THE LAST TIME OUT: A back-and-forth game went to Reading, 8-6. The Curve jumped out to an early 5-1 lead with three in the first, highlighted by a two-run single by Logan Hill, and two in the second, started by Arden Pabst's lead-off solo homer. The Fightin Phils smacked four doubles and hit three homers, including a game-tying blast in the sixth by Phillies top prospect Alec Bohm. In the seventh, Reading hit consecutive doubles by Luke Williams and Mickey Moniak to score three times to hold the lead for good.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve host the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, for the finale of a three-game series at PNG Field. The weekend set concludes the six-game season series between the two clubs, which would be completed in a 10-day span. Reading swept the Curve at FirstEnergy Stadium on August 2-4, outscoring the Curve 21-11. In this series, Altoona took a 1-0 game on Friday before Reading forced the rubber match with a two-run win on Saturday. The rubber game on Sunday is the first the Curve have played since July 3 at Akron. Altoona is 6-4 in series-deciding contests in 2019 and have been victorious in four in a row. Altoona will have their final day off on Monday before playing 21 straight to close the season.

THE CURVE: The Curve have won 4 of 6 on the homestand, including their first series win since the All-Star Break by taking 3 of 4 over Richmond, after going 1-6 on the previous road trip. After the All-Star Break, the Curve are 11-21 and have been outscored 139-111 and are hitting .225 (226/1006), the second-lowest average in the league. Altoona went 25-10 from June 3-July 13, including wins in 7 of 8 entering the All-Star Break, to climb from a season-low five games under .500 (24-29) to a season-best 10 games over (49-39). The Curve have reached the E.L. Playoffs in each of the last four seasons, the longest active streak in the league and tied for the longest run in franchise history (2003-06).

THE FIGHTIN PHILS: Reading is the first team in the Eastern League to reach 70 wins and have the fourth-best record among all of Double-A. The club has also won 7 of 9 to build a five-game lead in the Eastern Division. The R-Phils pace the Eastern Division in the Second Half and ended the First Half tied for first with Trenton, but were denied the first playoff spot due to a tie-breaker. The R-Phils' offense ranks tied for second in the league by scoring 4.24 runs per game thanks to a league-high 102 home runs and 432 walks. However, the club's .236 team batting average and .240 average with runners in scoring position are each the third-lowest in the E.L. Reading's pitchers lead the E.L. with 9.6 SO/9 IP, rank sixth in overall ERA (3.56), 10th in starter ERA (4.00) and the third-best bullpen ERA (2.97).

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Pedro Vasquez will make his 20th outing for the Curve and 22nd overall between Double-A and Triple-A. In his last start, he was limited to two scoreless innings on August 6 before rain suspended the contest to the next day. Vasquez was an Eastern League All-Star and pitched a 1-2-3 third inning in the Eastern League All-Star Game in Richmond to aid a 5-0 victory for the Western Divison over the Eastern Divison on July 10. He ranks fifth in the E.L. with a 2.77 ERA and sixth with a 1.11 WHIP. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by Seattle as an international free agent in 2015 and was acquired by the Pirates in a trade on September 1, 2016 as a player-to-be-named later for RHP Arquimedes Caminero... For more on Vasquez, see page two.

FOR READING: Adonis Medina, a 22-year-old right-hander, takes the mound for his 19th start and second straight against the Curve. He fired six one-run innings last Sunday and struck out eight during a no-decision during his last start versus Altoona. Over his previous two starts, Medina lost two starts against New Hampshire and had a 16.20 ERA (12 ER/6.2 IP). He trimmed his ERA to 3.53 ERA with seven one-run frames at Binghamton on July 15, his first outing since the All-Star Break. A 2019 Eastern League All-Star, Medina started the All-Star Game for the Eastern Division on July 10 at The Diamond and allowed a run in the opening inning. Medina recorded more strikeouts than innings pitched in 2017 with Class A Lakewood (133 in 119.2 IP) and A-Adv. Clearwater in 2018 (123 in 111.1 IP). The Phillies signed Medina as an international free agent on May 29, 2014 and is regarded by MLB.com as Philadelphia's top pitching prospect, No. 2 overall in the system and No. 92 in baseball.

BRAKE MEN: Altoona's bullpen has been a lockdown unit since mid-June, owning a 2.91 ERA (59 ER/182.2 IP) over 54 games since June 12. Blake Cederlind has a 1.57 ERA (4 ER/23 IP) with 23 strikeouts in his last 17 games since June 14. Matt Eckelman is the ninth player in club history to record 20 saves in a single season while his 32 career saves with Altoona are second-most in franchise history. Eckelman has allowed just two earned runs, four total, with 28 strikeouts in 24 games since the start of June for a 0.68 ERA (2 ER/26.2 IP). Over 12 outings since June 26, Joel Cesar has thrown nine scoreless games with a 2.55 ERA (5 ER/17.2 IP). Yeudy Garcia has anchored a 2.73 ERA (9 ER/29.2 IP) in 16 games since May 30. During his last 22 games since May 19, Angel German has yanked his ERA down from 7.07 to 4.15 with 17 scoreless outings, allowing just 17 hits, struck out 32 and has a 2.67 ERA (9 ER/30.1 IP). In parts of two seasons with the Curve, Jesus Liranzo has allowed just one earned run over 30.2 innings.

YEAR OF THE PITCHER: Eastern League pitchers in 2019 have handcuffed hitters to a .239 league-wide batting average with teams scoring 3.97 runs per game. The last time the league average finished below .240 and fewer than 4.0 runs were scored per game was in 1971 (.234/3.57). The league average has finished under .240 just five times since becoming a Double-A league in 1963: 1971 (.234), 1968 (.219), 1967 (.228), 1966 (.234) and 1965 (.236). The circuit has witnessed eight no-hitters in 2019 (two against Altoona), the most since a league-record nine no-nos were thrown in 1967. Strikeouts have also spiked to 8.7 SO/9 IP, the highest ratio in league history going back to the earliest data available in 1965.

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz has flourished over his first six games at PNG Field, going 6-for-20 (.300) with four RBIs. The 6-foot-6 shortstop connected on a go-ahead, two-run single on Monday, the game-tying RBI knock leading up to a Curve win in extra innings on Wednesday and drove home the first run of a 2-0 shutout win on Thursday. Cruz was limited to 35 games for A-Adv. Bradenton due to a right foot fracture in late April but he still hammered seven homers the Marauders. Since he was activated from the injured list on June 30 until his promotion to Double-A, Cruz led the Florida State League with six homers over a 24-game period along with a .330 (31/94) average, 13 RBIs and 18 runs to earn FSL Player of the Month honors. Cruz is the 11th 20-year-old to play for the Curve and the first since Cole Tucker made his Double-A debut on July 20, 2017

J.O. ON A ROLL: Jared Oliva has hit safely in 24 of his last 29 games since July 13, batting .349 (38/109). Before Oliva broke out for his team-high seventh three-hit game, he went 0-for-7 over his previous two games, which was the first time since June 19 & 21 that he did not recorded a hit in consecutive games. Going back to June 3, Oliva has raised his batting average from a season-low .188 to .286,second in the E.L., by reaching base in 54 of 62 games at a .348 (79/227) pace, 38 points higher than second-best, and has a .414 on-base percentage over that period, also the highest rate in the league. He currently ranks eighth in the E.L. in OPS (.784), seventh in on-base percentage (.361), seventh in hits (106), 11th in doubles (23), sixth in triples (5) and fifth in runs (60). In the stolen base department, Oliva ranks second in the E.L. and leads the Pirates system with 32 steals and is the ninth player in club history to surpass 30 stolen bases in a single season.

POPE'S POKES: Brett Pope has gotten stronger at the plate as the season has progressed. Over his last 50 games since May 25, he has raised his batting average from .169 to .244 by batting .292 (38/130) with seven doubles, one triple and 15 walks for a .350 on-base percentage. Pope batted a season-best .291 through the month of June. During his last 16 games since July 22, he is hitting .333 (13/39) and is 5-for-14 (.357) with two doubles in eight games to start August.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features four of Baseball America's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects with infielder Oneil Cruz (No. 3), right-handed pitcher Cody Bolton (No. 5), right-handed reliever Blake Cederlind (No. 24) and right-handed pitcher Cody Ponce (No. 30). After the latest MLB.com Mid-Season update, four Top 30 Pirates prospects are in Altoona with Cruz (No. 3), Jared Oliva (No. 11), Bolton (No. 13) and right-handed reliever Cederlind (No. 28). Across all of baseball, Cruz is ranked by Baseball America as their No. 79 overall prospect while MLB.com ranks him at No. 62.

MILESTONE TRACKER: The Altoona franchise is 7 wins from reaching 1,500 regular season victories over the ballclub's 21-year history. Manager Michael Ryan is 9 wins from 500 for his managerial career and needs three more victories to reach 214 as the Curve skipper, which would be the most by a manager in team history. He is 210-184 overall for the Curve. Matt Eckelman is seven saves from passing Montana DuRapau for the franchise's all-time saves record.

Ryan returns for his third season in Altoona after guiding the Curve to back-to-back Western Division championships. In his first season, the Curve captured the 2017 Eastern League title. He also managed the Western Division All-Stars in the 2018 Eastern League All-Star Classic. Ryan started his coaching career as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He is in his seventh season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016 and won the Florida State League championship. Ryan played 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors, after he was a fifth-round draft choice by the Minnesota Twins in 1996.

Joel Hanrahan Pitching Coach

1st season 3rd overall

Hanrahan joins the Curve in 2019 for his third season as a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh minor league system. He started his coaching career with the Bristol Pirates in 2017 and most recently oversaw pitchers for the West Virginia Power last year. Hanrahan was a two-time National League All-Star with the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2011 and 2012 while he served as the team's closer.
