THE LAST TIME OUT: Curve pitchers Cody Bolton, Clay Holmes, Angel German and Blake Cederlind pitched a 2-0 shutout victory over Richmond to win Altoona's first series since the All-Star Break. Bolton went the first five frames before Holmes threw two scoreless on MLB rehab. German and Cederlind each tossed hitless innings to close out the game. Oneil Cruz connect on an RBI single during the fourth. In the seventh, Brett Pope hit a double with two outs and was knocked in on a double by relief pitcher Beau Sulser, who appeared as a pinch hitter.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve host the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, for the first of a three-game series at PNG Field. The weekend set concludes the six-game season series between the two clubs, which would be completed in a 10-day span. Reading swept the Curve at FirstEnergy Stadium on August 2-4, outscoring the Curve 21-11.

THE CURVE: The Curve are coming off first series win since the All-Star Break by taking 3 of 4 over Richmond to start the homestand, breaking a six-series losing streak. After the All-Star Break, the Curve are 10-20, the worst record in the league, by being outscored 131-104 and are hitting .221 (208/942), the second-lowest average in the league. Altoona went 25-10 from June 3-July 13, including wins in 7 of 8 entering the All-Star Break, to climb from a season-low five games under .500 (24-29) to a season-best 10 games over (49-39). The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE FIGHTIN PHILS: Reading has the best record in the Eastern League and third-best among all of Double-A. The R-Phils pace the Eastern Division in the Second Half and ended the First Half tied for first with Trenton, but were denied the first playoff spot due to a tie-breaker. Reading comes to PNG Field after thier six-game winning streak was broken with a 6-4 loss to Hartford. Their longest winning streak of the season was seven games from July 14-19. The R-Phils' offense ranks third in the league by scoring 4.24 runs per game thanks to a league-high 99 home runs and 430 walks. However, the club's 235 team batting average and .240 average with runners in scoring position are each the third-lowest in the E.L. Reading's pitchers lead the E.L. with 9.6 SO/9 IP, rank sixth in overall ERA (3.56), 10th in starter ERA (4.01) and the third-best bullpen ERA (2.96).

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander **Domingo Robles** makes his 14th Double-A start and 24rd overall in the Pirates system. Robles made his last start in Reading on Sunday and held the R-Phils to just two hits outside of a four-run third. During his previous start, he took a 3-2 lead into the final frame of a seven-inning game on July 30 at Trenton and recorded the first out before three straight hits for the Thunder led to a walk-off, 4-3 loss for Altoona. Robles was the Opening Day starter for A-Adv. Bradenton this season and went 5-5 with a 2.61 ERA in 10 Florida State League starts before his promotion on May 28. Robles, a 21-year-old native of the Dominican Republic, was signed by Pittsburgh as an international free agent on July 2.2014. FOR READING: Right-hander Spencer Howard makes his third Double-A start and second straight against the Curve. Howard lasted 3.1 innings on August 2, allowing two runs on three hits but required 73 pitches. He had an impressive debut on July 26 in New Hampshire after he fanned 10 over 4.2 innings. Howard opened 2019 with A-Adv. Clearwater and landed on the injured list after a strong April in which he struck out 30 over 20 innings, holding opponents to five runs. He returned to the Threshers on July 8 after a pair of tune-up outings in the GCL before his promotion to Reading. In 2018, Howard spent the entire season with Class A Lakewood, went 9-8 with a 3.78 ERA and struck out 147 hitters in 112 innings. He also threw a nine-inning no-hitter in the South Atlantic League playoffs against Kannapolis (White Sox) in which he walked one and struck out nine. The Phillies drafted Howard with the 45th overall pick in 2017 out of Cal Poly and is Philadelphia's No. 5 overall prospect. overall prospect.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: Eastern League pitchers in 2019 have handcuffed hitters to a .239 league-wide batting average with teams scoring 3.97 runs per game. The last time the league average finished below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs were scored per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The league average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). The circuit has witnessed eight no-hitters in 2019 (two against Altoona), the most since a league-record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. Strikeouts have also spiked to 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965.

BRAKE MEN: Altoona's bullpen has been a lockdown unit since mid-June, owning a 2.69 ERA (53 ER/177.1 IP) over 52 games since June 12. Blake Cederlind has a 1.64 ERA (4 ER/22 IP) in his last 16 games since June 14. Over 11 outings since June 26, Joel Cesar has thrown eight scoreless games with a 2.70 ERA (5 ER/16.2 IP). Yeudy Garcia has anchored a 2.73 ERA (9 ER/29.2 IP) in 16 games since May 30. During his last 21 games since May 19, Angel German has yanked his ERA down from 7.07 to 4.32 with 16 scoreless outings, allowing just 15 hits, struck out 29 and has a 2.86 ERA (9 ER/28.2 IP). In parts of two seasons with the Curve, Jesus Liranzo has allowed just one earned run over 30.2 innings. Matt Eckelman is the ninth player in club history to record 20 saves in a single season while his 31 career saves with Altoona trail only Montana DuRapau's team record of 38. Eckelman has allowed just two earned runs, four total, in 23 games since the start of June for a 0.71 ERA (2 ER/25.2 IP). start of June for a 0.71 ERA (2 ER/25.2 IP).

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz has flourished over his first four games at PNG Field, going 5-for-14 with four RBIs. The 6-foot-6 shortstop has connected on a go-ahead, two-run single on Monday, the game-tying RBI knock leading up to a Curve win in extra innings during the suspended game on Wednesday and drove home the first run of a 2-0 shutout win on Thursday. Cruz was limited to 35 games for A-Adv. Bradenton due to a right foot fracture in late April but he still hammered seven homers the Marauders. Since he was activated from the injured list on June 30 until his promotion to Double-A, Cruz led the Florida State League with six homers over a 24-game period along with a .330 (31/94) average, 13 RBIs and 18 runs to earn FSL Player of the Month honors. Cruz is the 11th 20-year-old to play for the Curve and the first since Cole Tucker made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017 made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017.

J.O. ON A ROLL: Jared Oliva has 11 multi-hit games and has hit safely in 23 of his last 27 games since July 13, batting .347 (35/101). He finished July with a league-best .388 (40/103) batting average, 40 hits and 13 steals over 27 games. Going back to June 3, Oliva has raised his batting average from a season-low .188 to .284, ranked fifth in the E.L., by reaching base in 52 of 60 games at a .347 (76/219) pace, 34 points higher than second-best, and has a .413 on-base percentage over that period, also the highest rate in the league. He currently ranks fifth in the E.L. in OPS (.783), eighth in on-base percentage (.359), eighth in hits (103), eighth in doubles (23), sixth in triples (5) and sixth in runs (59). In the stolen base department, Oliva ranks second in the E.L. and leads the Pirates system with 32 steals and is the ninth player in club history to surpass 30 stolen bases in a single season.

POPE'S POKES: Brett Pope has gotten stronger at the plate as the season has progressed. Over his last 50 games since May 25, he has raised his batting average from .169 to .244 by batting .292 (38/130) with seven doubles, one triple and 15 walks for a .350 on-base percentage. Pope batted a season-best .291 through the month of June. During his last 16 games since July 22, he is hitting .333 (13/39) and is 5-for-14 (.357) with two doubles in eight games to start August.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features three of Baseball America's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects with infielder Oneil Cruz (No. 3), right-handed pitcher Cody Bolton (No. 5) and right-handed pitcher Cody Ponce (No. 30). After the latest MLB.com Mid-Season update, four Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Cruz (No. 3), Jared Oliva (No. 11), Bolton (No. 13) and right-handed reliever Blake Cederlind (No. 29). Across all of baseball, Cruz is ranked by Baseball America as their No. 79 overall prospect while MLB.com rates the 20-year-old as the No. 62 prospect.

MILESTONE TRACKER: The Altoona franchise is 8 wins from reaching 1,500 regular season victories over the ballclub's 21-year history. Manager **Michael Ryan** is 10 wins from 500 for his managerial career and needs four more victories to reach 214 as the Curve skipper, which would be the most by a manager in team history. He is 210-184 overall for the Curve.
