11, Altoona's home opener and the fifth walk-off hit of his pro career. Madris ranks ninth in the E.L. and sixth in the Pirates system with 91 hits and has 14 multi-hit games in his last 41 contests since June 12, batting .296 (42/142) with eight doubles, five home runs and 26 RBIs, second-most in the E.L. over that time. Madris hit .326 (29/89) over his first 21 games at Double-A through April 28 with seven doubles and nine RBIs before slumping to a .156 (14/90) pace with three doubles and five RBIs over his next 28 from April 29-June 1.

LOOKIN' SHARPE: In a little over his first month at Double-A, **Chris Sharpe** has been one of the most productive players in the Eastern League. Since his Double-A debut on June 21, his 26 runs lead the league and 22 RBIs are second-most while six homers by the outfielder rank fourth. His go-ahead, two-run homer in the ninth inning in Bowie last Sunday was his third game-winning hit for Altoona, joining a walk-off single on June 28 and a go-ahead grand slam on June 30, each versus Binghamton. Sharpe was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star and batted .292 for A-Adv. Bradenton. Between both levels, he ranks among the best performers in the Pirates system with a .263 batting average (7th), .354 on-base percentage (5th), 11 homers (8th), 52 RBIs (7th), 24 doubles (5th), 94 hits (4th) and 62 runs (3rd).

G'DAYS FOR ROBBIE: Robbie Glendinning leads Pirates minor leaguers with a .305 batting average (min. 300 plate appearances) and on-base percentage at .369 while his career-high 12 homers (7th), 55 RBIs (6th), 23 doubles (T-6th), 98 hits (2nd) between two levels also rank among the organization's best. Glendinning hit .333 (23/69) with 18 RBIs over his first 16 games back with the Curve from June 14-July 4. He went hitless (0-for-21) over six games from July 18-23 but has reached base in each of his last seven with five walks and has gone 6-for-19 (.316) at the plate. The Western Australia native was a 2019 Florida State League All-Star for A-Adv. Bradenton and led the FSL with .340 average, .599 slugging percentage and .992 OPS over 43 games after he played his first nine games of the year with the Curve.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features two of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects in outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system. After the latest MLB.com Mid-Season update, three Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Oliva (No. 11), Bolton (No. 13) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 29).

He also managed the Western Division All-Stars in the 2018 Eastern League All-Star Classic. Ryan started his coaching career as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He is in his seventh season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016 and won the Florida State League championship. Ryan played 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors, after he was a fifth-round draft choice by the Minnesota Twins in 1996.
