THE LAST TIME OUT: After finishing off a May 30 game that was suspended to rain, the Curve were defeated on a walk-off, two-run double by Kyle Holder that lifted Trenton to a 4-3 win. Jared Oliva's single in the third scored all three Curve runs when Thunder right fielder Isiah Gilliam misplayed the ball and it rolled to the walt. Jerrick Suiter and Chris Sharpe scored on the play as Oliva circled the bases for his second little league homer of the season. Oneil Cruz made his Double-A debut with Altoona in the suspended game but smacked a pair of doubles in the nightcap. Domingo Robles went the distance and had two strikes and one out on Holder before the game-ending double, which was the third straight Trenton hit to close the contest.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve play the second of a four-game series versus the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. The current series wraps up the season series between the two clubs. Trenton took 2 of 3 in Altoona on July 15-17 and the two teams split two games played during the last visit to ARM & HAMMER Park, which was shortened due to weather.

THE CURVE: The Curve have lost 7 of 8 and are 6-14 since the All-Star Break, the worst record in the league. They have not won a series since going 23-9 with one series loss between June 3-July 7 prior to the break. On Altoona's last homestand, the club went 2-6 with wins in the first and last game around a six-game losing streak, which matched their longest of the season. Each of the Curve's last 11 games and 22 of 23 since July 3 have been decided by three runs or less. The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06). Altoona reached the postseason in 2018 by chasing down Akron, who held a seven-game lead at the start of August.

THE THUNDER: First-Half Eastern Division Champs have gone 11-17 in July and are 18-22 since they punched their ticket to the postseason for the fourth consecutive season. Trenton has the best home winning percentage in the league and are 34-19 at ARM & HAMMER Park in 2019. Trenton's offense is ranked ninth in the league with 3.9 runs per game, eighth with a .239 team batting average, fifth with a .252 average with runners in scoring position, sixth with 75 homers and steal the third-most bases in the league at 87. The club's 3.74 ERA is also ninth in the league with the third-most strikeouts per nine innings (9.2) and third-most walks per nine innings (3.9)

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Nick Economos take the mound for his second Double-A start after he struck out seven Erie SeaWolves during a 3-1 Curve loss in his debut on July 23. His 2.31 ERA between Single-A Greensboro and A-Adv. Bradenton ranks third among Pirates minor leaguers. Economos was drafted by the Pirates in the 21st round during the 2015 draft out of nearby Mercer County Community College, roughly 10 miles from ARM & HAMMER Park...For more on Economos, see page two.

FOR TRENTON: Right-hander Nick Green gets the ball for his 10th appearance for the Thunder and 13th overall this season. Green has gone 0-2 with a 12.23 ERA (24 ER/17.2 IP) over four outings in July after he missed nearly two months with a shoulder ailment. He last pitched on July 25 at Erie and was tagged for six runs in three innings. Last season, he went 7-5 with a 3.28 ERA in 20 starts for A-Adv. Tampa and Double-A for the first time in his career in August and went 1-2 with a 3.63 ERA over three outings. The 24-year-old from Fountain, Colo. was drafted by the Texas Rangers in the seventh round in 2014 out of Indian Hills (lowa) Community College and was acquired by the Yankes on August 1, 2014 in a trade that sent Carlos Beltran to Taxas Yankees on August 1, 2016 in a trade that sent Carlos Beltran to Texas

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: Eastern League pitchers in 2019 have handcuffed hitters to a .239 league-wide batting average with teams scoring 4.0 runs per game. The last season the league average finished below .240 and and fewer than 4.0 runs were scored per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The league average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). Seven no-hitters have been thrown in the league in 2019, the most since a league record nine no-nos occurred in 1967. Strikeouts have also spiked up to 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965. Strong pitching has created a blistering, nine-inning game pace of 2:37:50, making the Eastern League the fastest in professional baseball.

CRUZ CONTROL: One of baseball's top prospects, **Oneil Cruz**, joined the Curve on Tuesday, nearly two years to the day after he was acquired as an 18-year-old from the Los Angeles Dodgers in a trade for former Curve pitcher Tony Watson. Cruz is the 11th 20-year-old to play for the Curve and the first since Cole Tucker made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017. Cruz's call-up was delayed by a right-foot fracture in late April that limited him to 35 games but still hammered seven homers for A-Adv. Bradenton. Since he was activated from the injured list on June 30, Cruz led the Florida State League with six homers in 24 games with a .330 (31/94) average, 13 RBIs and 18 runs.

OLIVA COMING ALIVE: Jared Oliva has hit safely in 16 of 18 while batting .361 (26/72) and nine multi-hit games since July 13. The top hitter in the Eastern League since early June, Oliva has reached base in 45 of his last 51 games with a .425 on-base percentage and hitting .353 (67/190), both the highest rates in the league since June 3, to go with 16 doubles, 37 runs, 22 steals and 67 hits. His batting average has risen from a season-low .188 to .281, seventh-best in the E.L. and ranked fourth in Pittsburgh's system. In the Second Half, Oliva leads the E.L. with a .375 batting average and 51 hits. In the stolen base department, Oliva ranks second on the E.L. circuit and first in the Pirates system with 30 steals for the year and is the ninth player in club history to surpass 30 stolen bases in a single season. single season.

BIG FLY BLIGH: Out of seven total home runs hit by **Bligh Madris**, five have been either go-ahead or game-tying homers in Curve wins. He also has connected on three other game-winning hits, including a walk-off single on April 11, Altoona's home opener and the fifth walk-off hit of his pro career. Madris ranks ninth in the E.L. and seventh in the Pirates system with 93 hits and is second on the club with 27 multi-hit games.

TOLMAN AT THE TOP: Since taking over the leadoff role on June 19, **Mitchell Tolman** has reached base in 33 of 36 games while hitting .269 (36/134). Since the start of the Second Half, Tolman has scored a league-high 28 runs scored, drawn the second-most walks with 22 and ranks sixth with a .388 on-base percentage.

PRODUCING AFTER PROMOTIONS: Robbie Glendinning and **Chris Sharpe**, a pair of 2019 Florida State League All-Stars, have not missed a beat since their mid-June promotions from A-Adv. Bradenton. Glendinning ranks fifth in the league with 25 RBIs in 41 games since his June 13 promotion and currently leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a .300 batting average and .364 on-base percentage between the two levels while his 98 hits total are second-best in the system. Since Sharpe's June 21 debut for the Curve, the outfielder leads the E.L. with 27 runs scored and is fourth with six homers and 23 RBIs. Each player has also contributed a walk-off hit since joining the team.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features three of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects with infielder **Oneil Cruz** (No. 3), outfielder **Jared Oliva** (No. 19) and right-handed pitcher **Cody Bolton** (No. 21). Oliva is ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system while Cruz is regarded as the organization's "Best Power Hitter" and "Best Infield Arm". After the latest MLB.com Mid-Season update, four Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Cruz (No. 3), Oliva (No. 11), Bolton (No. 13) and right-handed reliever **Blake Cederlind** (No. 29). Across all of baseball, Cruz is ranked by *Baseball America* as their No. 79 overall prospect and No. 12 shortstop while MLB.com rates the 20-year-old as the No. 62 prospect in baseball and their No. 9 prospect.

Ryan returns for his third season in Altoona after guiding the Curve to back-to-back Western Division championships. In his first season, the Curve captured the 2017 Eastern League title. He also managed the Western Division All-Stars in the 2018 Eastern League All-Star Classic. Ryan started his coaching career as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He is in his seventh season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016 and won the Florida State League championship. Ryan played 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors, after he was a fifth-round draft choice by the Minnesota Twins in 1996.

Joel Hanrahan Pitching Coach
